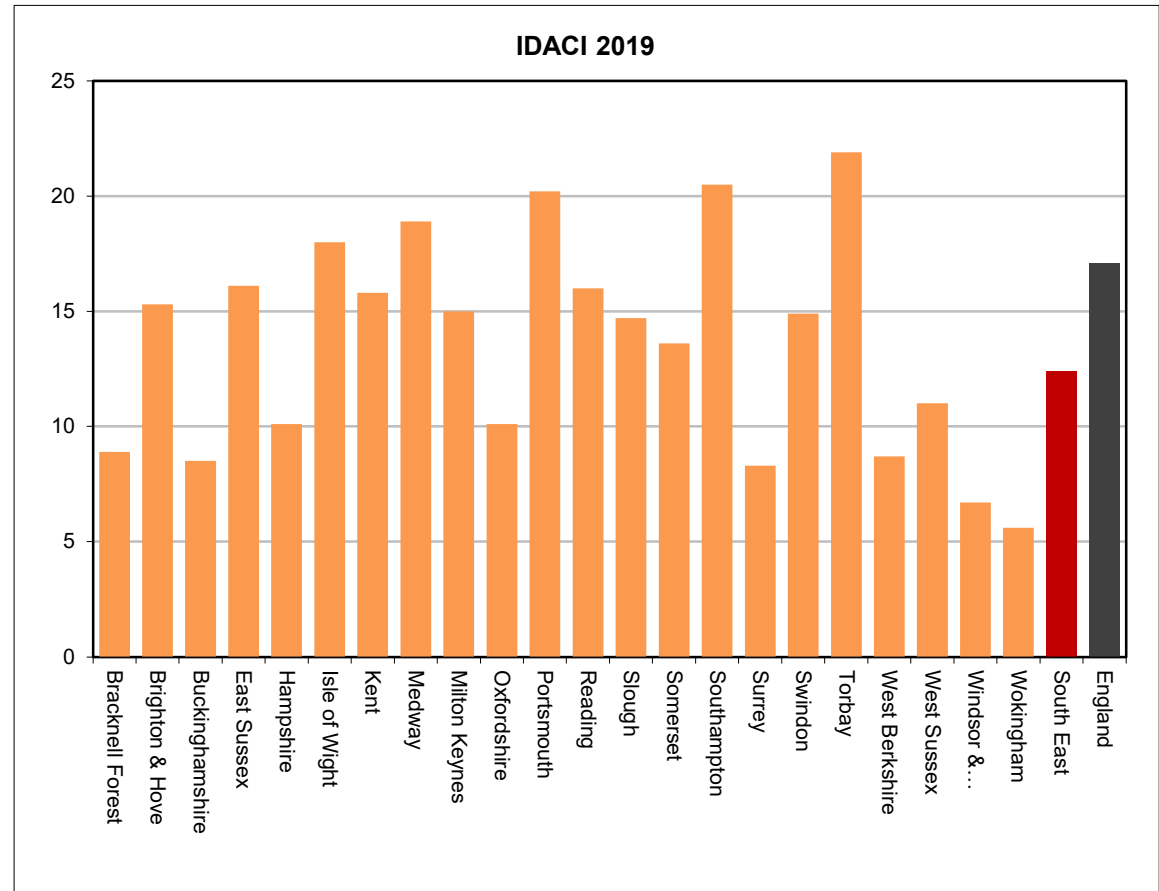

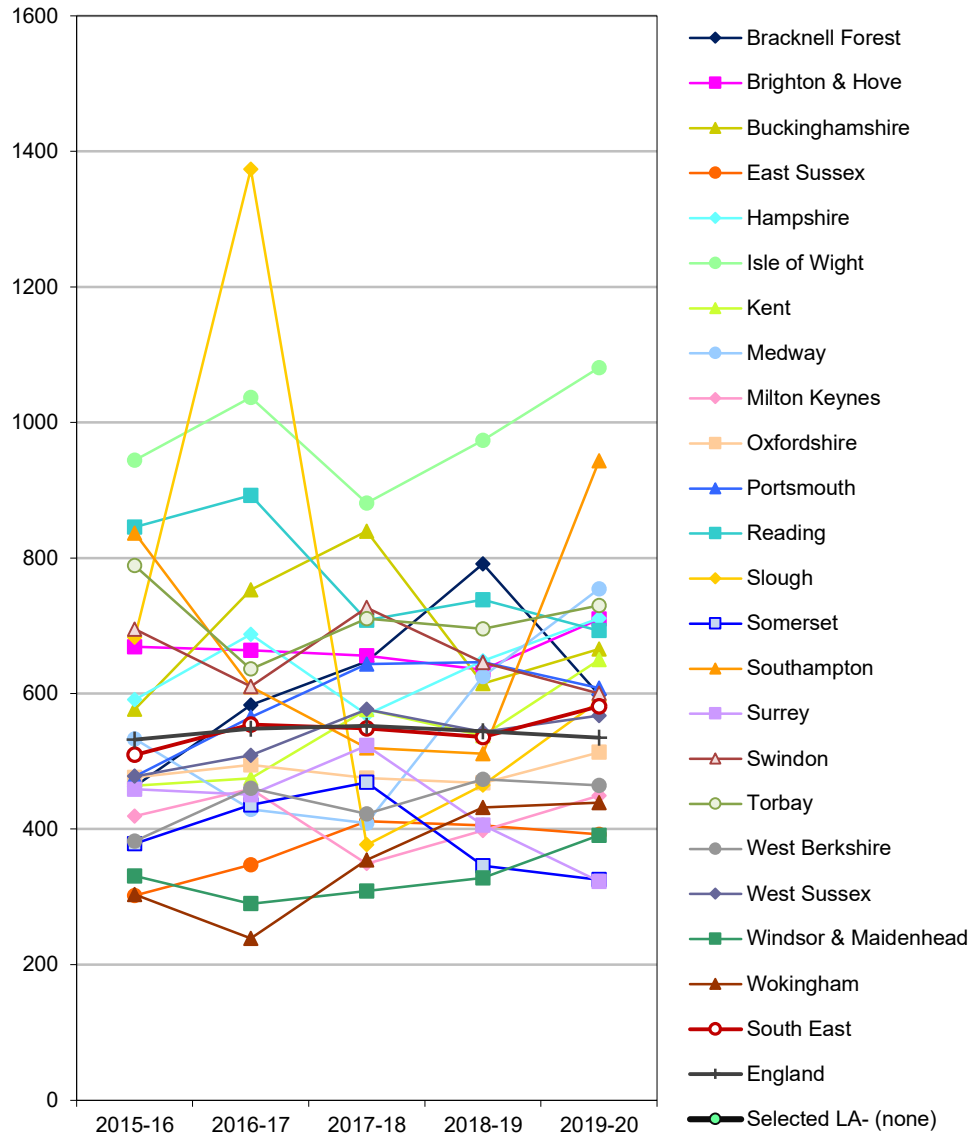

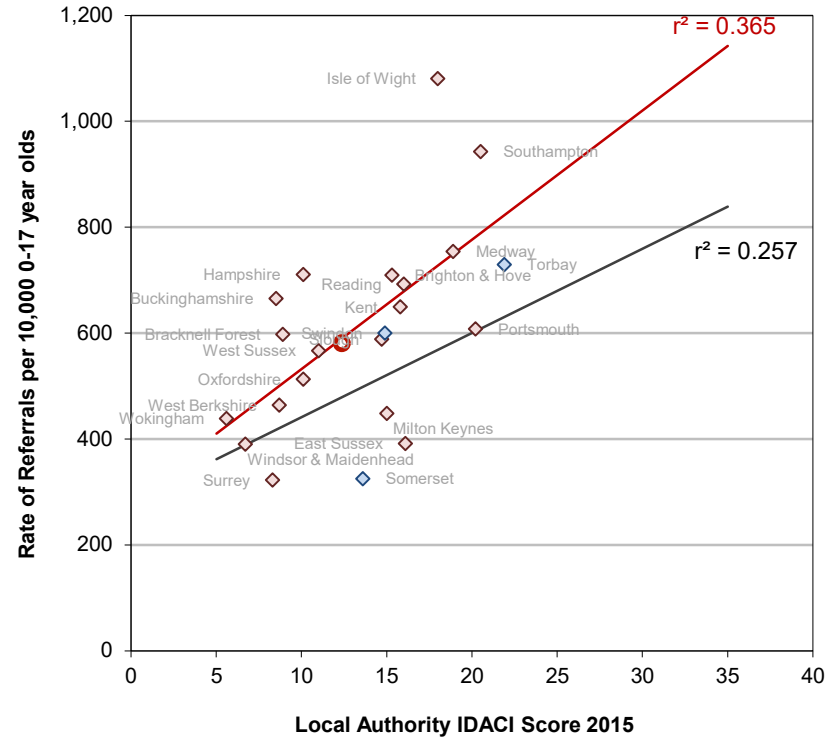

**Rate of Referrals, per 10,000 0-17 year olds**

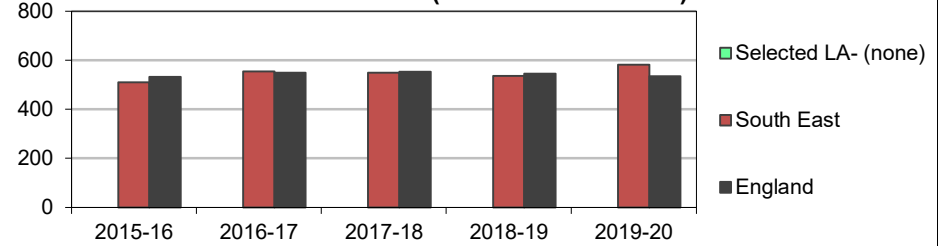


**Rate of Referrals vs. IDACI**

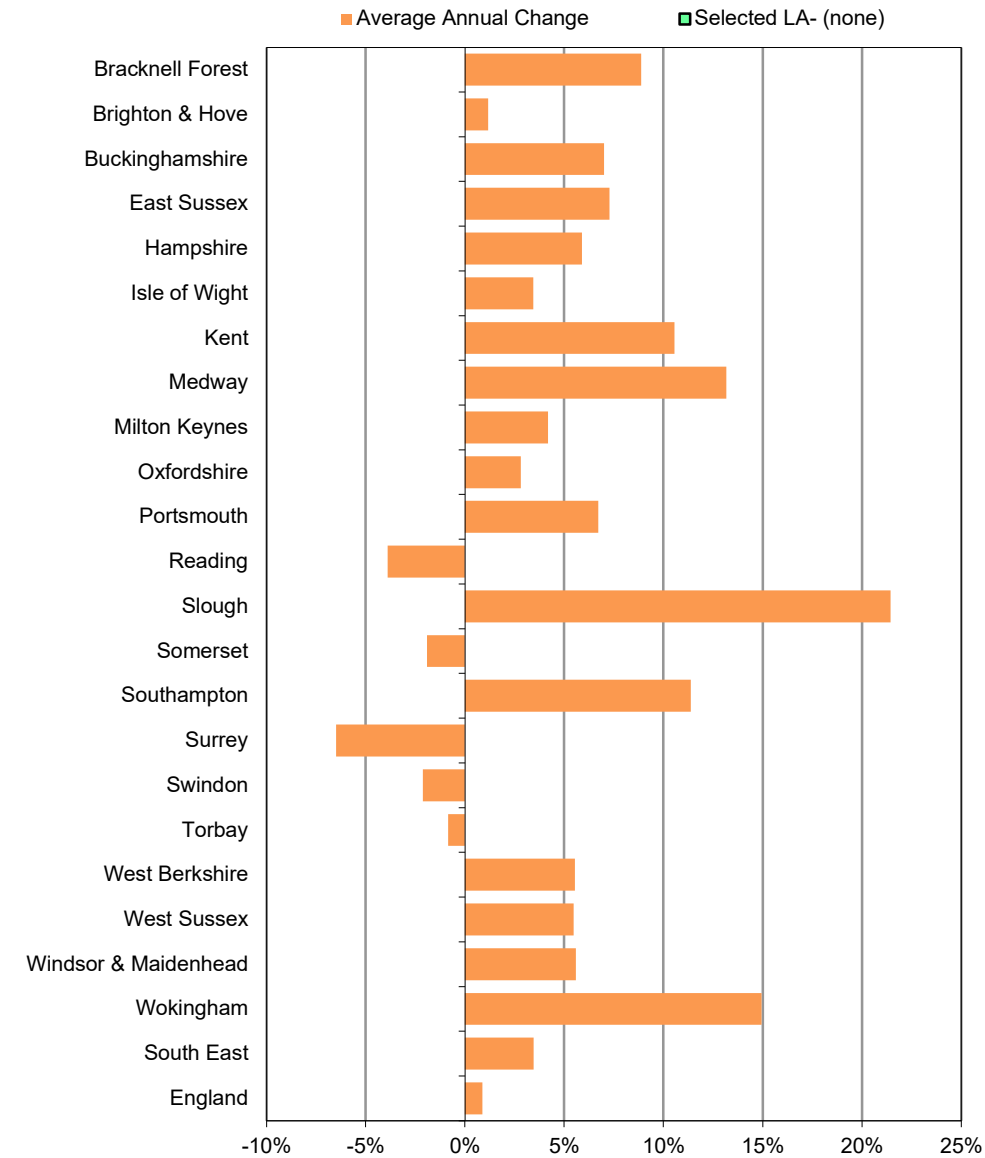

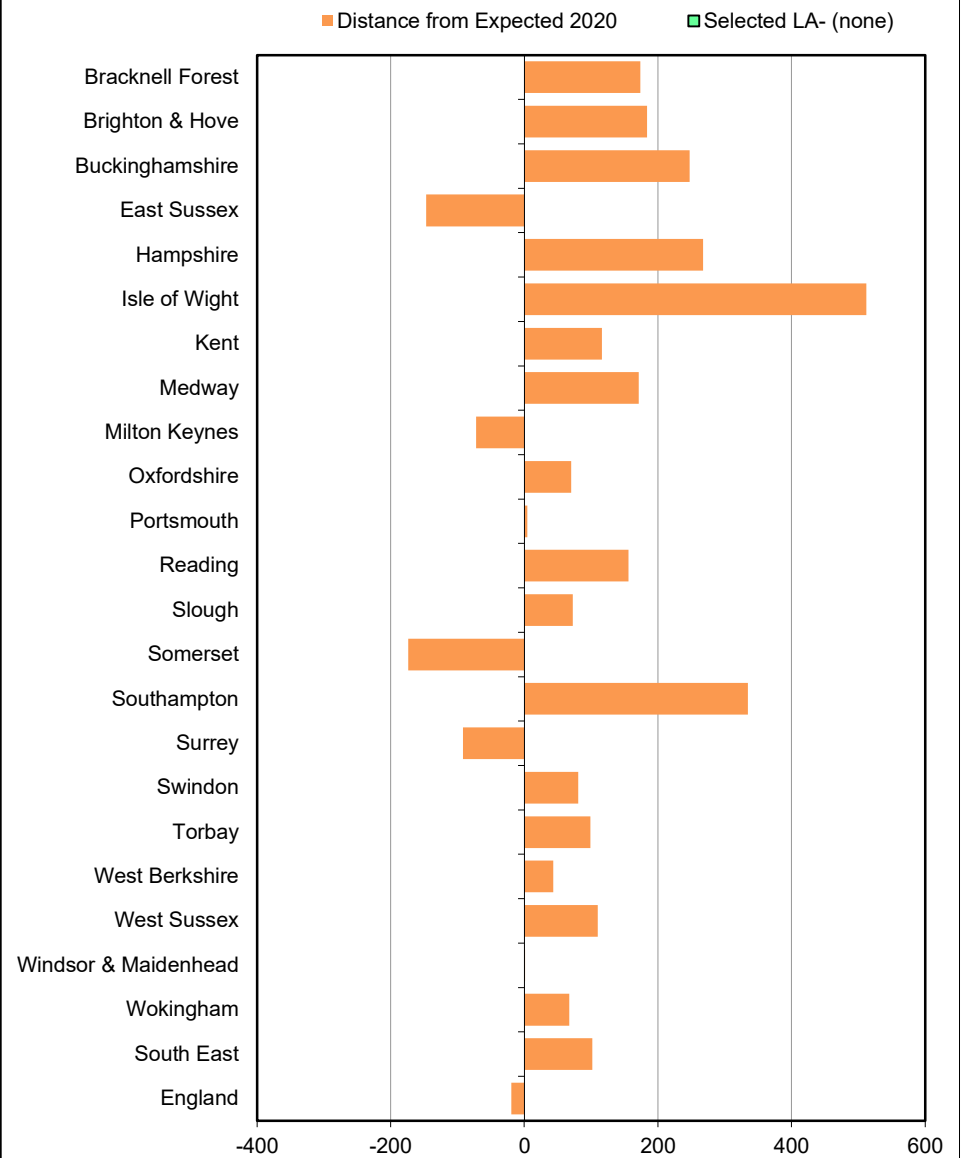
**Rate of Referrals (Selected LA vs. SE)**

### Distance from Expected Rate of Referrals

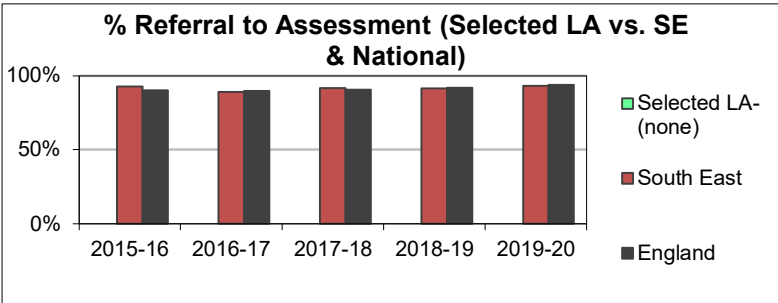

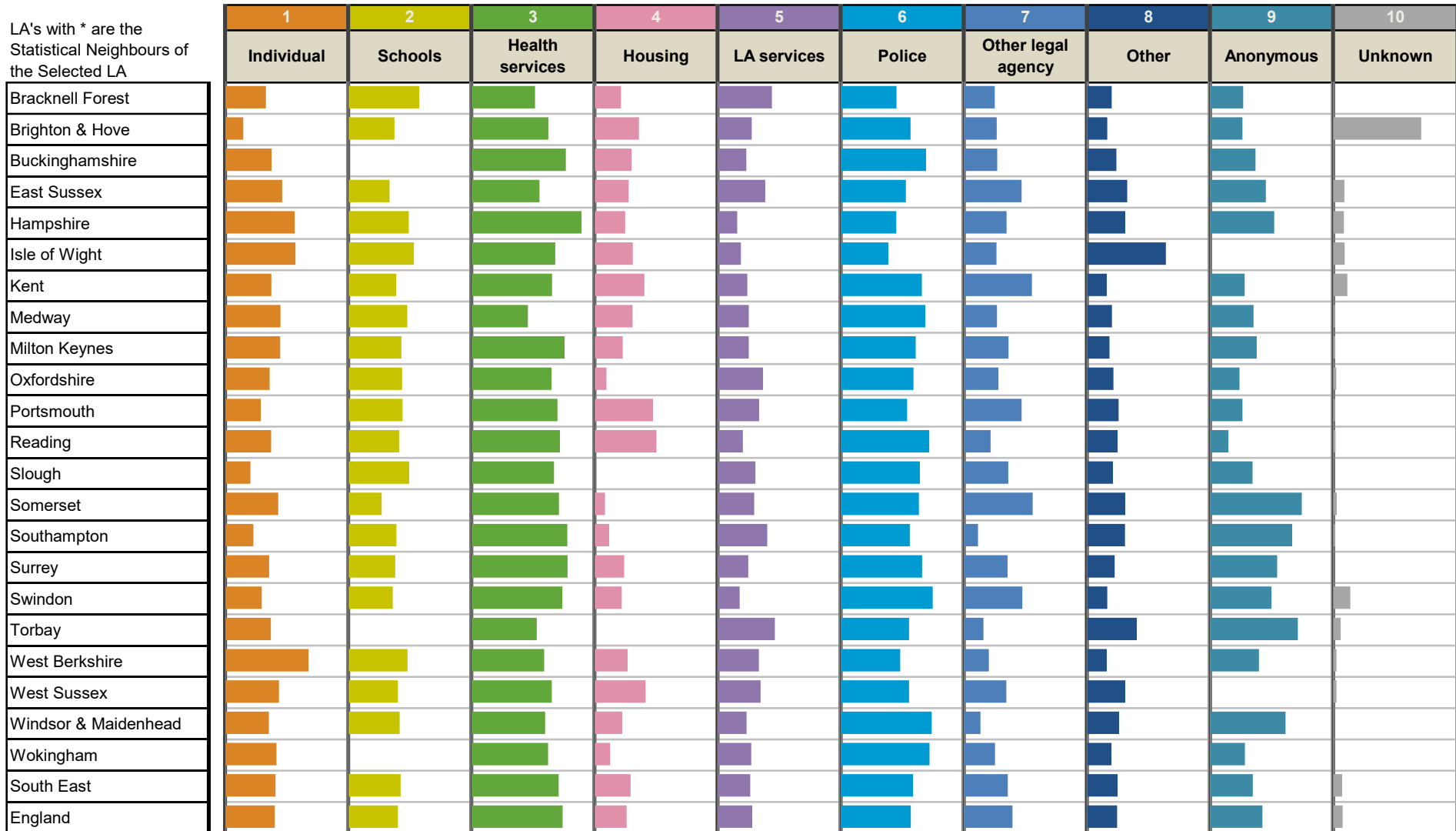

**Rate of Re-referrals, per 10,000 0-17 year olds**

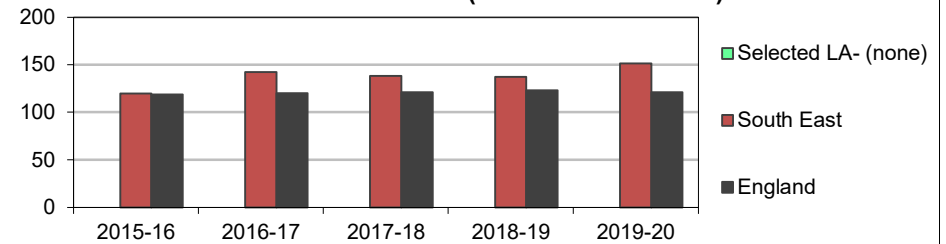


**Rate of Re-referrals vs. IDACI**

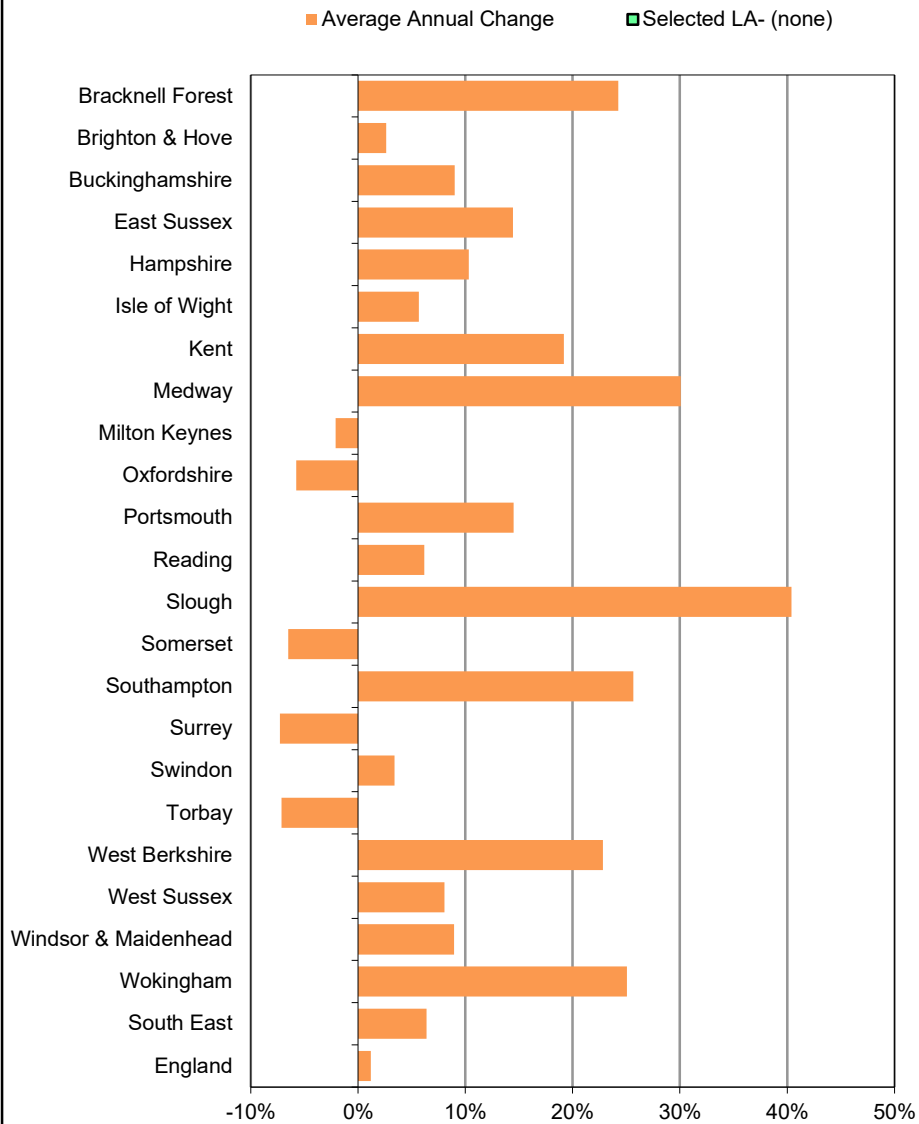

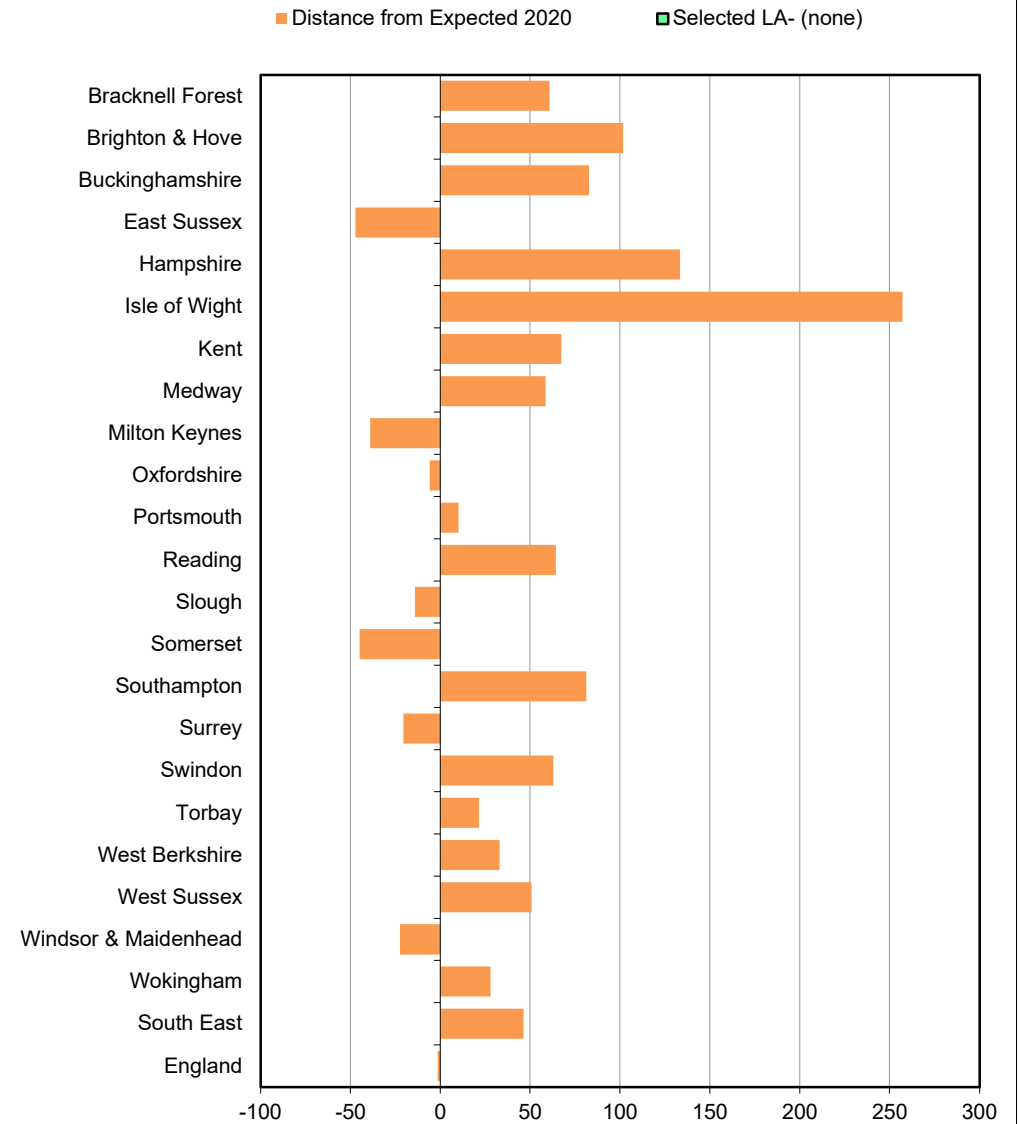
**Rate of Re-referrals (Selected LA vs. SE)**



### Average Annual Change in Number of Re-referrals



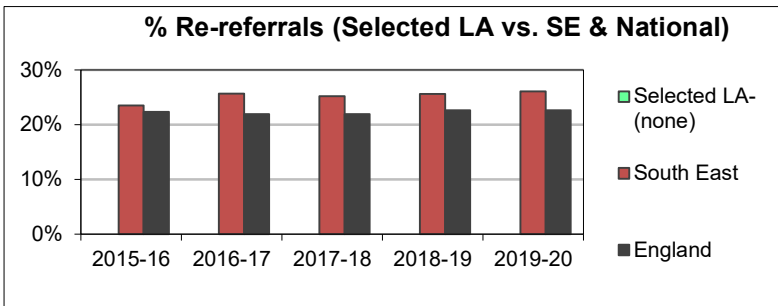

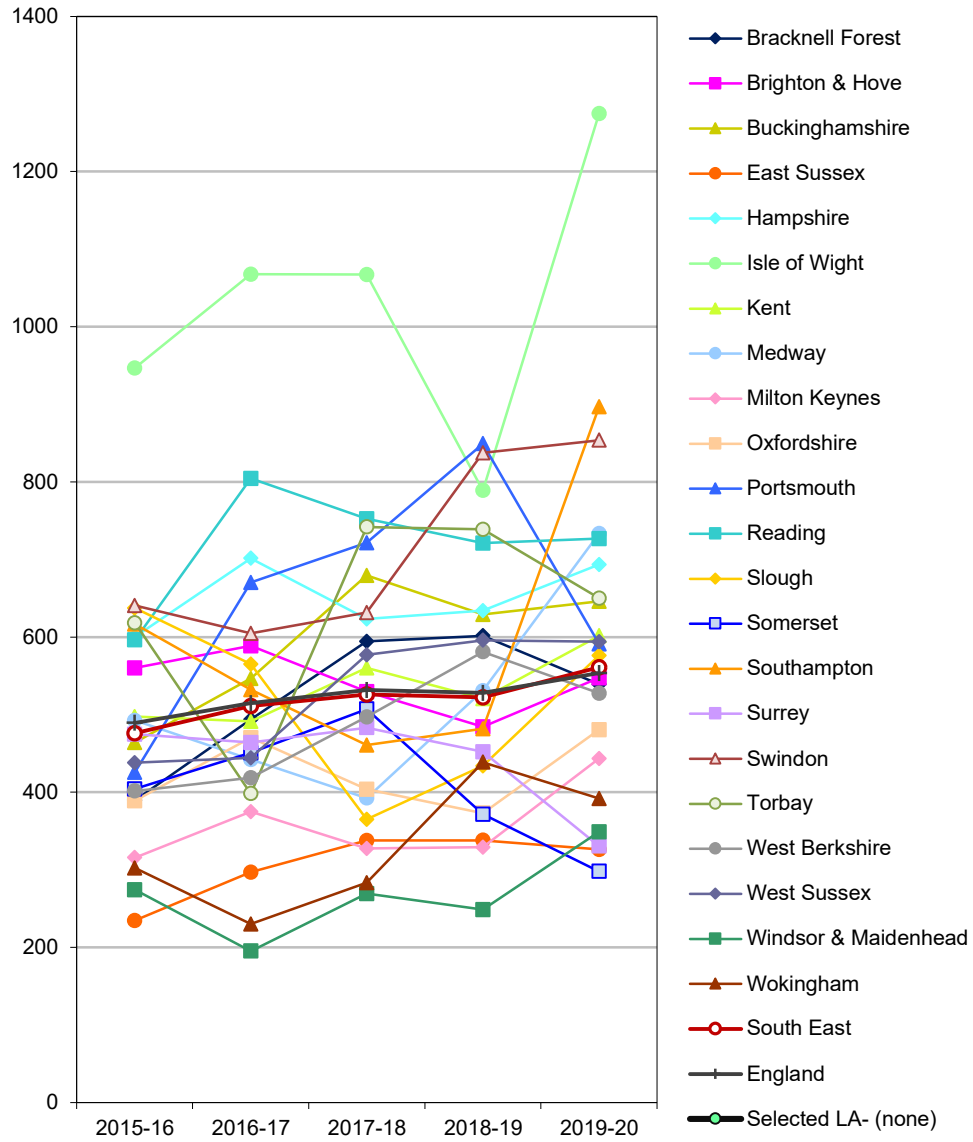

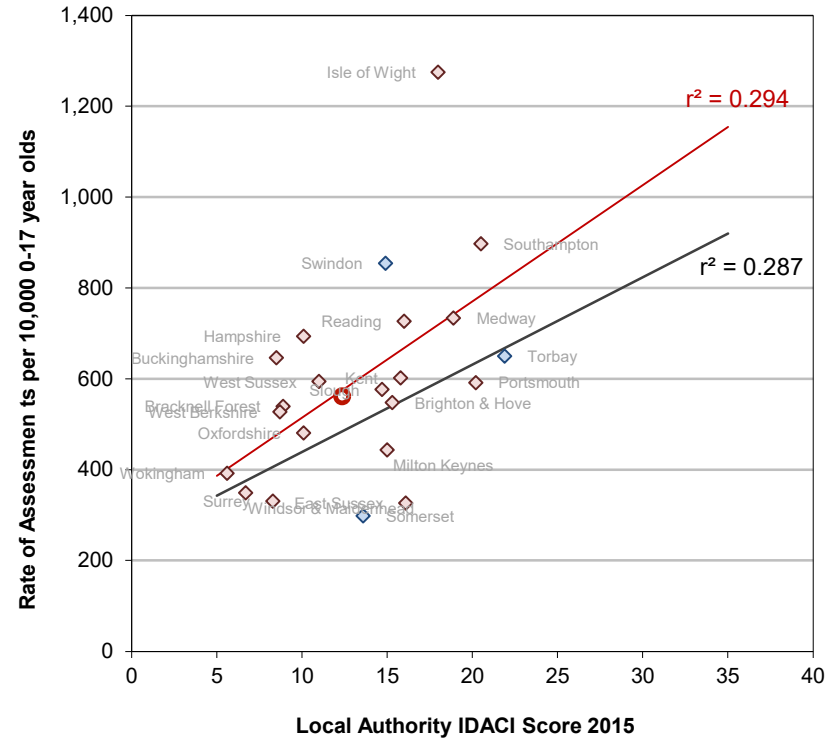

**Rate of Assessments, per 10,000 0-17 year olds**

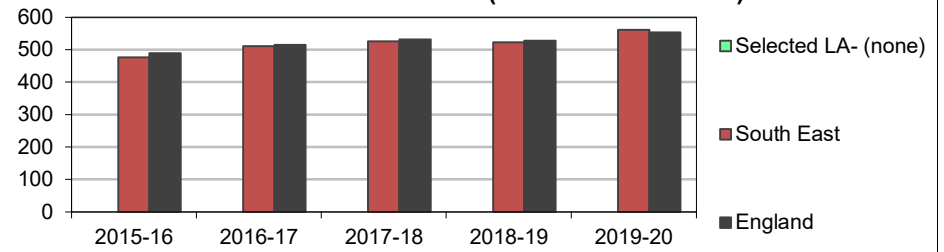


**Rate of Assessments vs. IDACI**



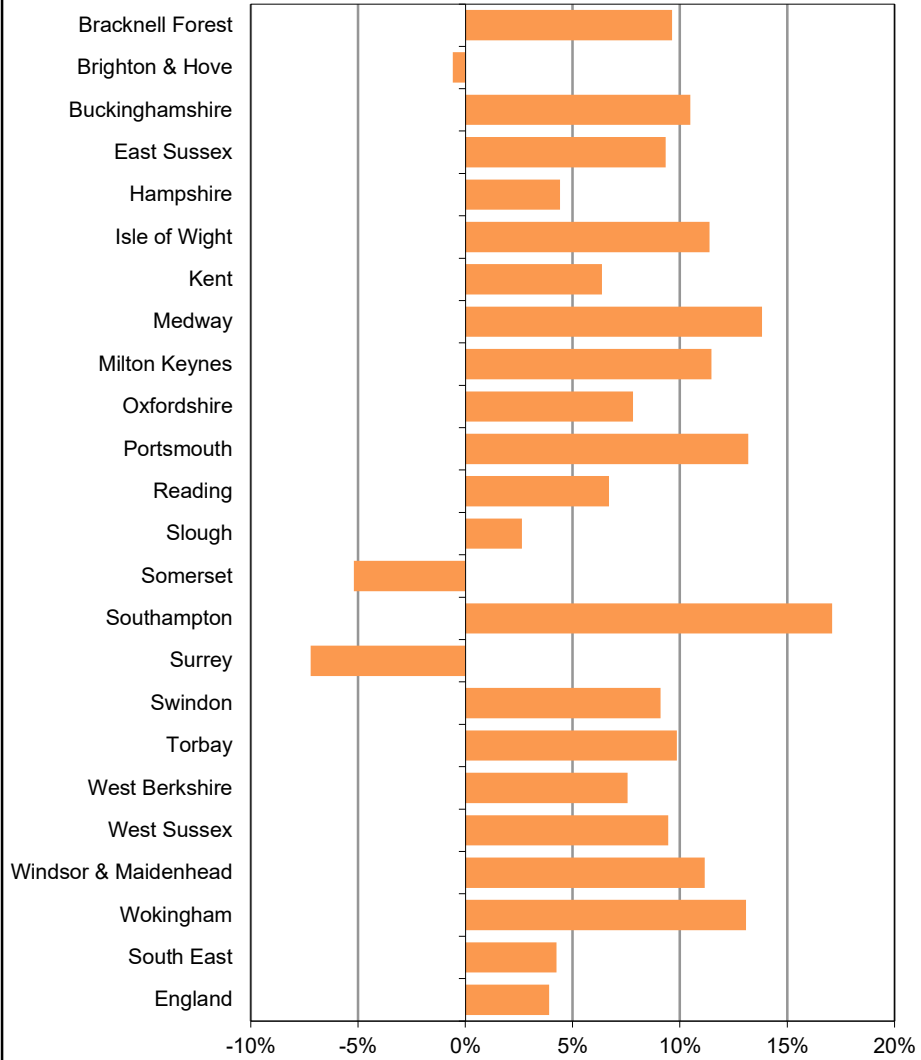

**Rate of Assessments (Selected LA vs. SE)**



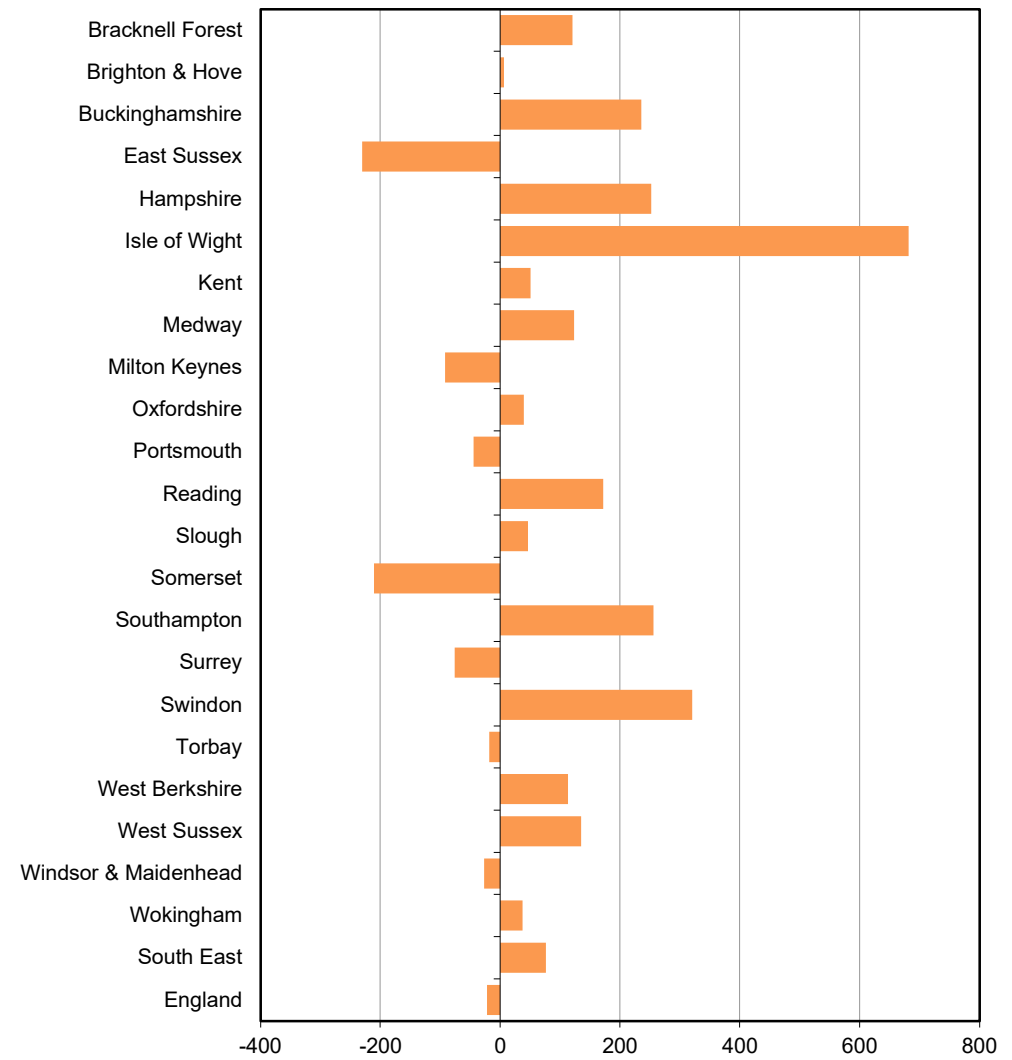
### Average Annual Change in Number of Assessments

■ Distance from Expected 2020    ■ Selected LA- (none)

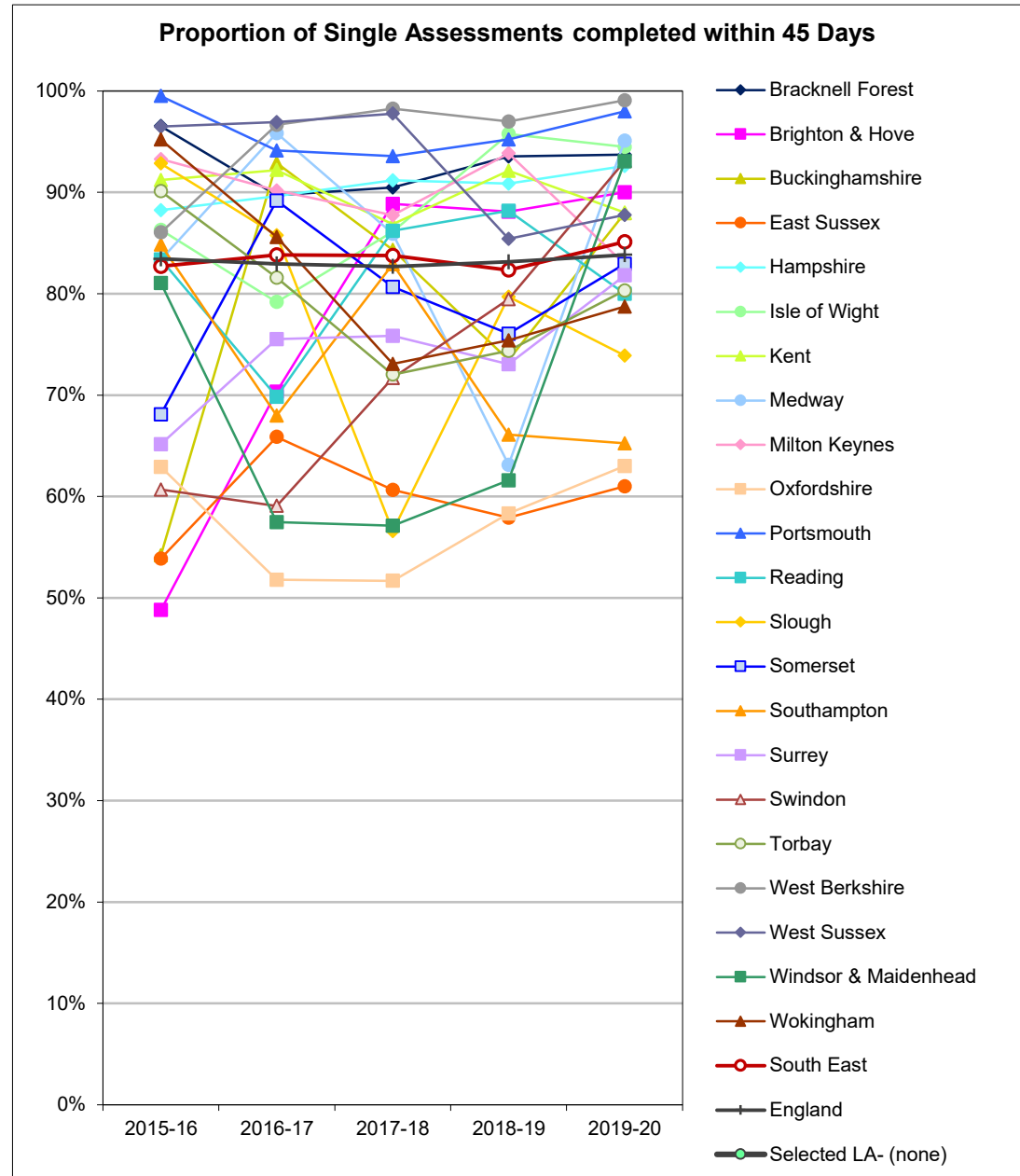
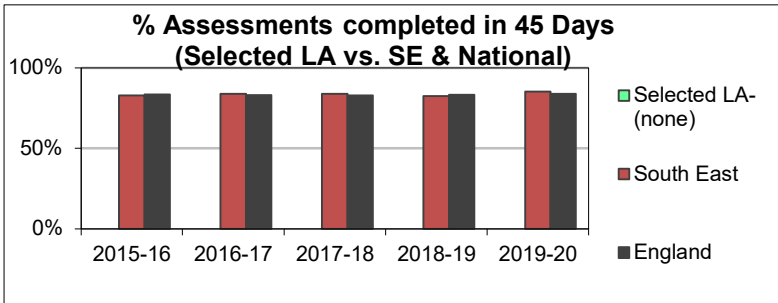

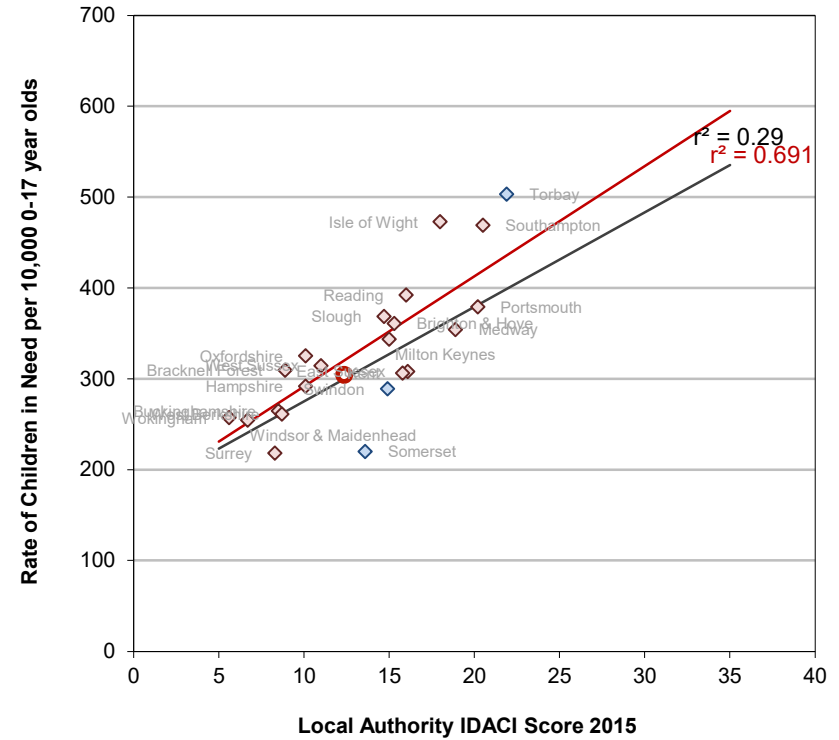

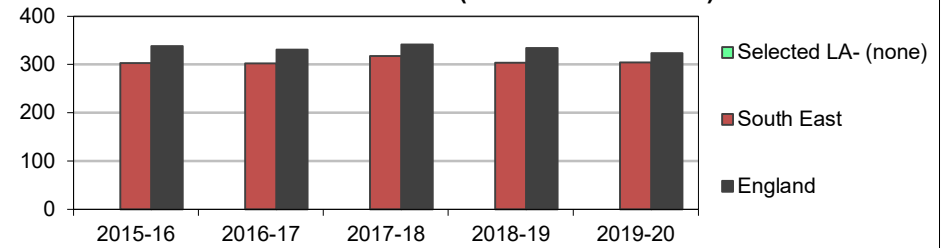
**Rate of Children in Need, per 10,000 0-17 year olds**



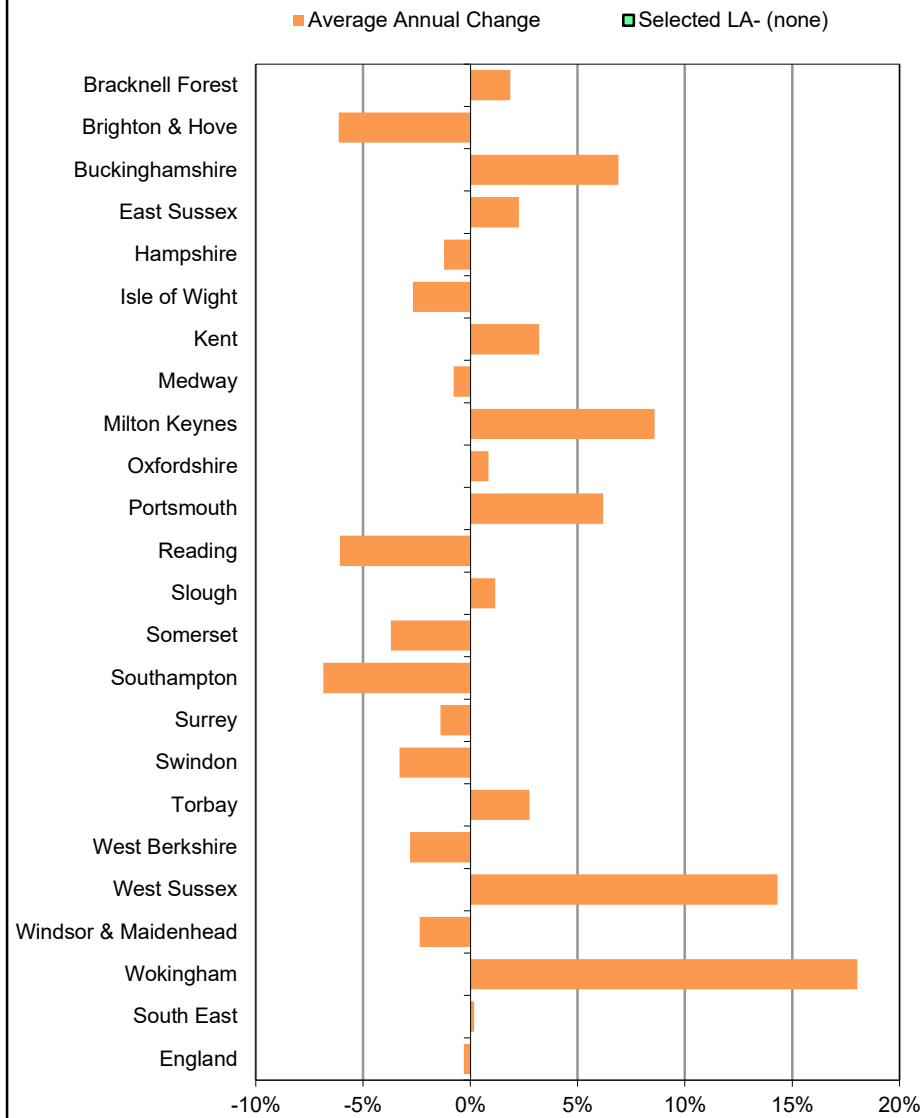
**Rate of Children in Need vs. IDACI**



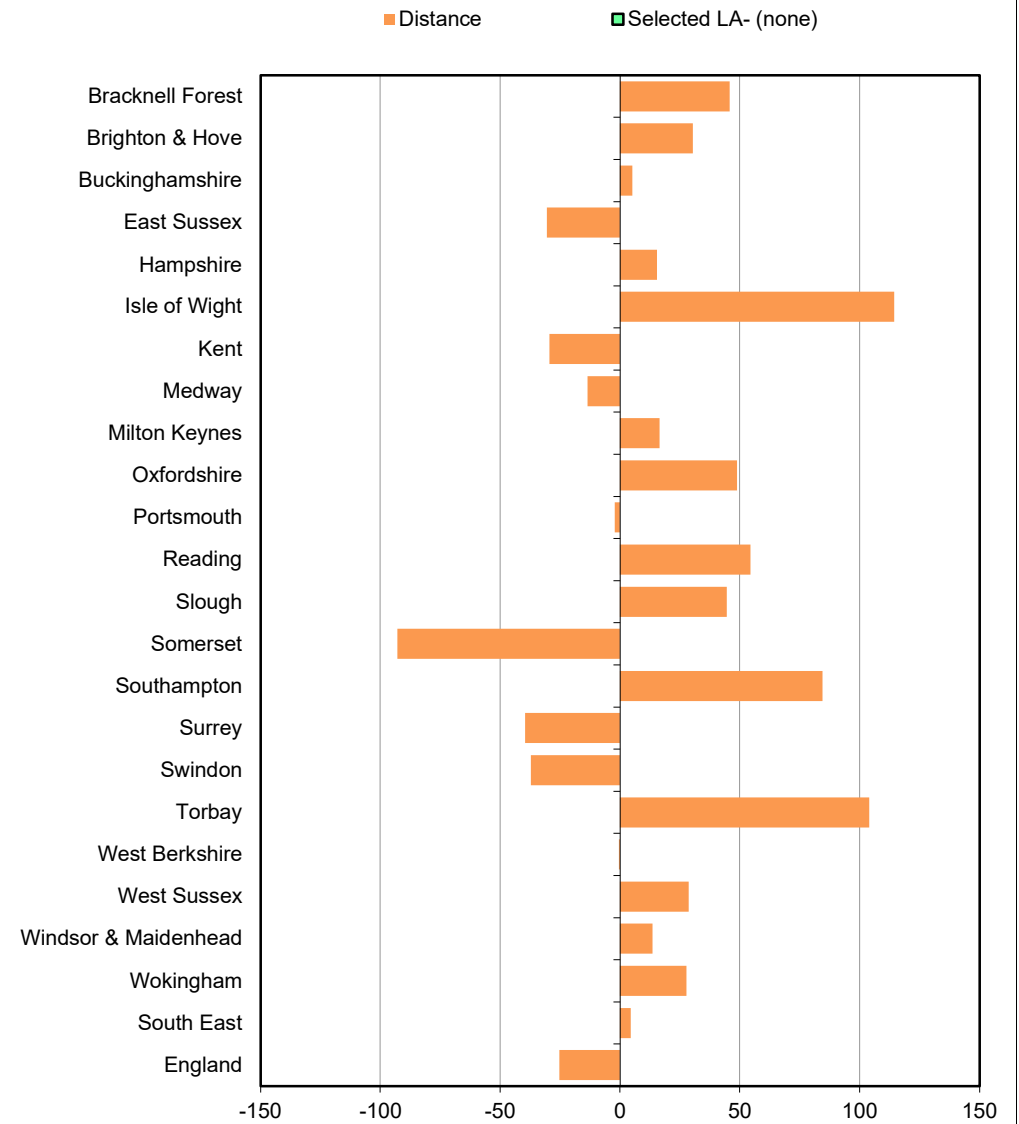
**Rate of Children in Need (Selected LA vs. SE)**

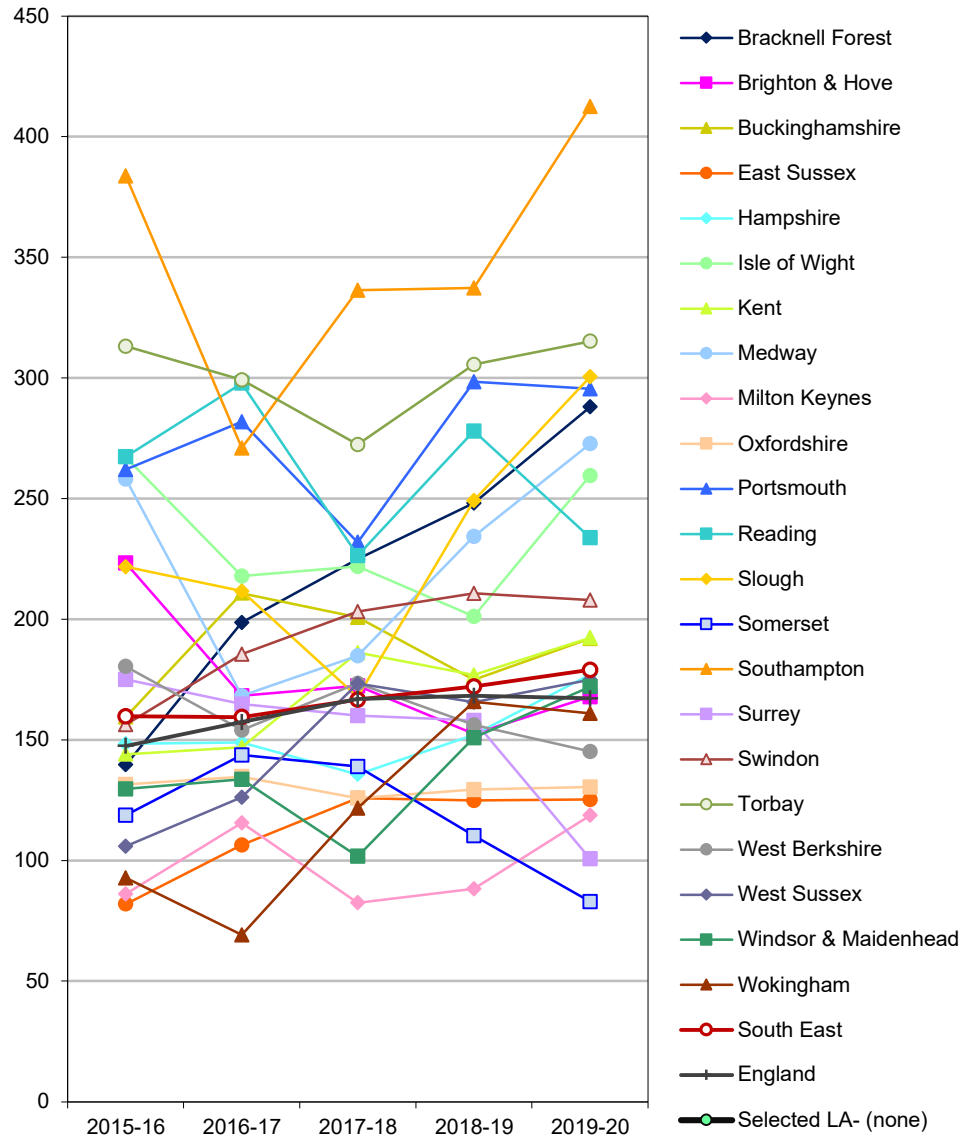

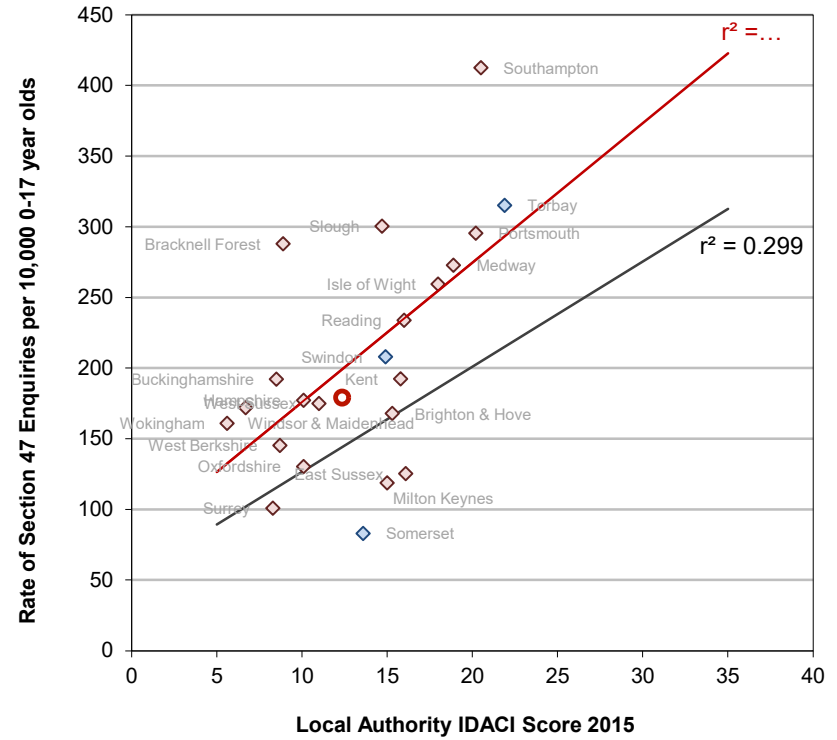

**Rate of Section 47 Enquiries, per 10,000 0-17 year olds**

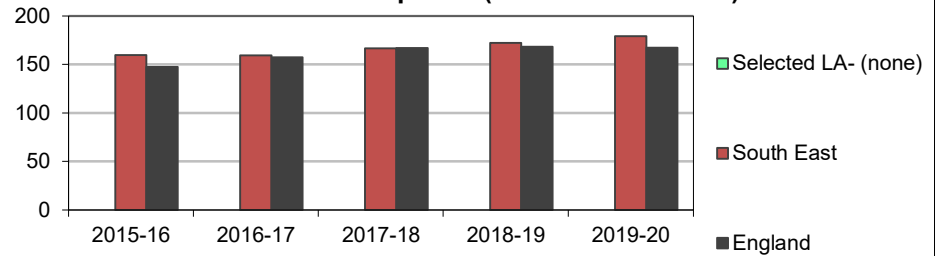


**Rate of Section 47 Enquiries vs. IDACI**

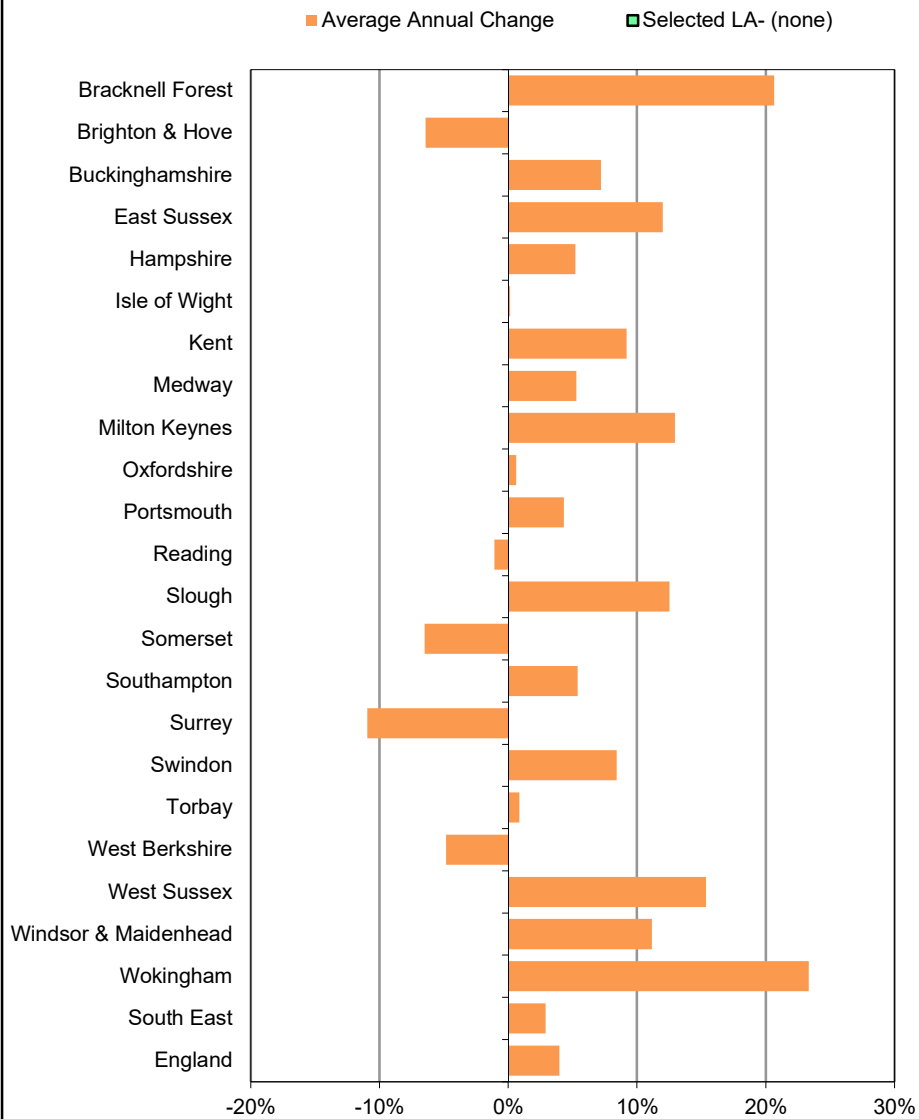

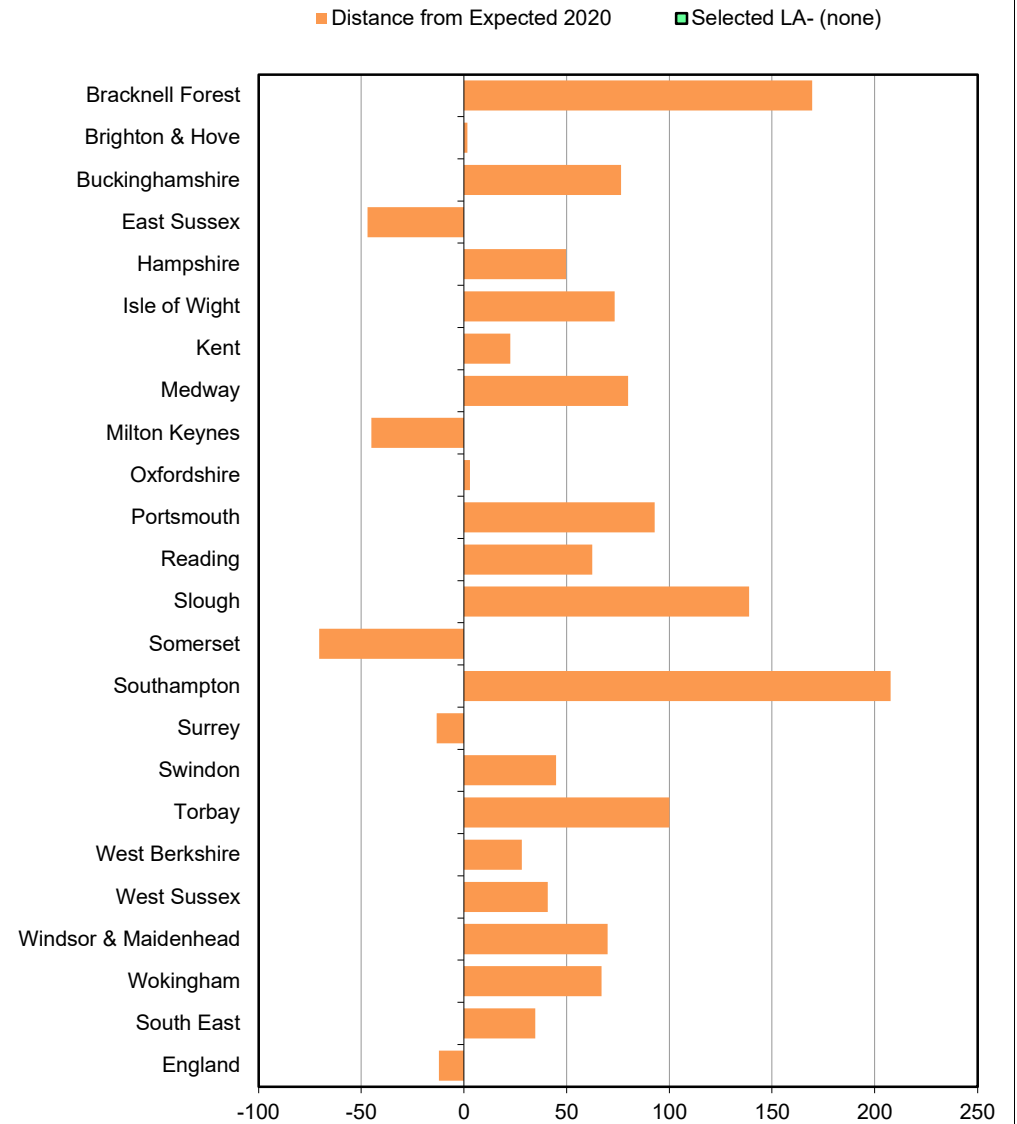
**Rate of Section 47 Enquiries (Selected LA vs. SE)**

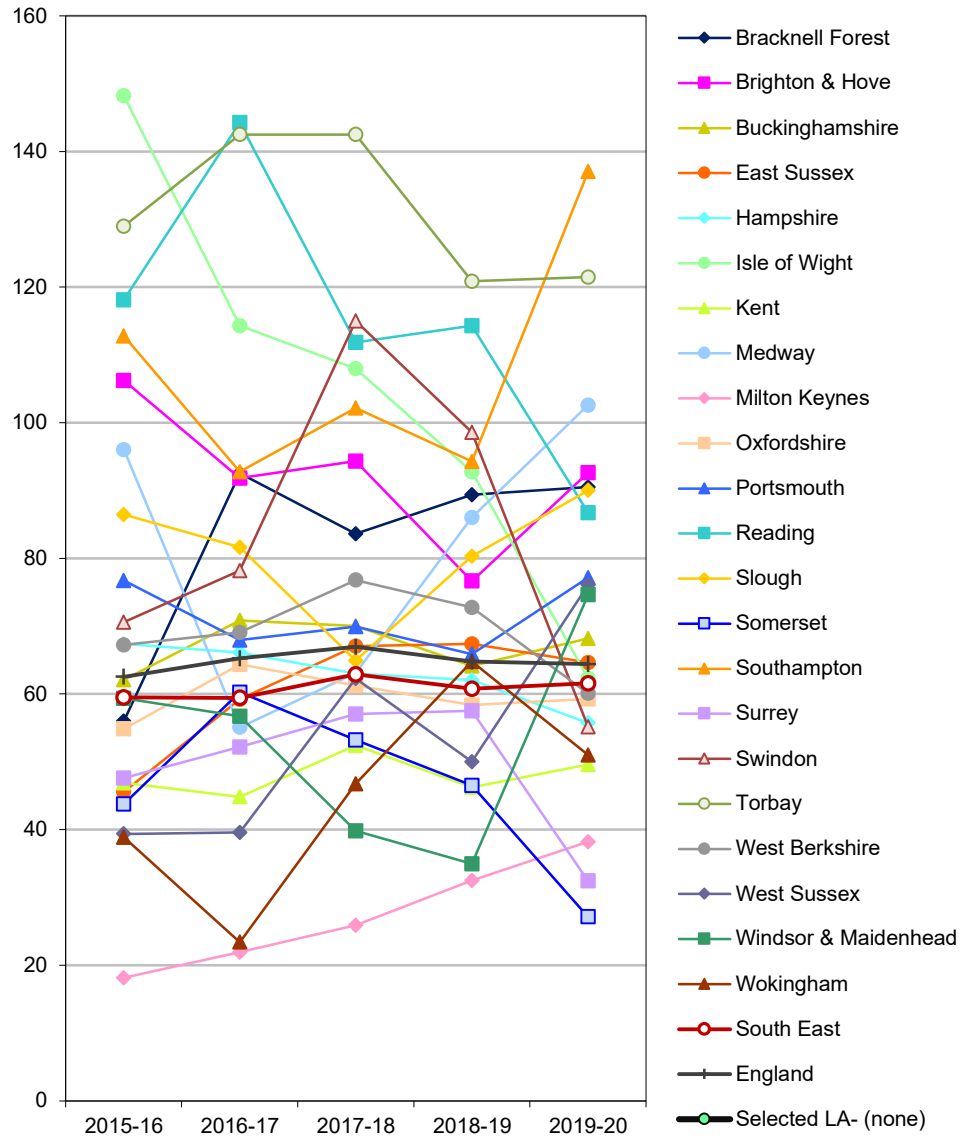

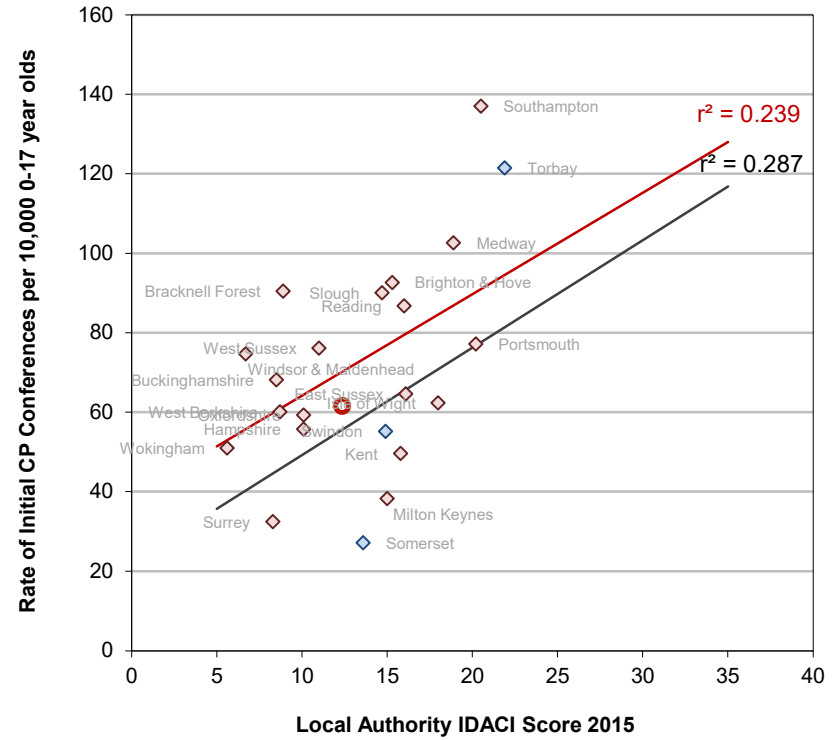

**Rate of Initial CP Conferences, per 10,000 0-17 year olds**

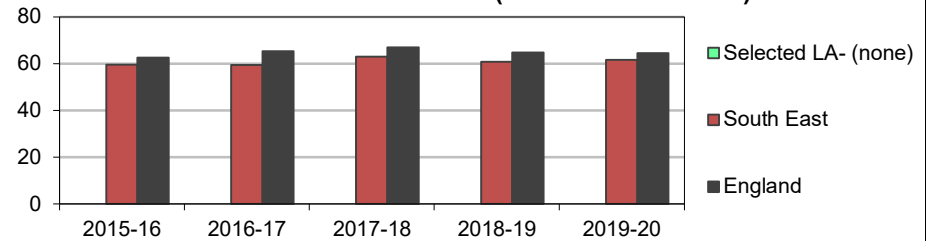


**Rate of Initial CP Conferences vs. IDACI**

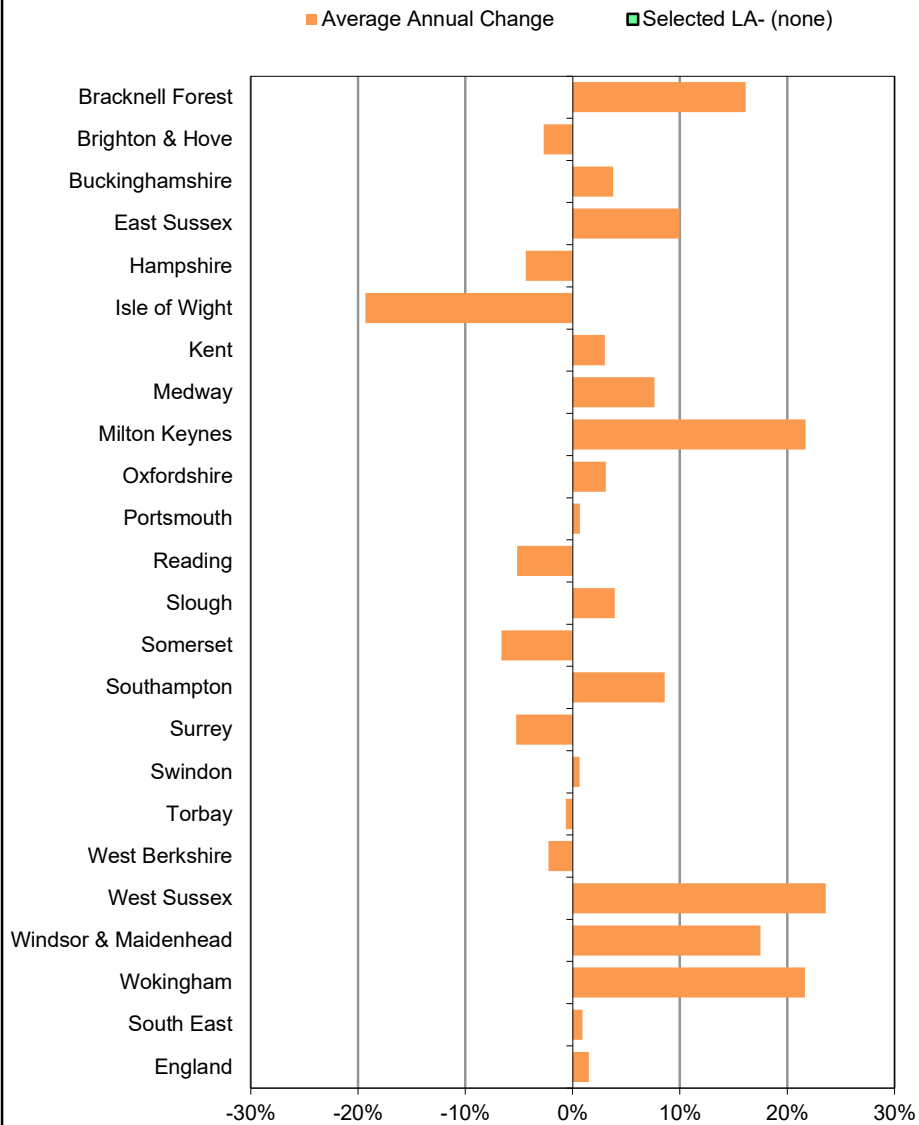

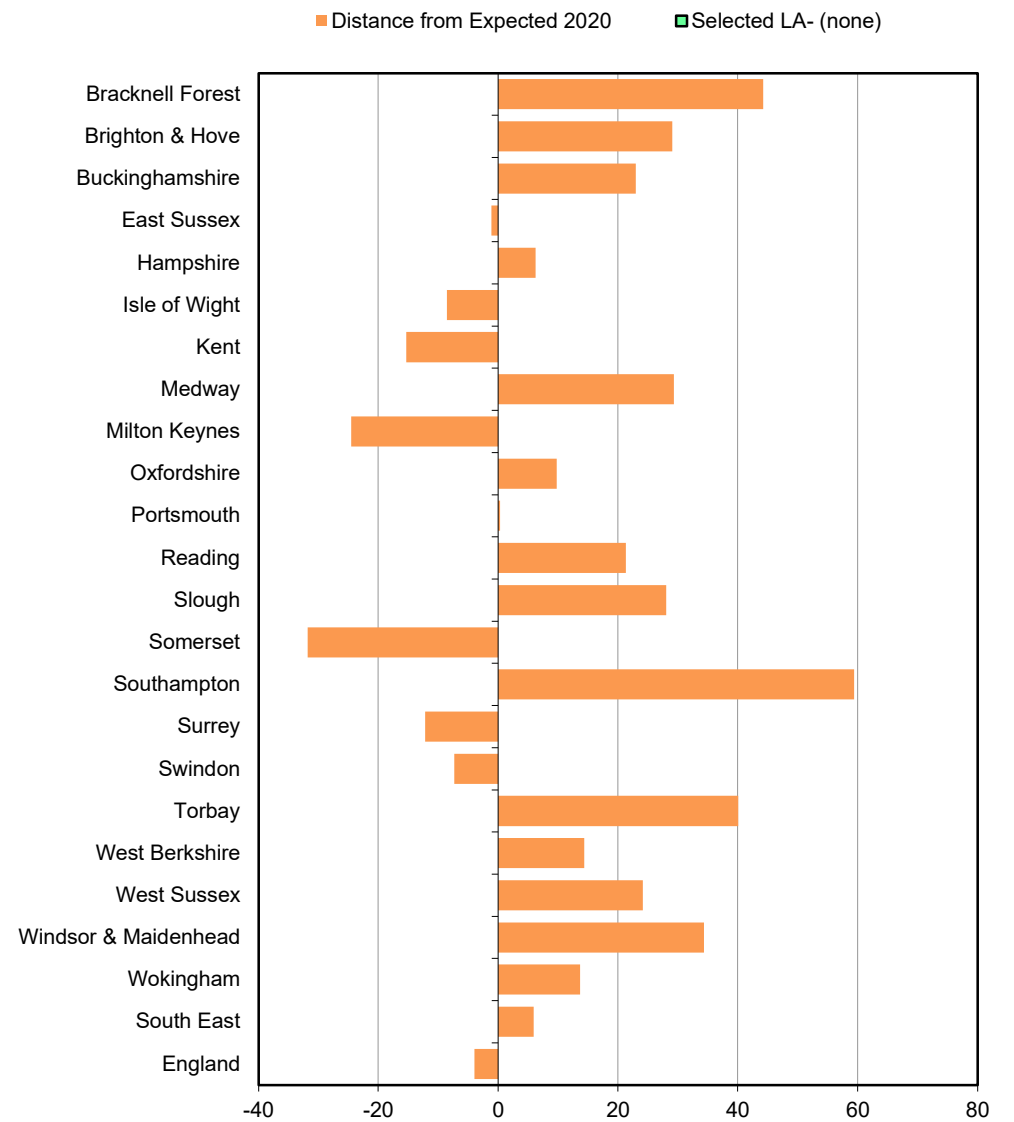
**Rate of Initial CP Conferences (Selected LA vs. SE)**



### Average Annual Change in Number of Initial CP Conferences



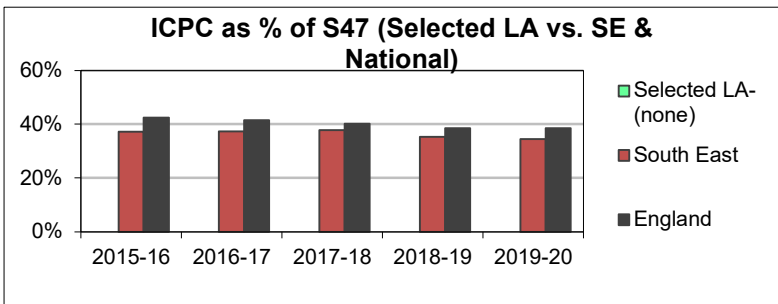
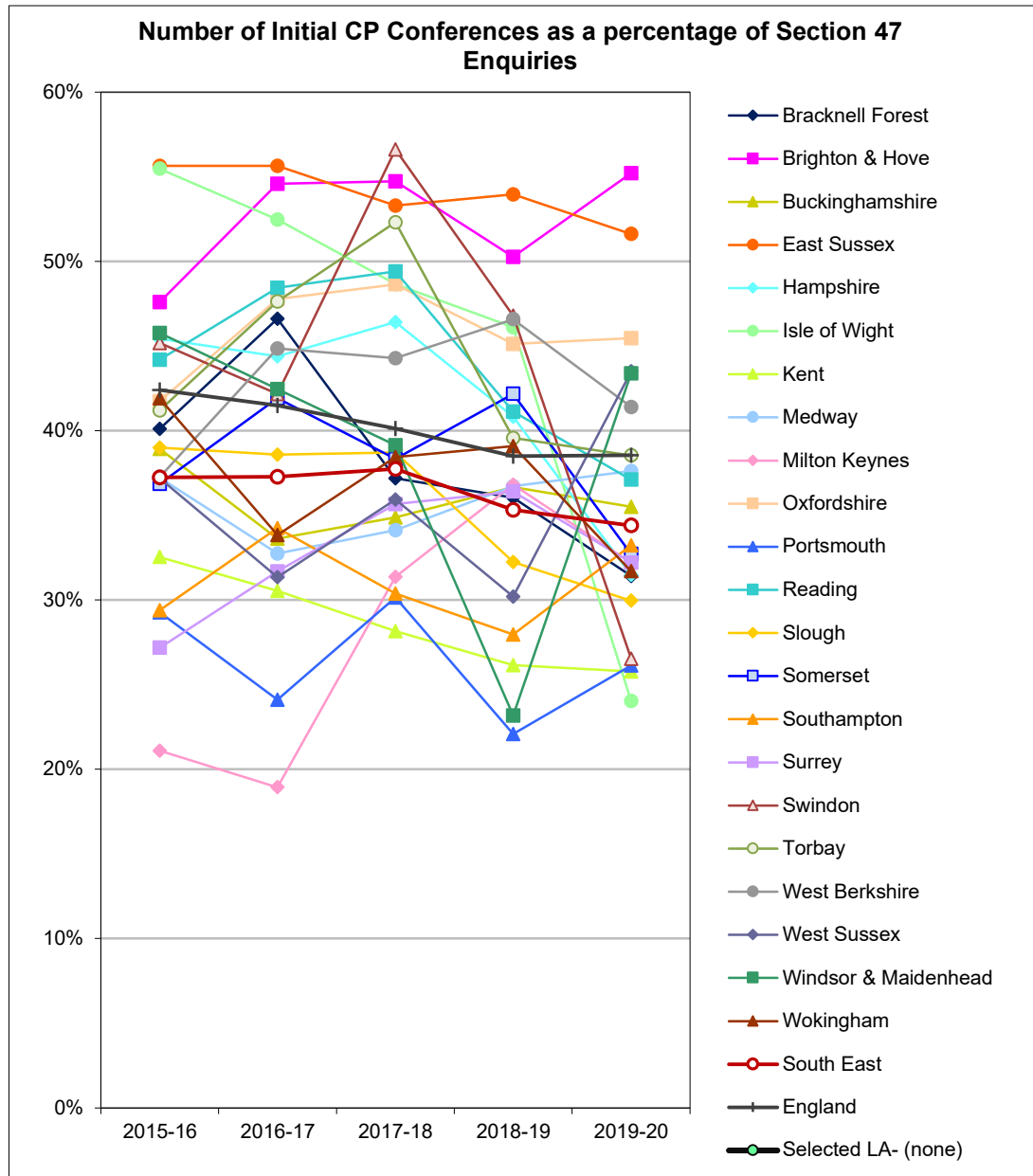

**Rate of Child Protection Plans, per 10,000 0-17 year olds**

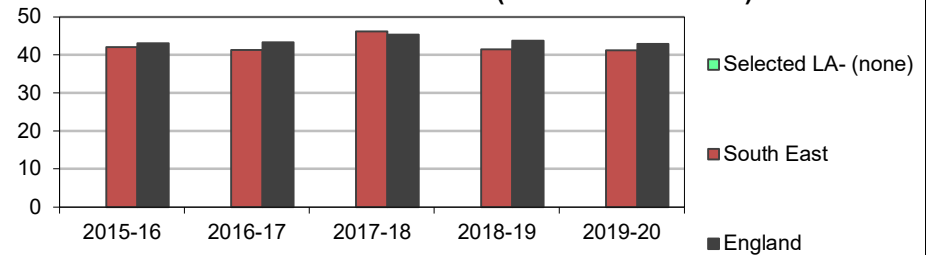


**Rate of Child Protection Plans vs. IDACI**

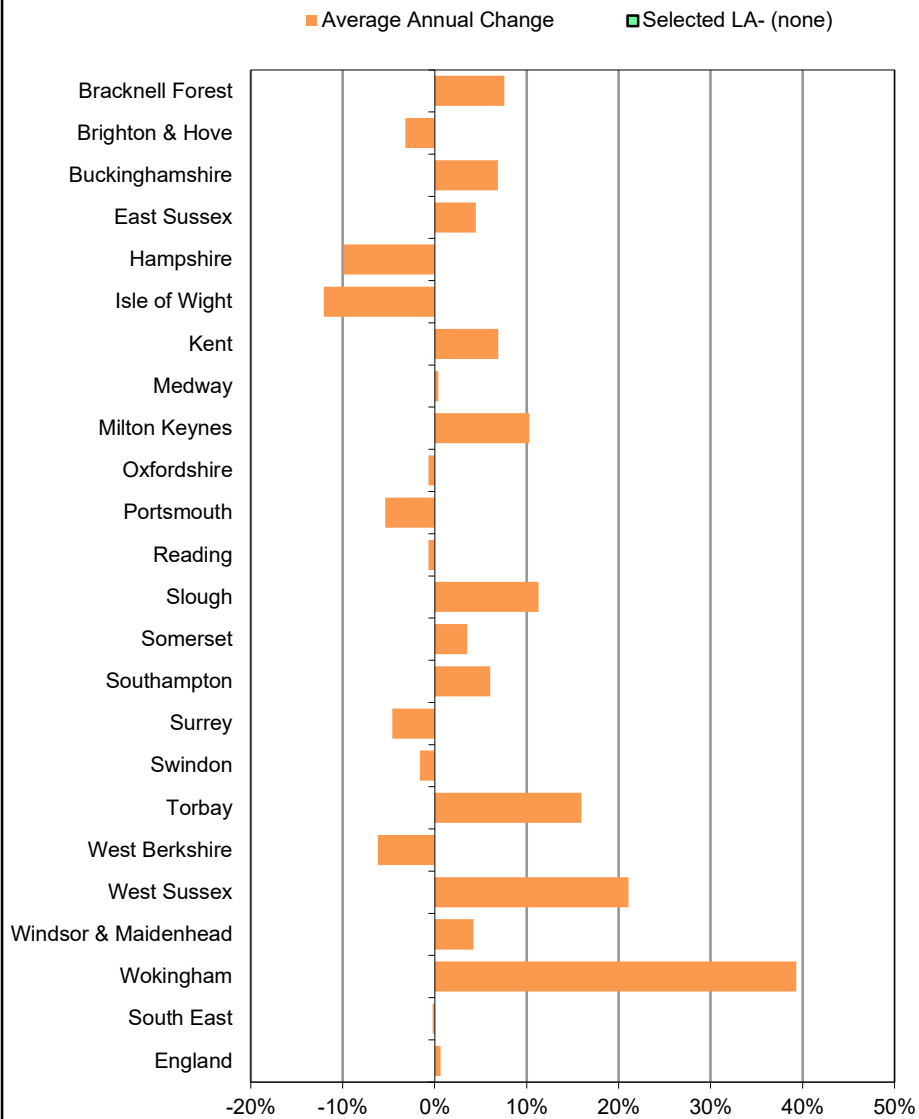

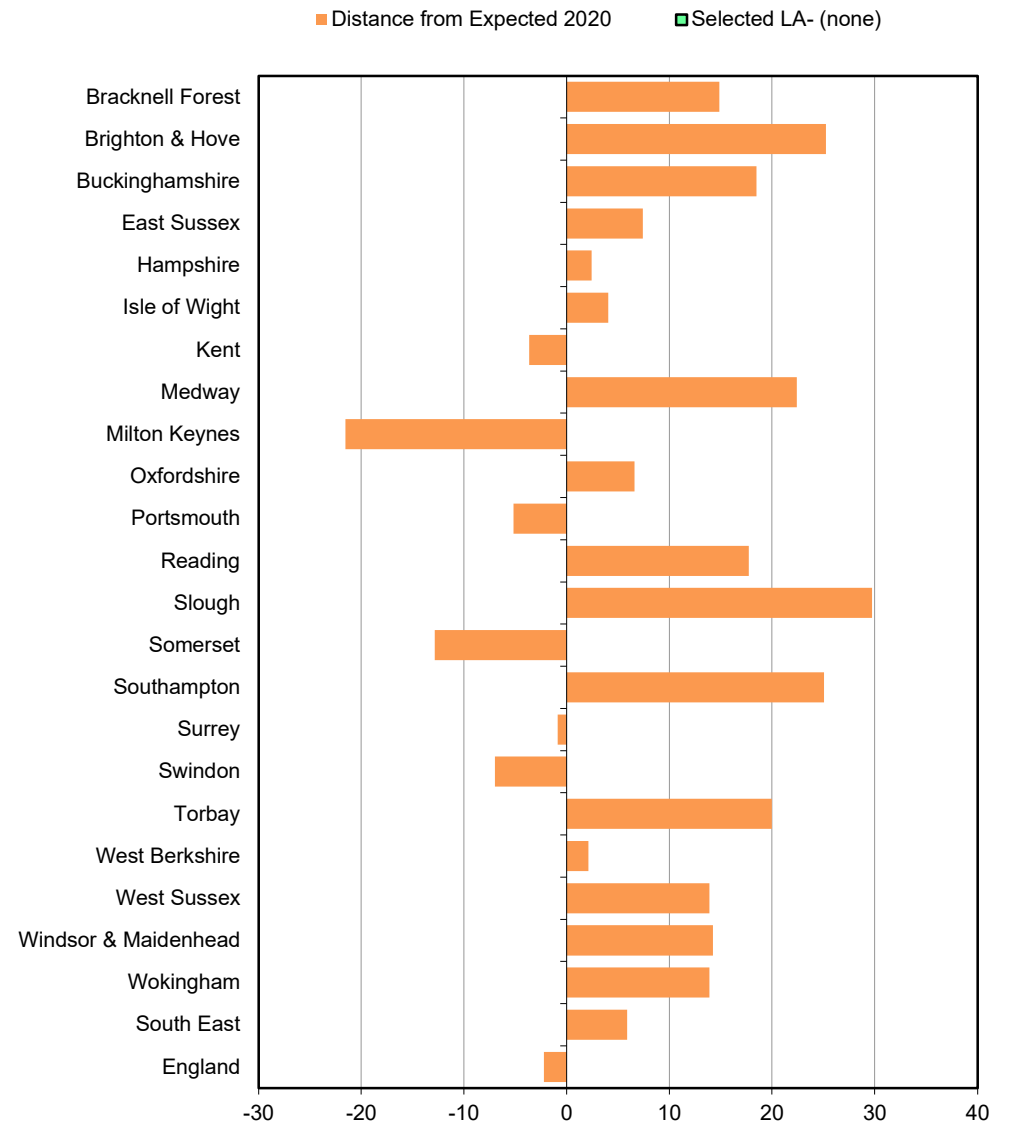
**Rate of Child Protection Plans (Selected LA vs. SE)**

**% CPP Reviews in Timescales (Selected LA vs. SE & National)**

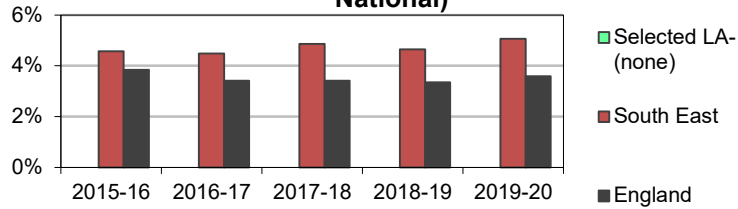

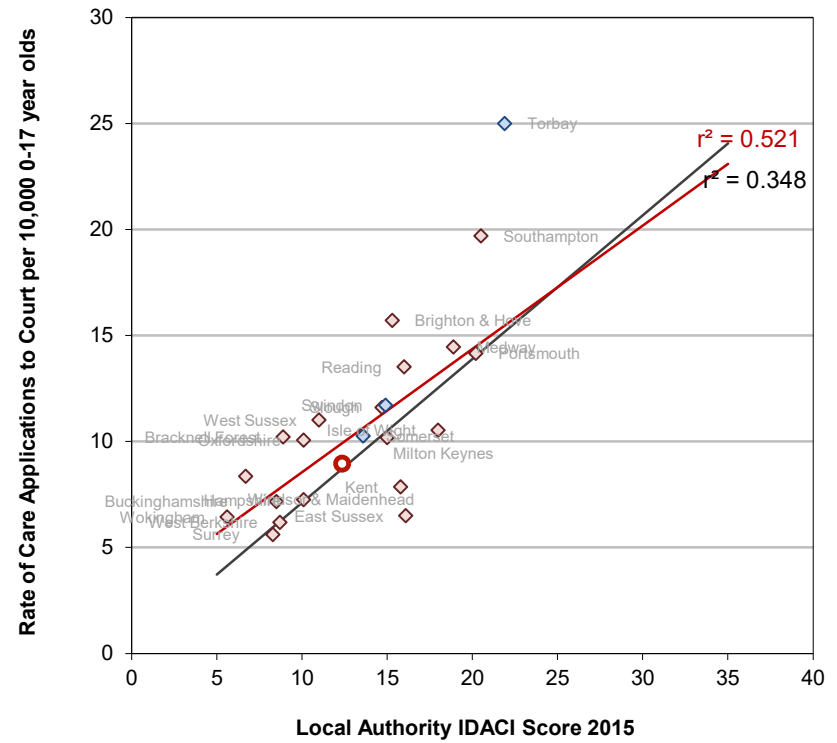

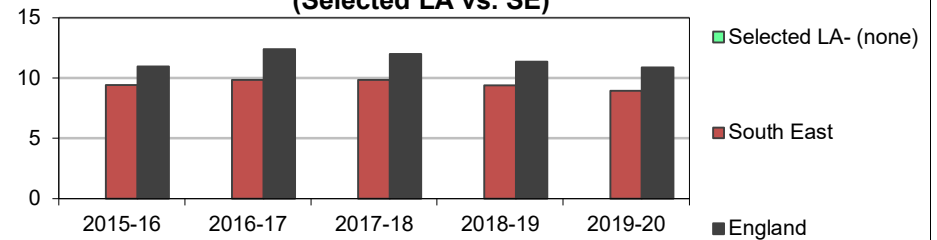


**Rate of Care Applications to Court vs. IDACI**

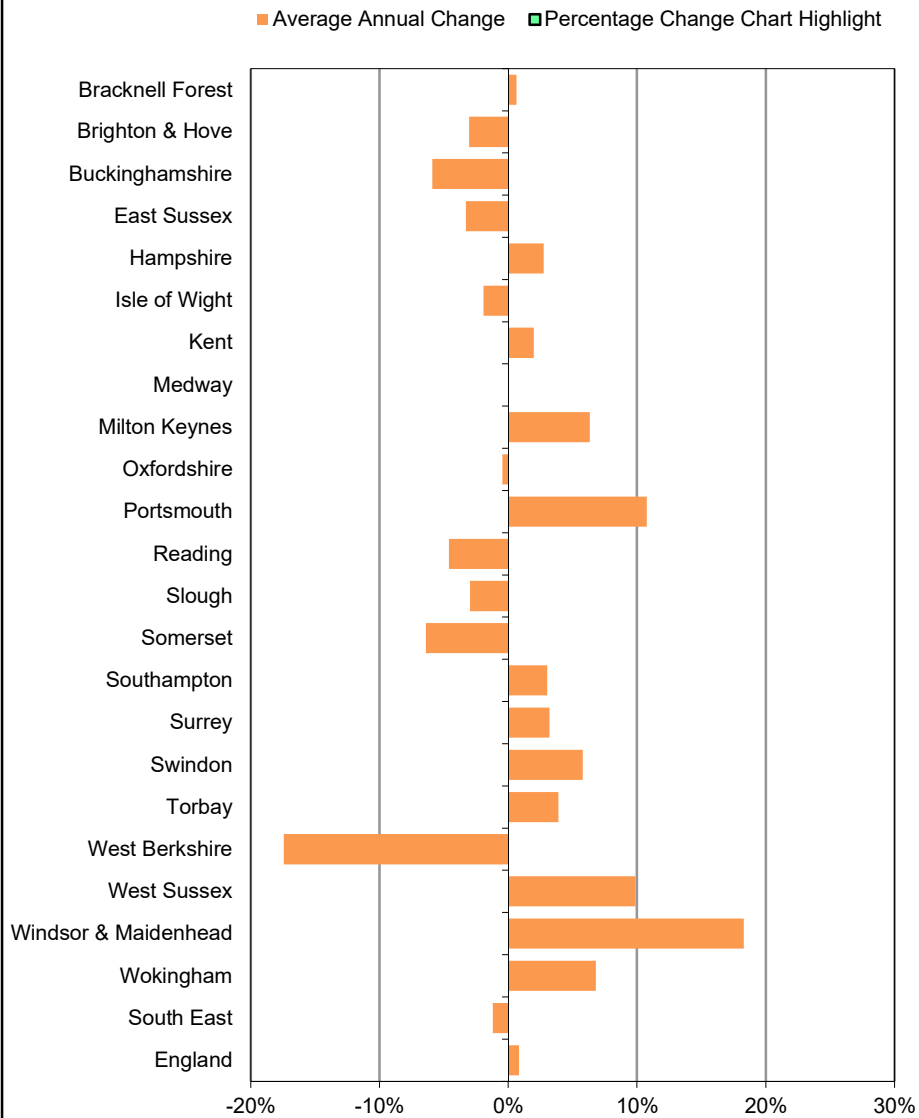

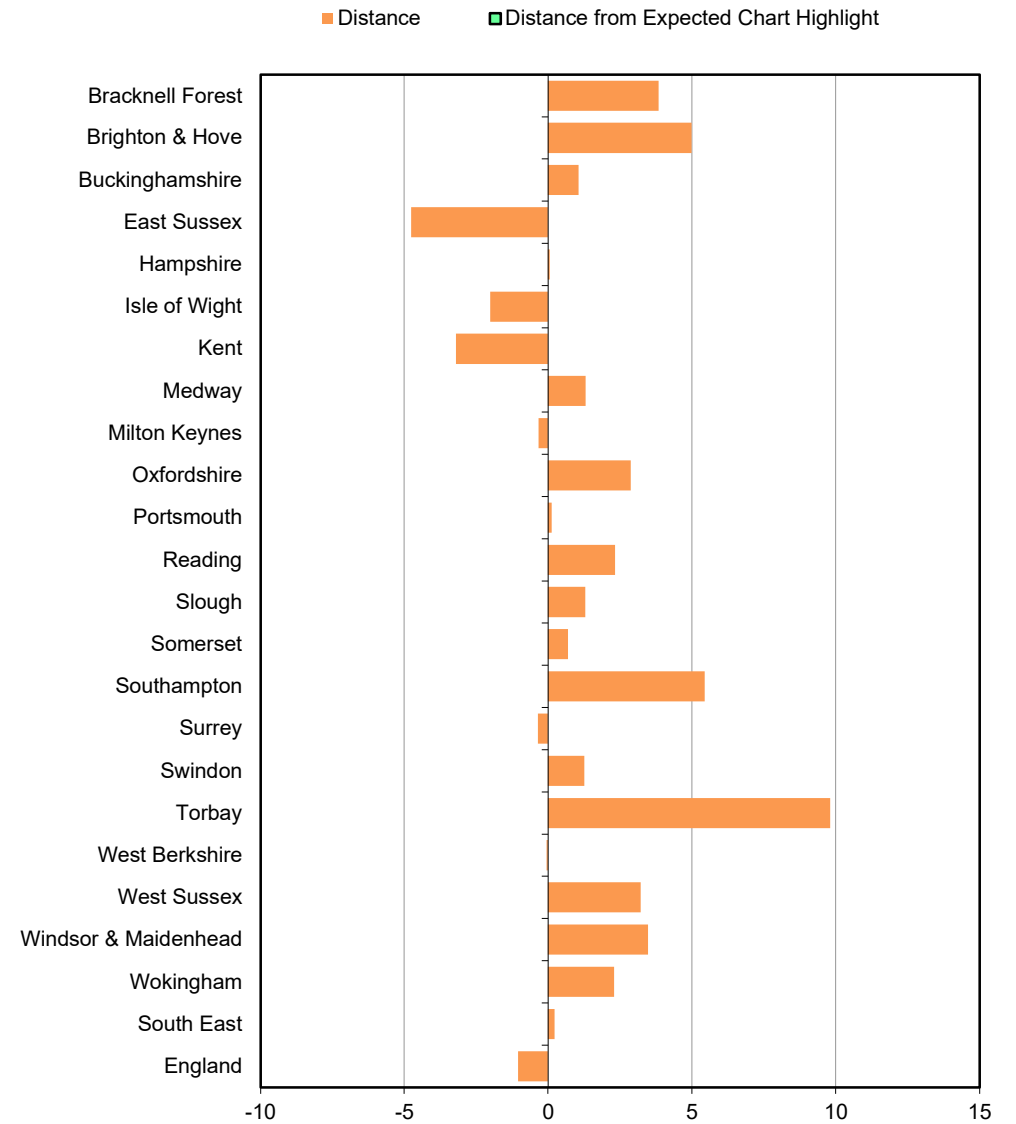
**Rate of Care Applications to Court (Selected LA vs. SE)**

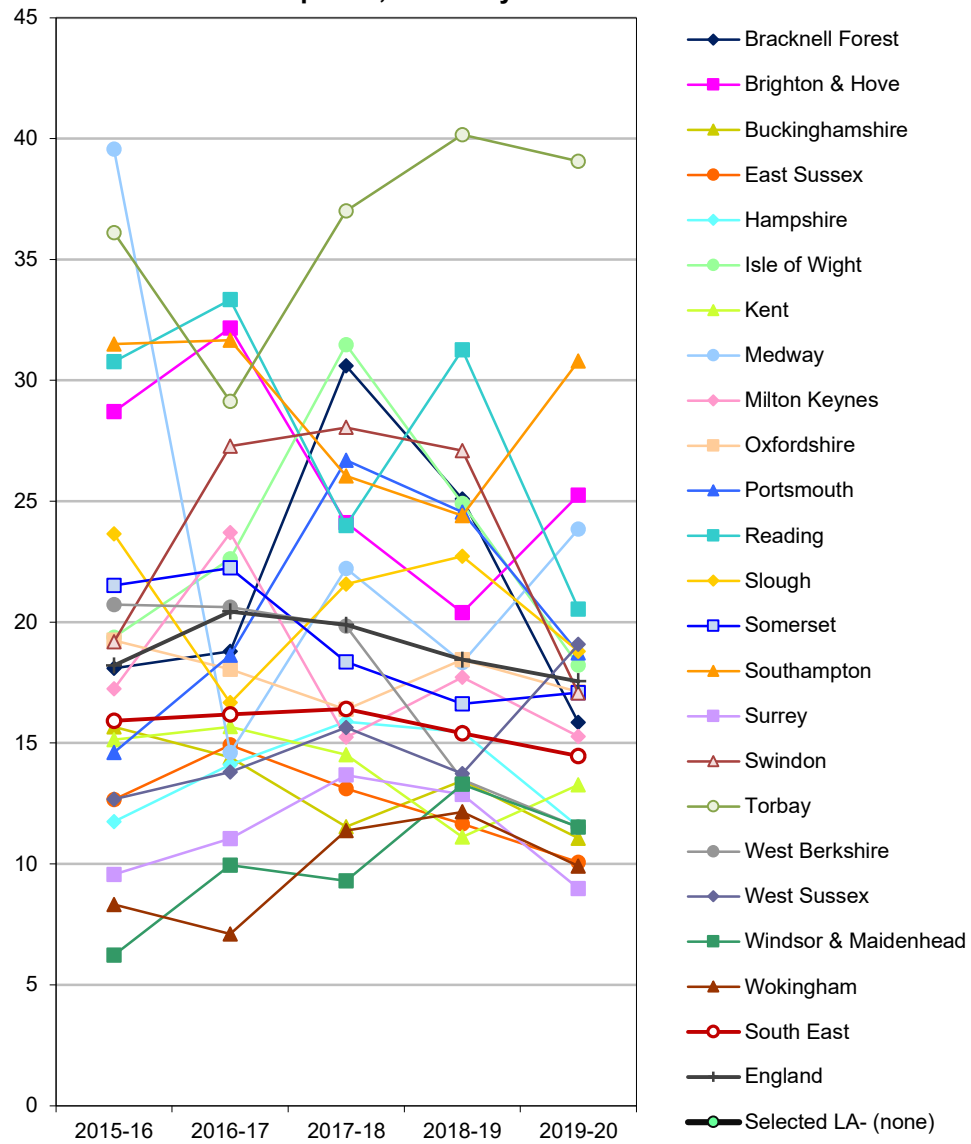

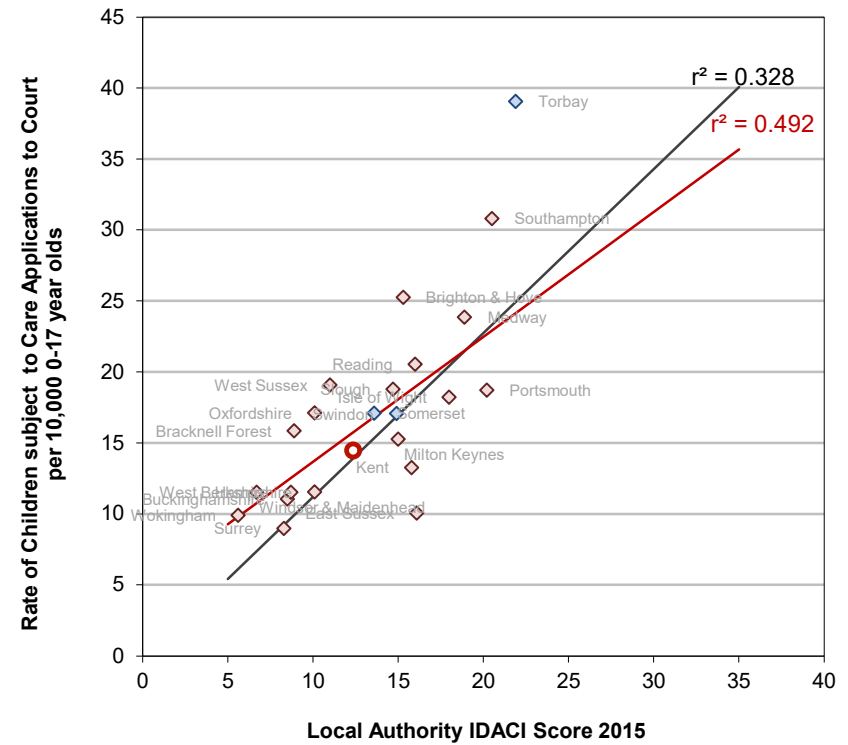

**Rate of Children subject to Care Applications to Court, per 10,000 0-17 year olds**

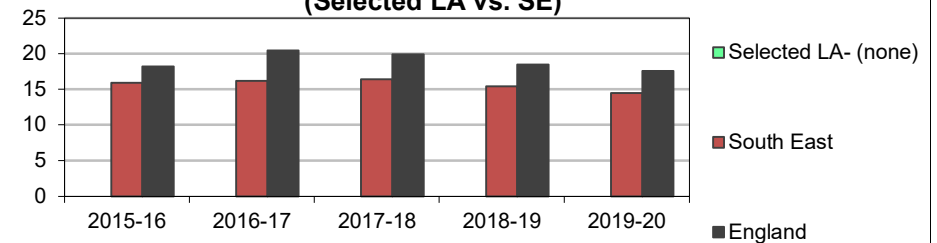


**Rate of Children subject to Care Applications to Court vs. IDACI**



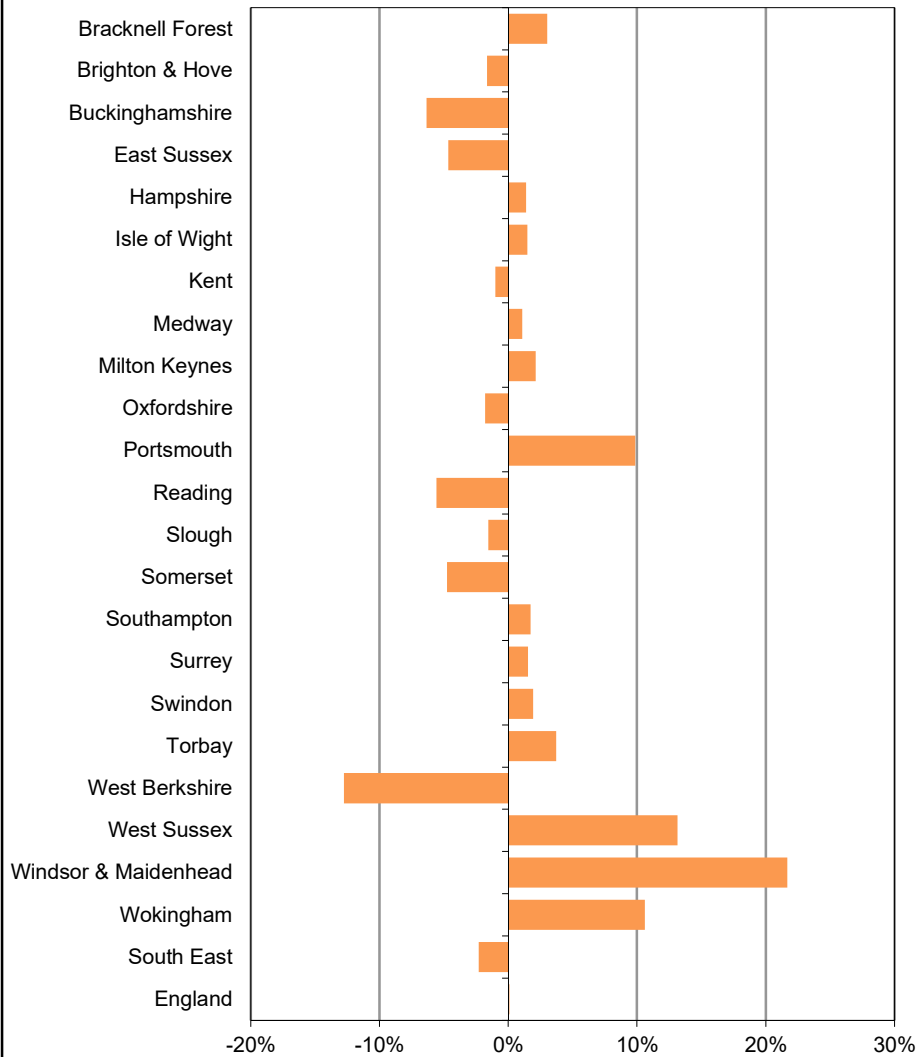

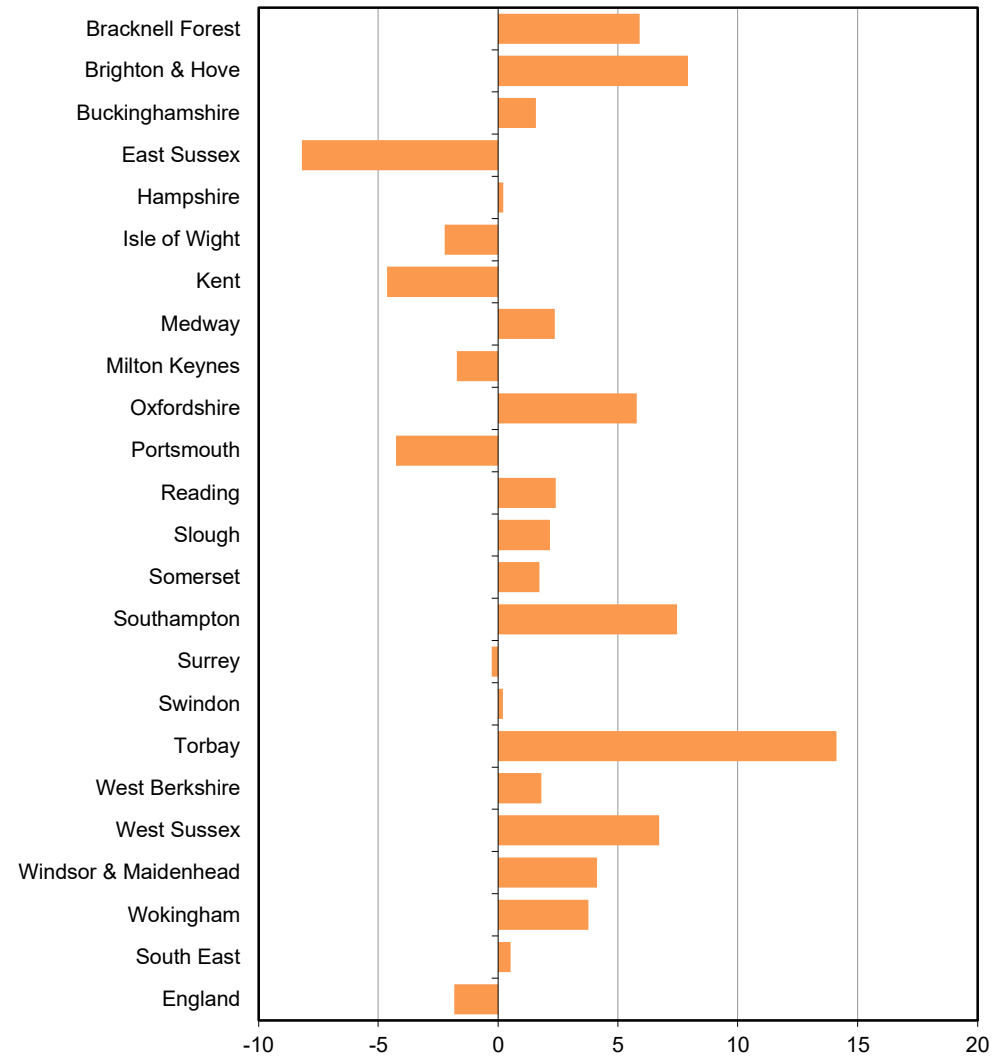
### Average Annual Change in Number of Children subject to Care Applications to Court during the year ending 31st March

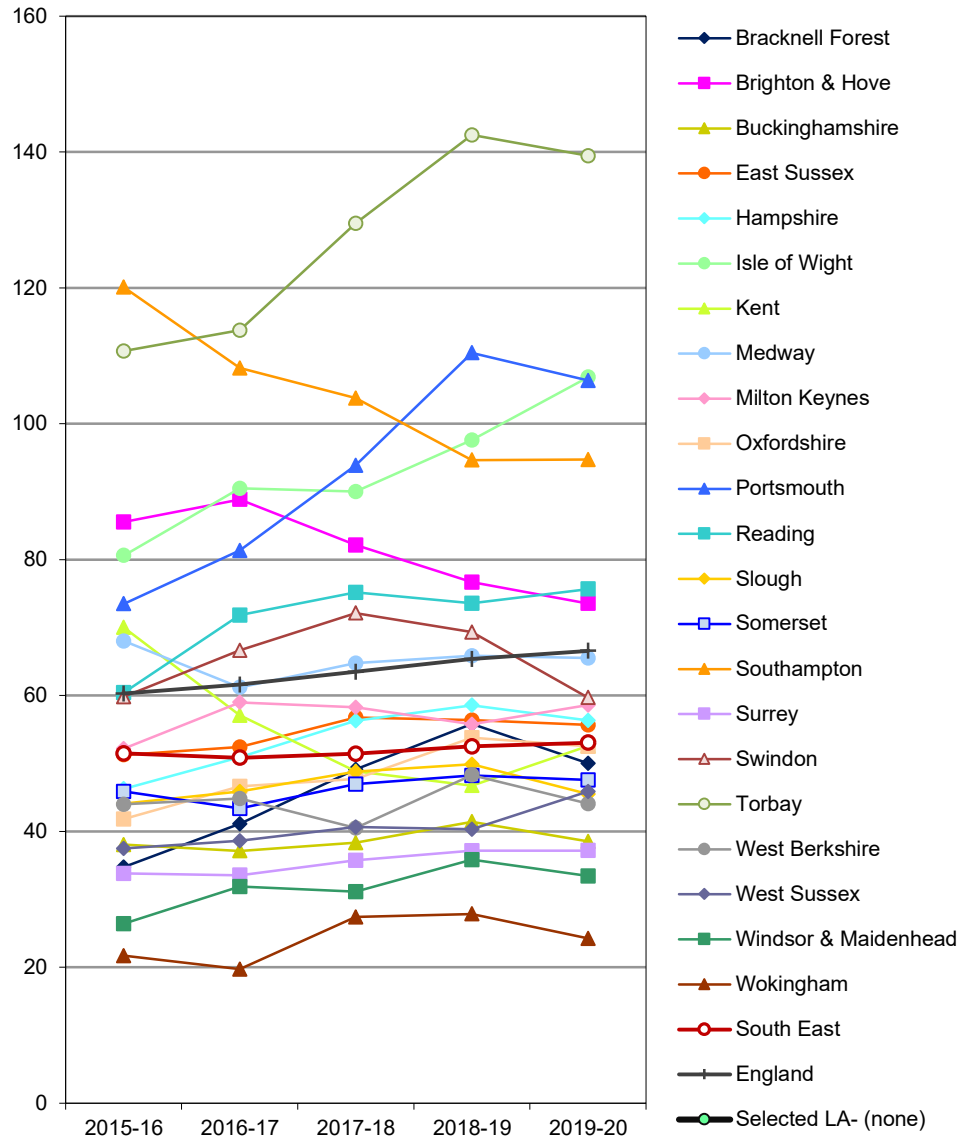

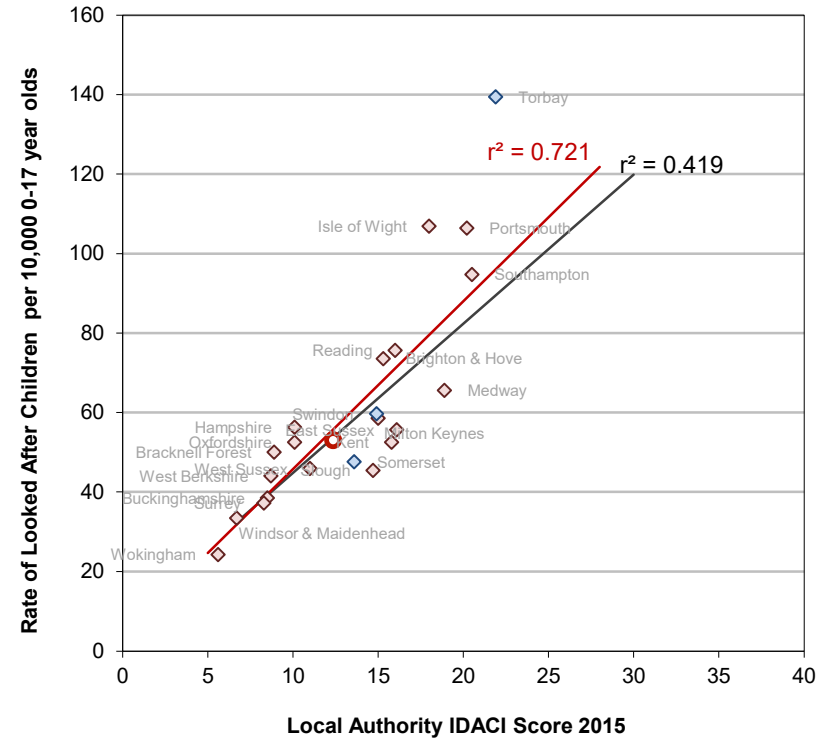

**Rate of Looked After Children, per 10,000 0-17 year olds**

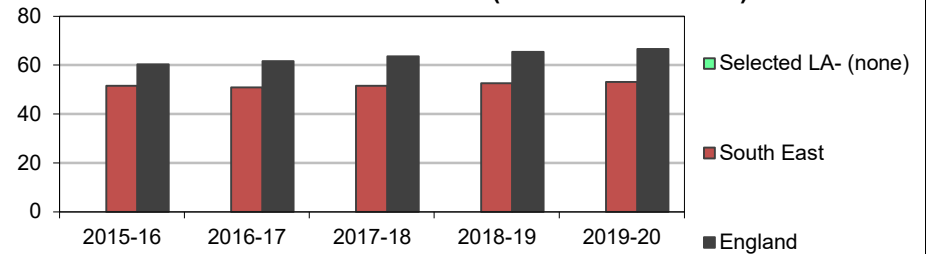


**Rate of Looked After Children vs. IDACI**

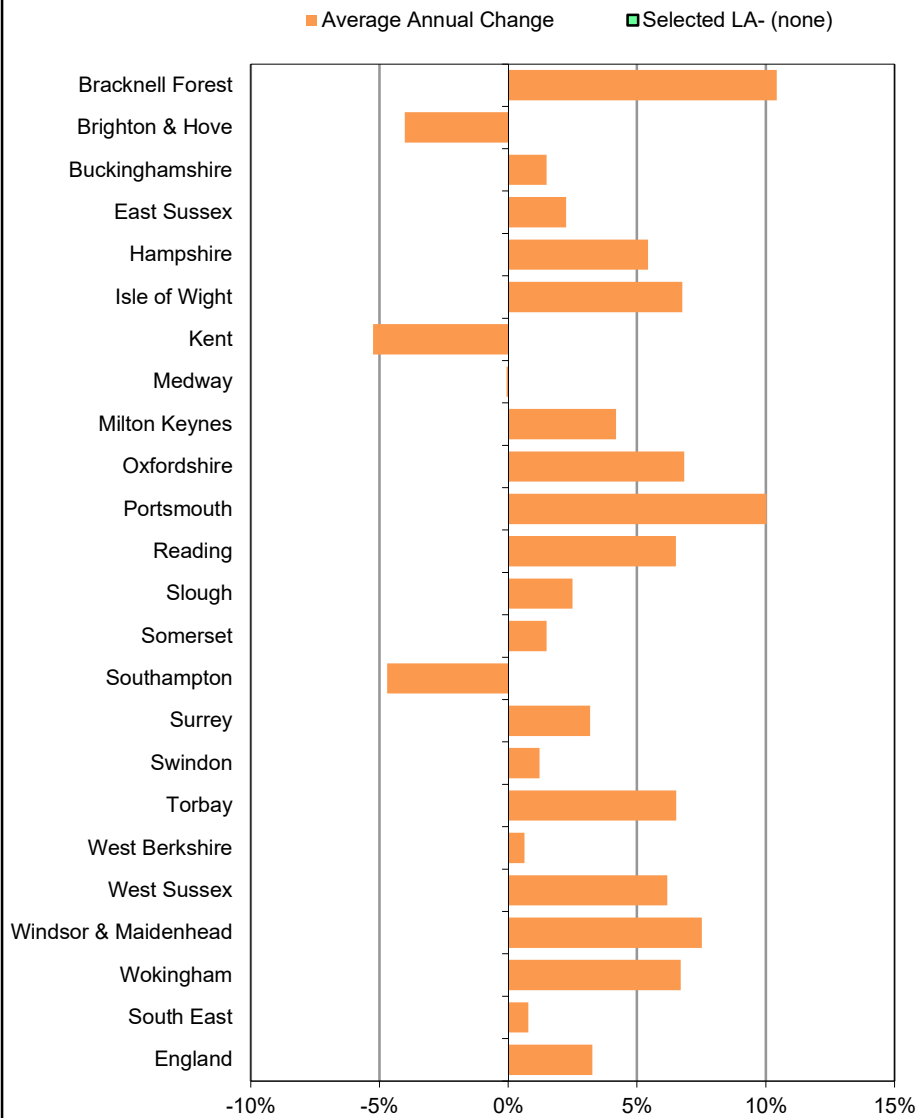

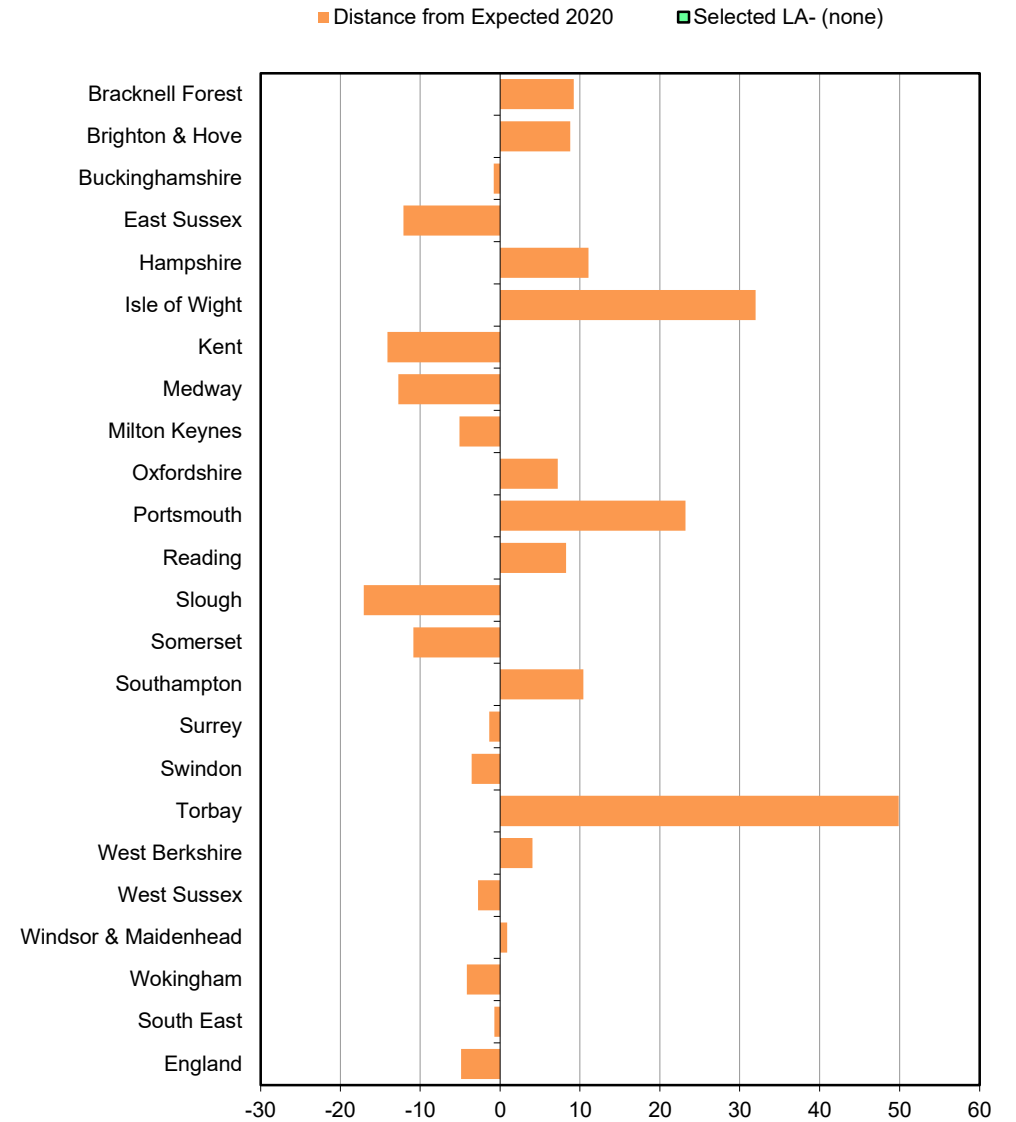
**Rate of Looked After Children (Selected LA vs. SE)**



### Average Annual Change in Number of Looked After Children



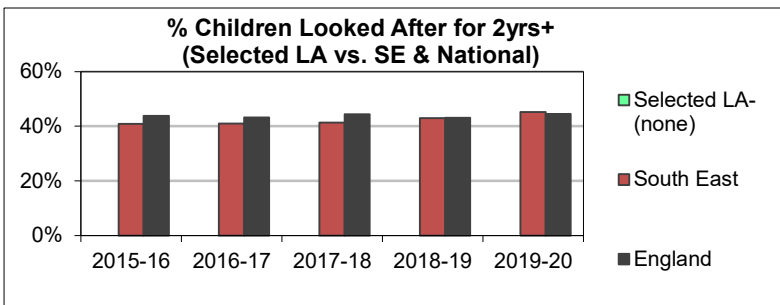

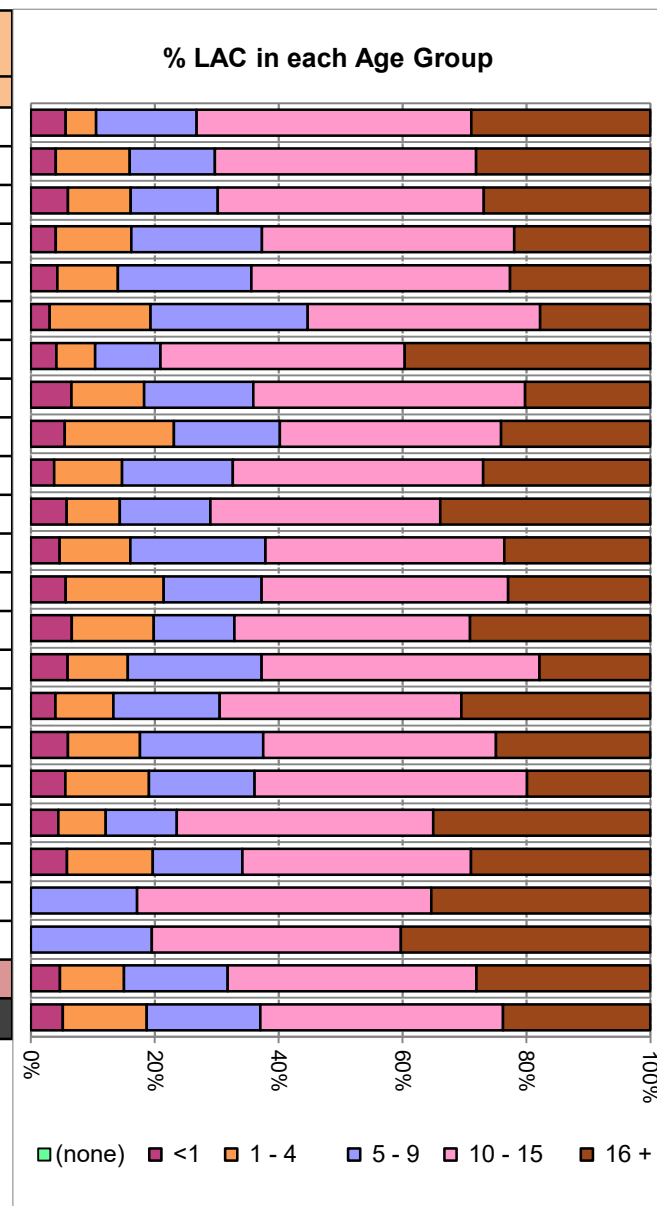

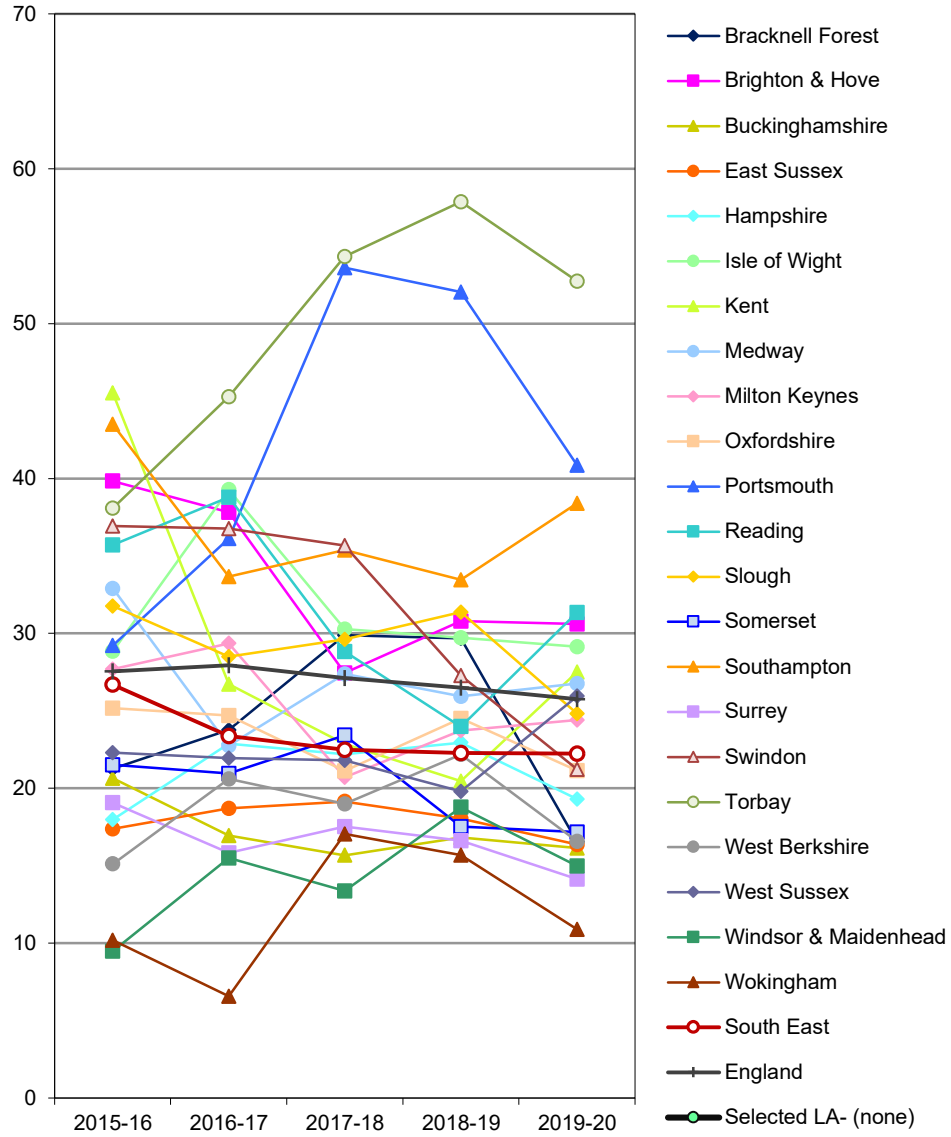

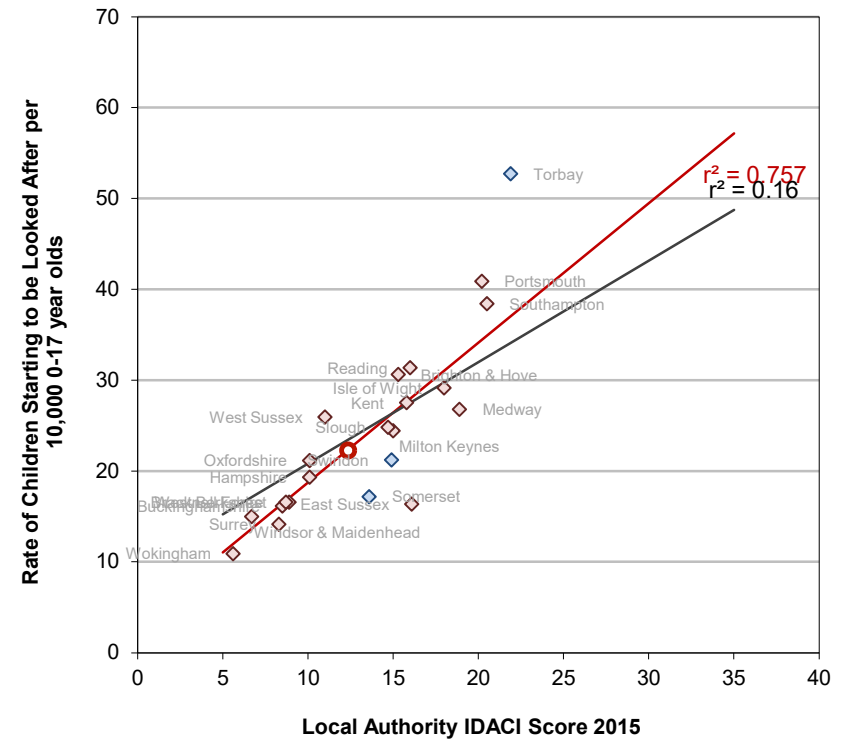

**Rate of Children Starting to be Looked After, per 10,000 0-17 year olds**

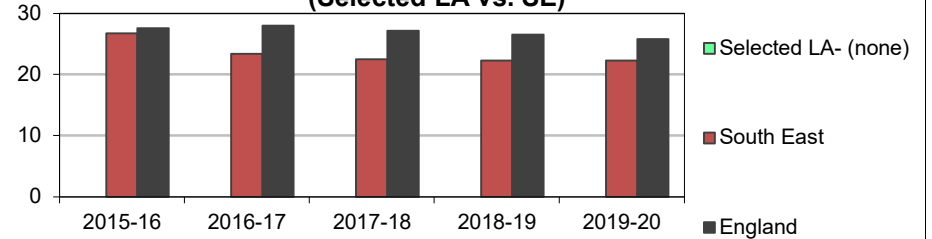


**Rate of Children Starting to be Looked After vs. IDACI**

### Rate of Children Ceasing to be Looked After, per 10,000 0-17 year olds

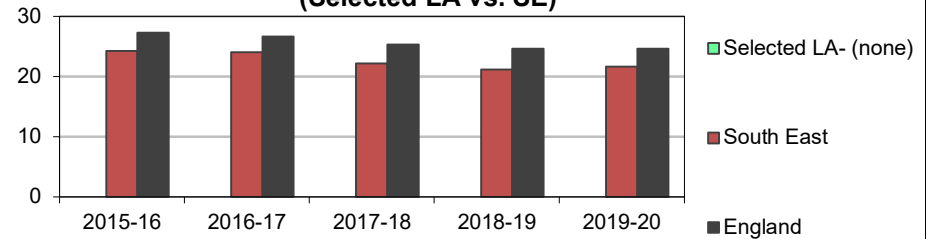


### Rate of Children Ceasing to be Looked After vs. IDACI

### Rate of Children Ceasing to be Looked After (Selected LA vs. SE)

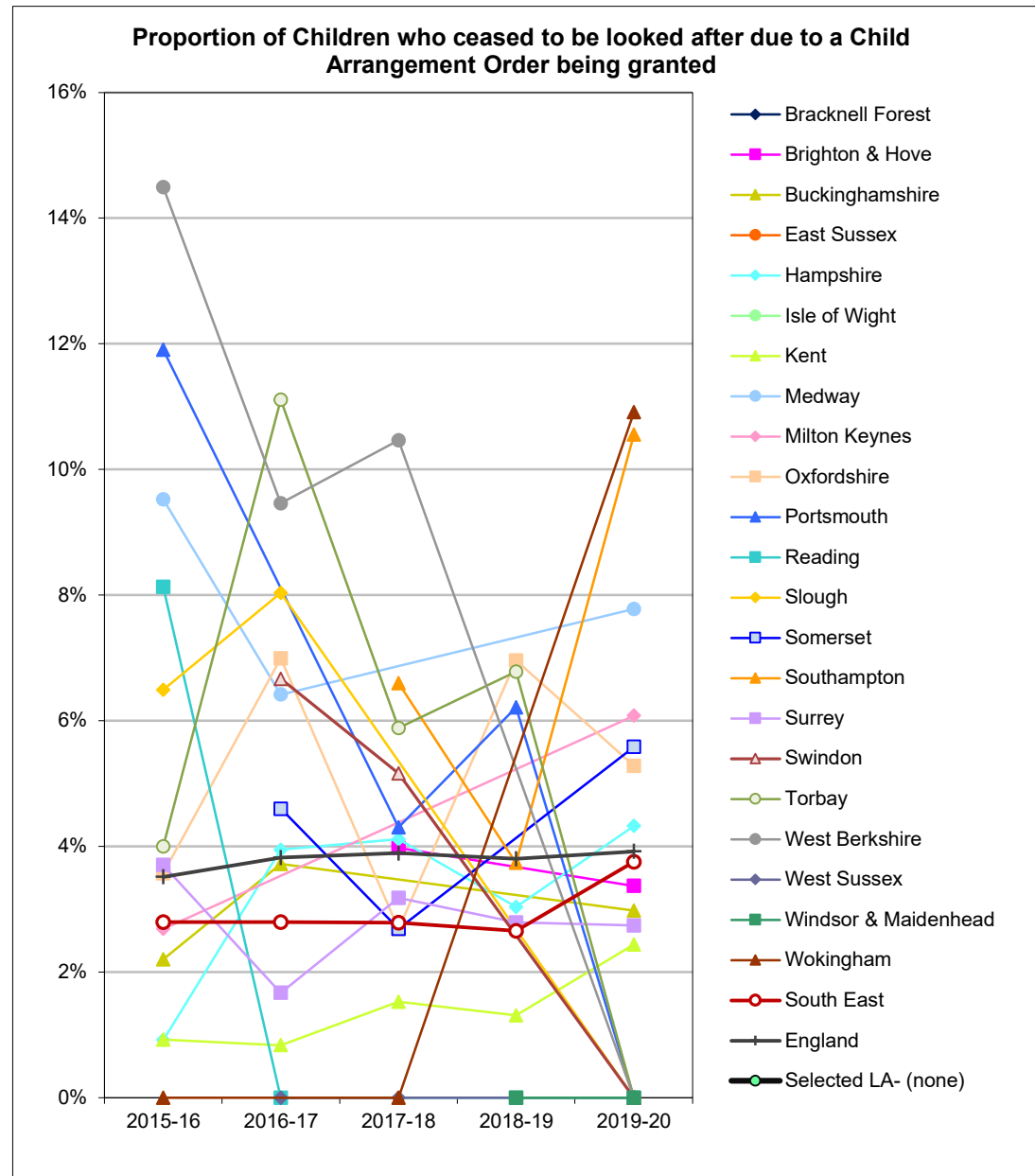
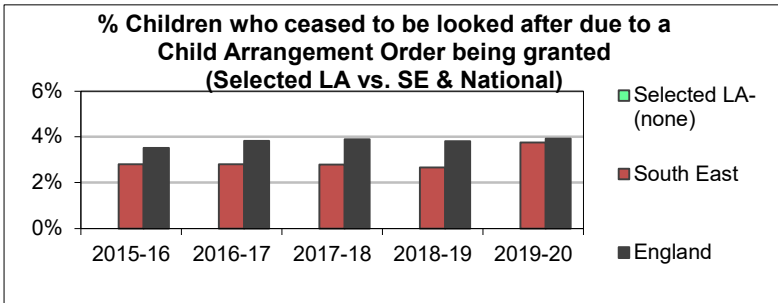

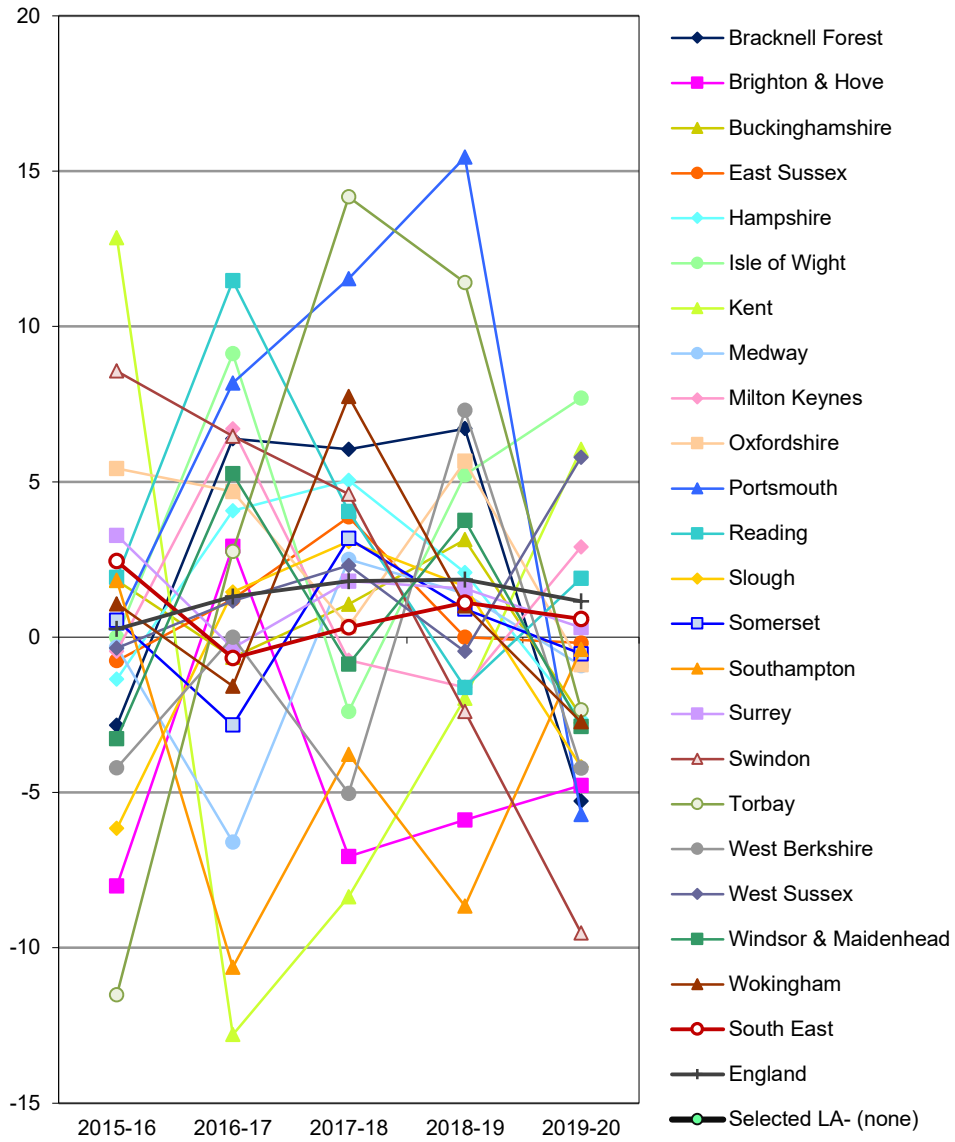

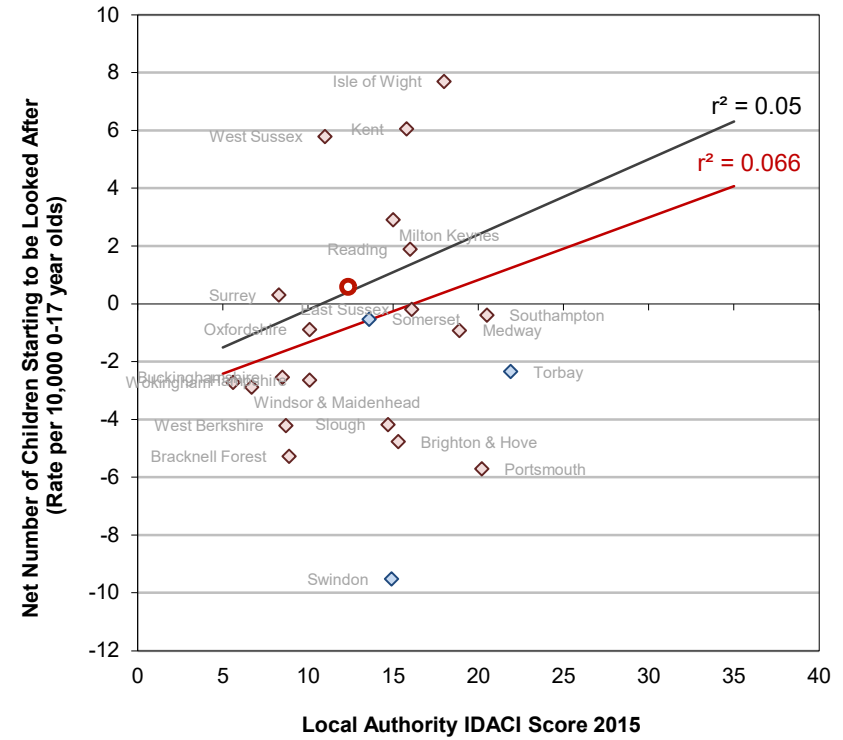

**Net Number of Children Starting to be Looked After, Rate per 10,000 0-17 year olds**

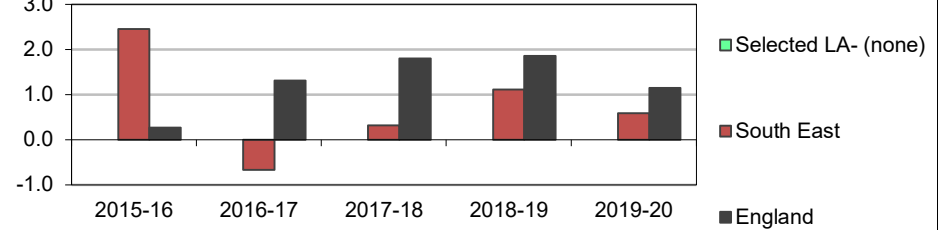


**Net Number of Children Starting to be Looked After (Rate per 10,000 0-17 year olds) vs. IDACI**

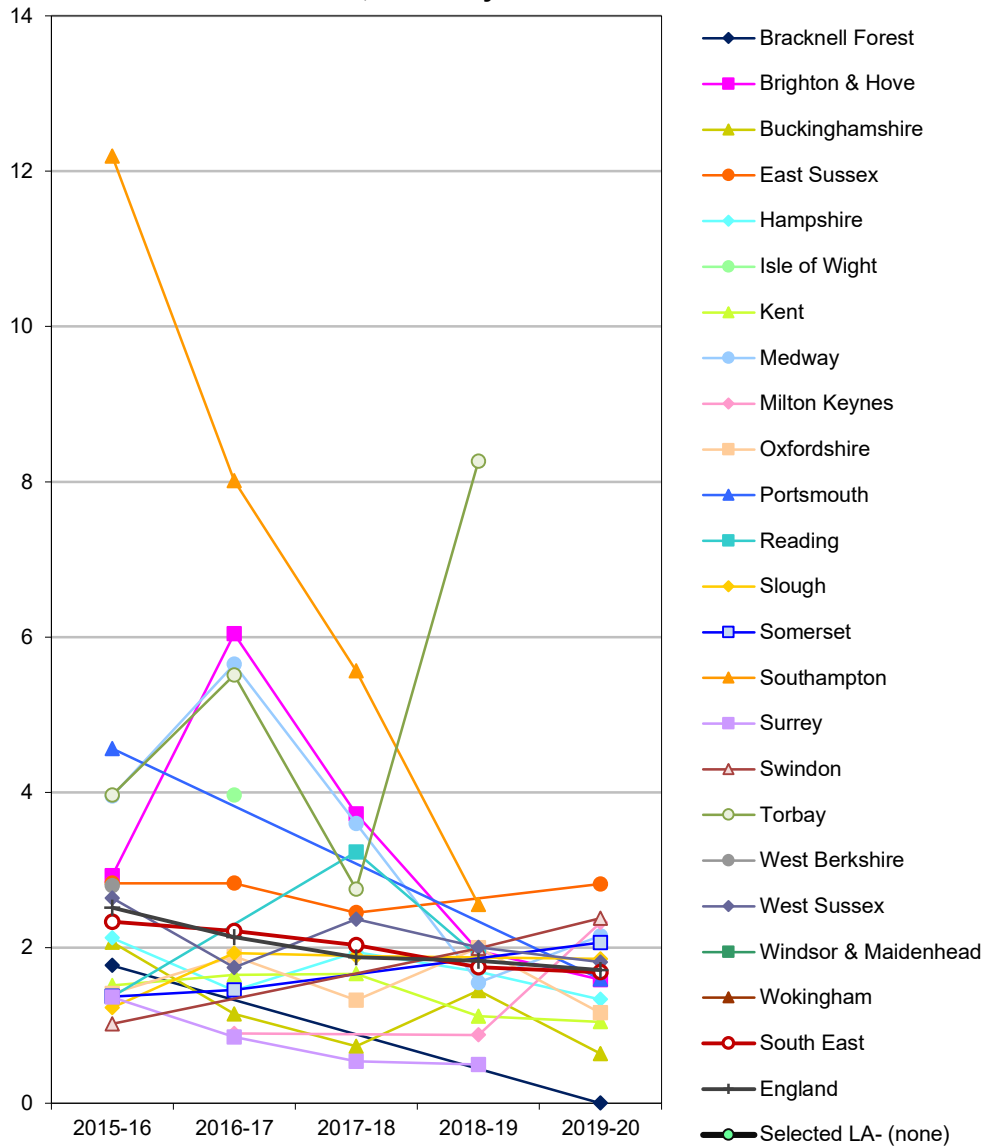

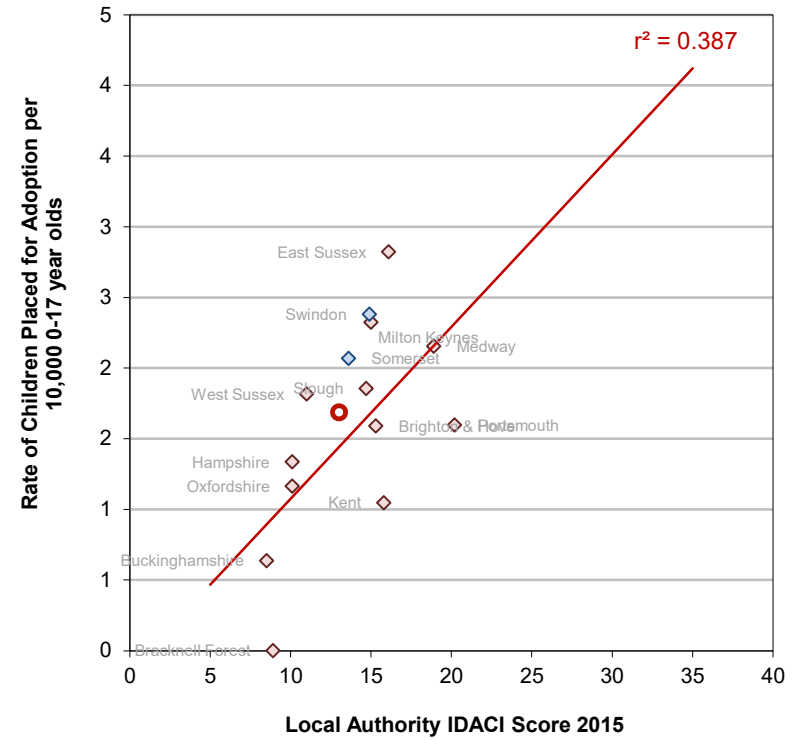

**Rate of Children Placed for Adoption at last day in period per 10,000 0-17 year olds**

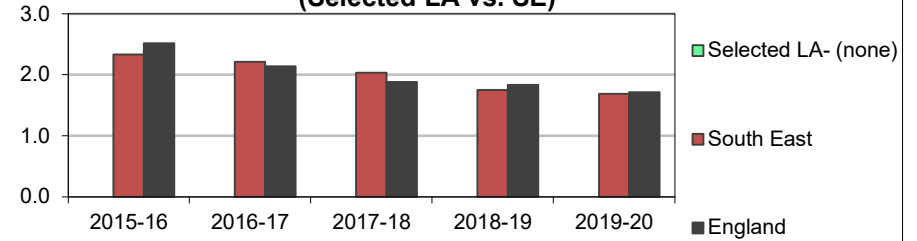


**Rate of Children Placed for Adoption vs. IDACI**

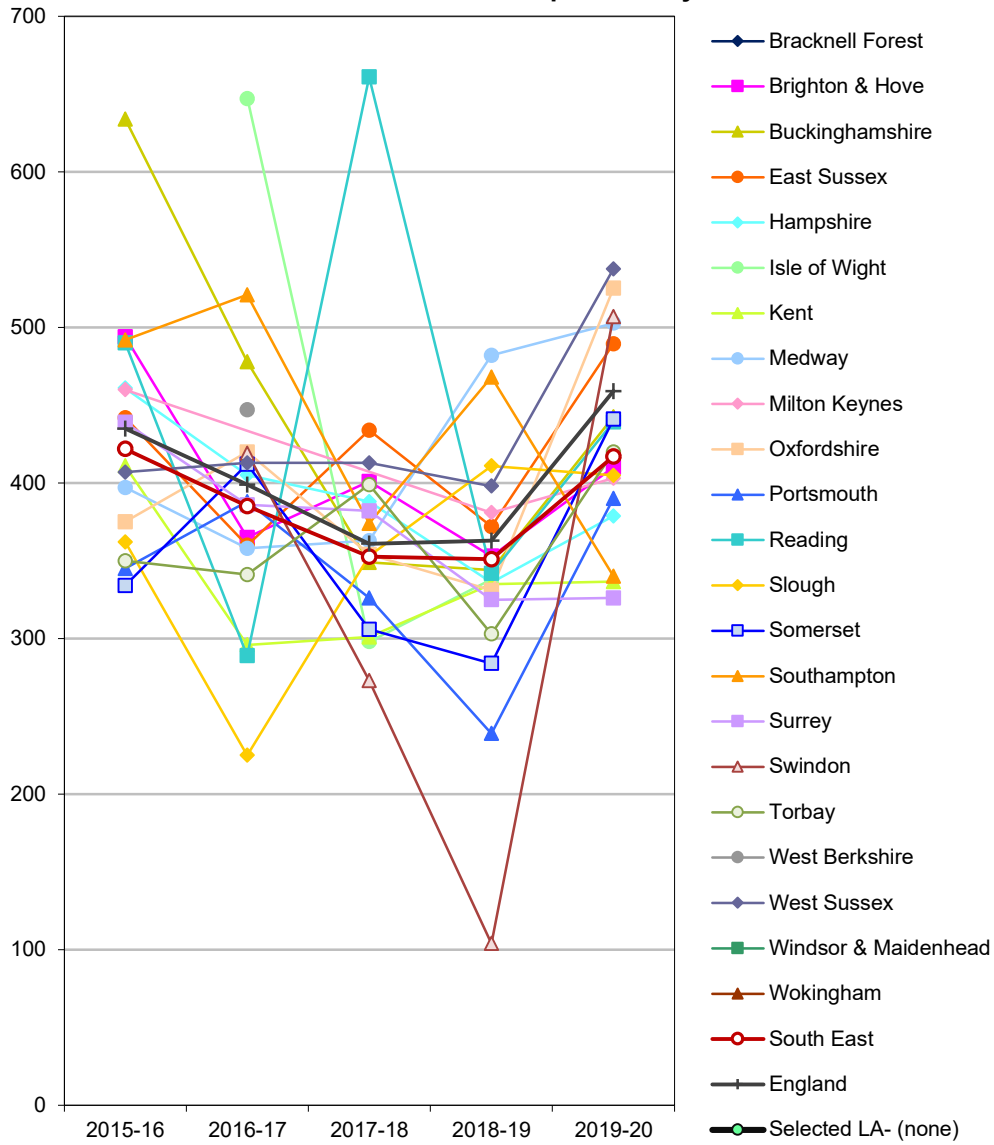

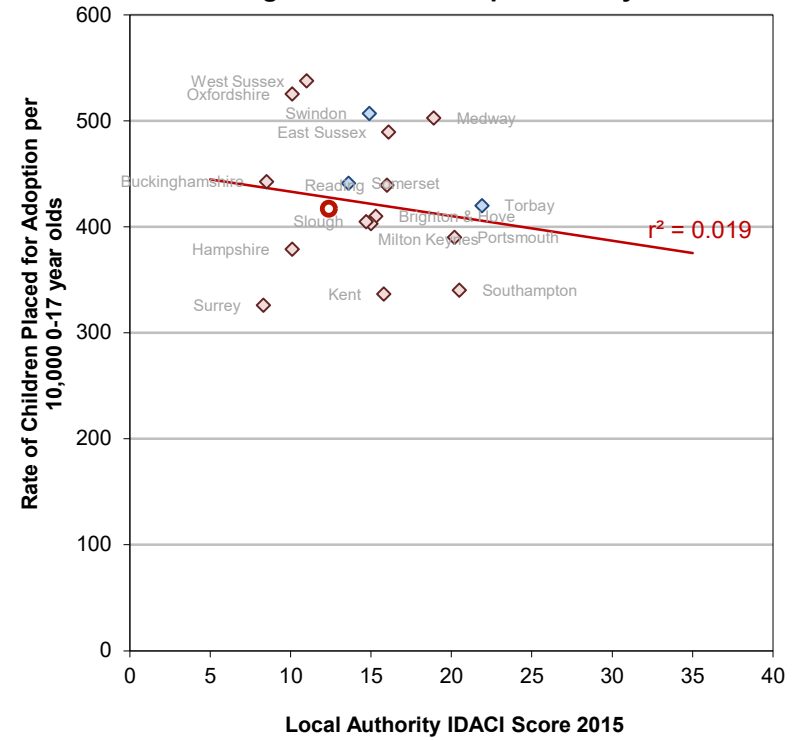

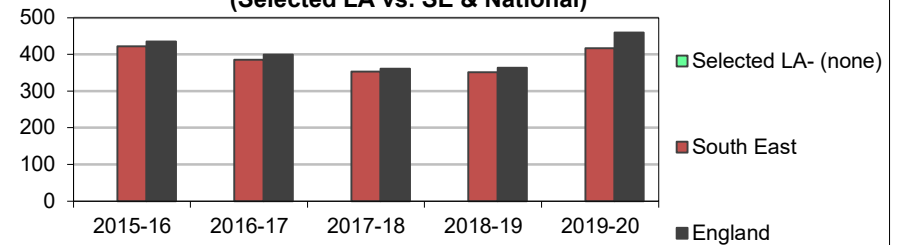


**Average time in days between a child entering care and moving in with their adoptive family vs. IDACI**

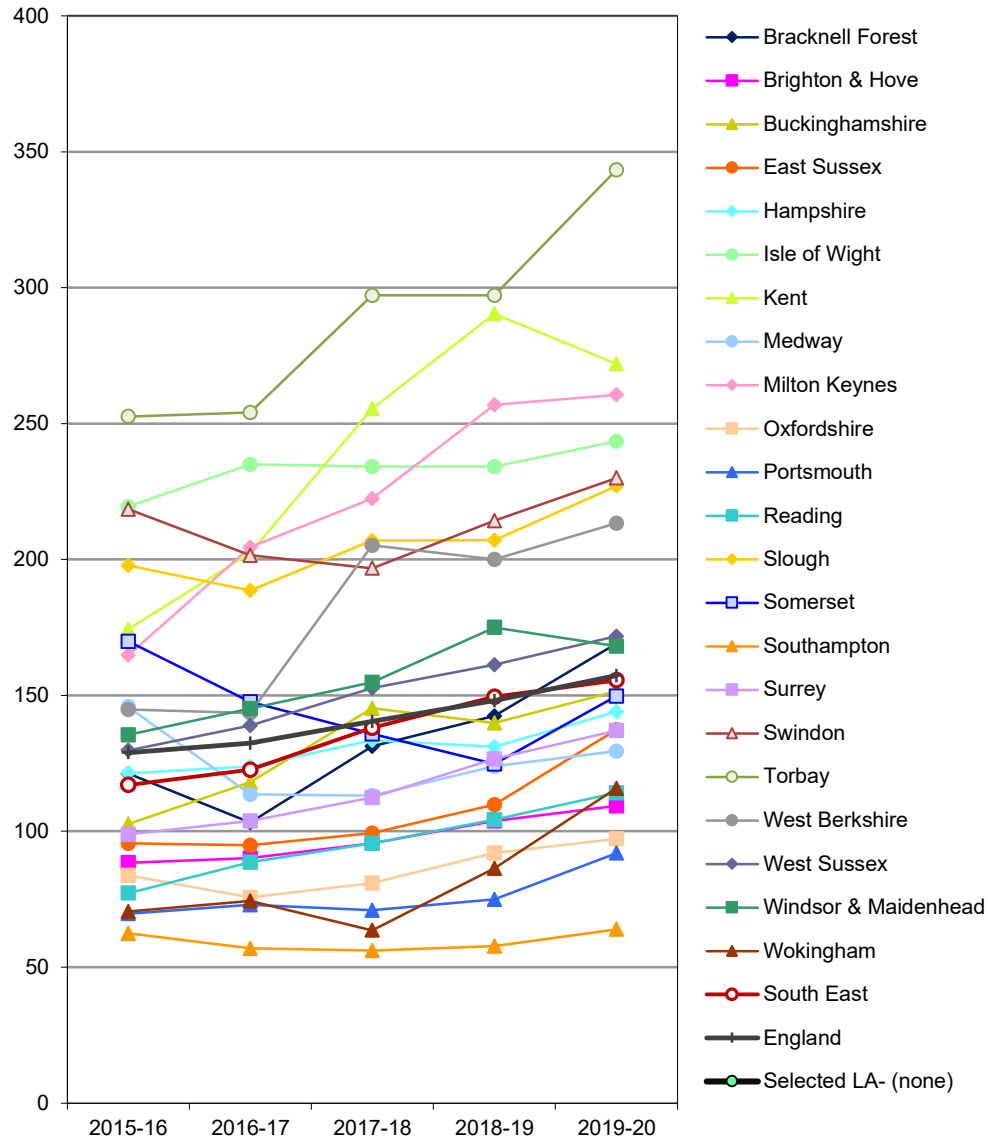

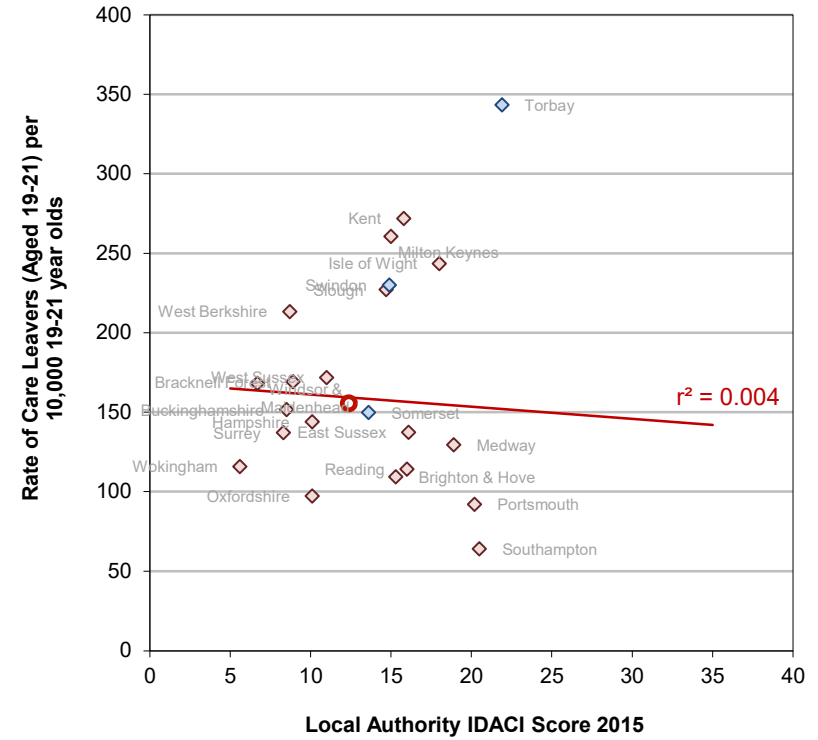

**Rate of Care Leavers (Aged 19-21), per 10,000 0-17 year olds**

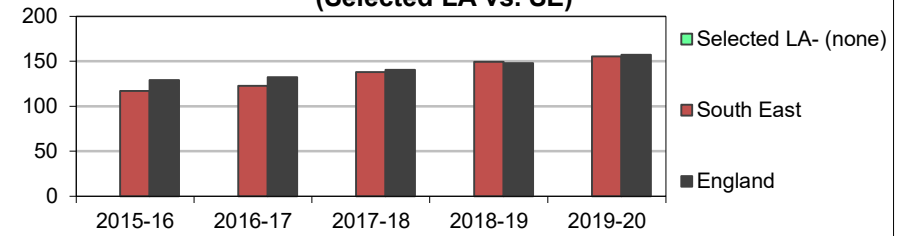


**Rate of Care Leavers (Aged 19-21) vs. IDACI**

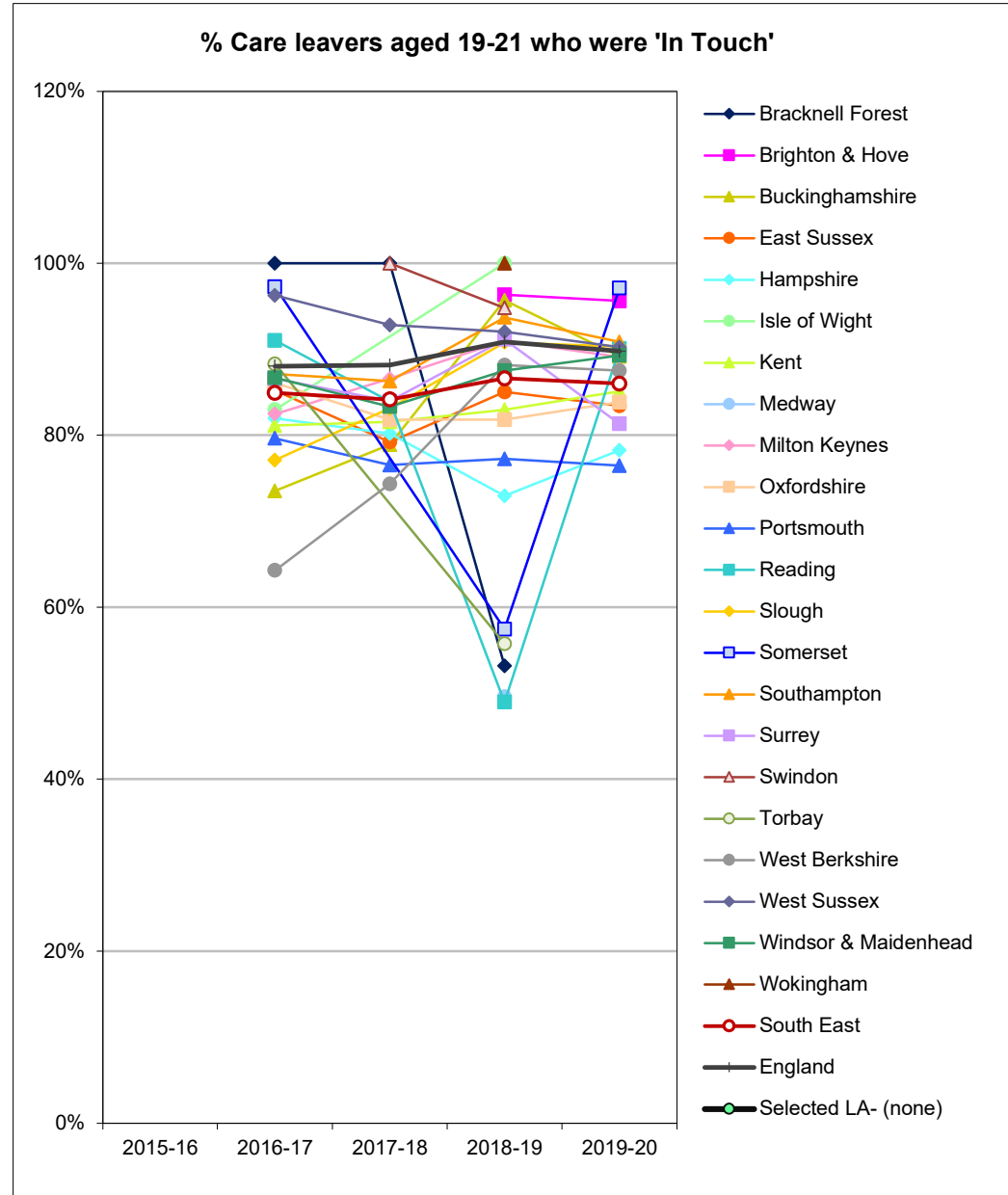
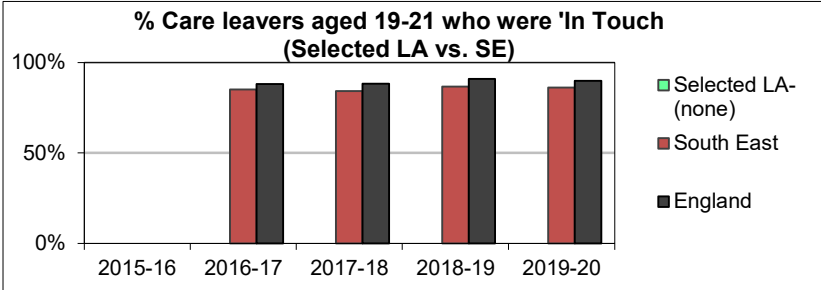
**Rate of Care Leavers (Aged 19-21) (Selected LA vs. SE)**

**Rate of New EHC Plans Issued in period, per 10,000 0-25 year olds**

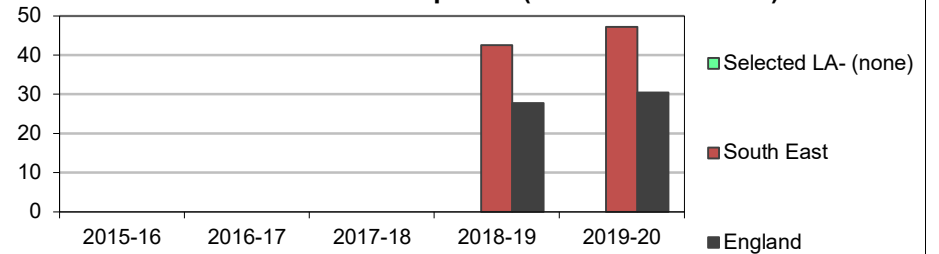


**Rate of New EHC Plans Issued vs. IDACI**

\*National Reoffending is measured by the Ministry of Justice using PNC data. From October 2017 the MoJ have changed the way reoffending is measured. They are now measuring a cohort of young people who offend within a 3 month period and track them for 12 months. The new measure produces an increase in the rate of reoffending as there is an inbuilt over-representation of prolific young offenders. Previously a prolific young offender would only be counted once in the 12 month cohort they could now be counted up to four times. The MoJ predict that this will lead to a 4-5 percent increase in the reoffending rate.
