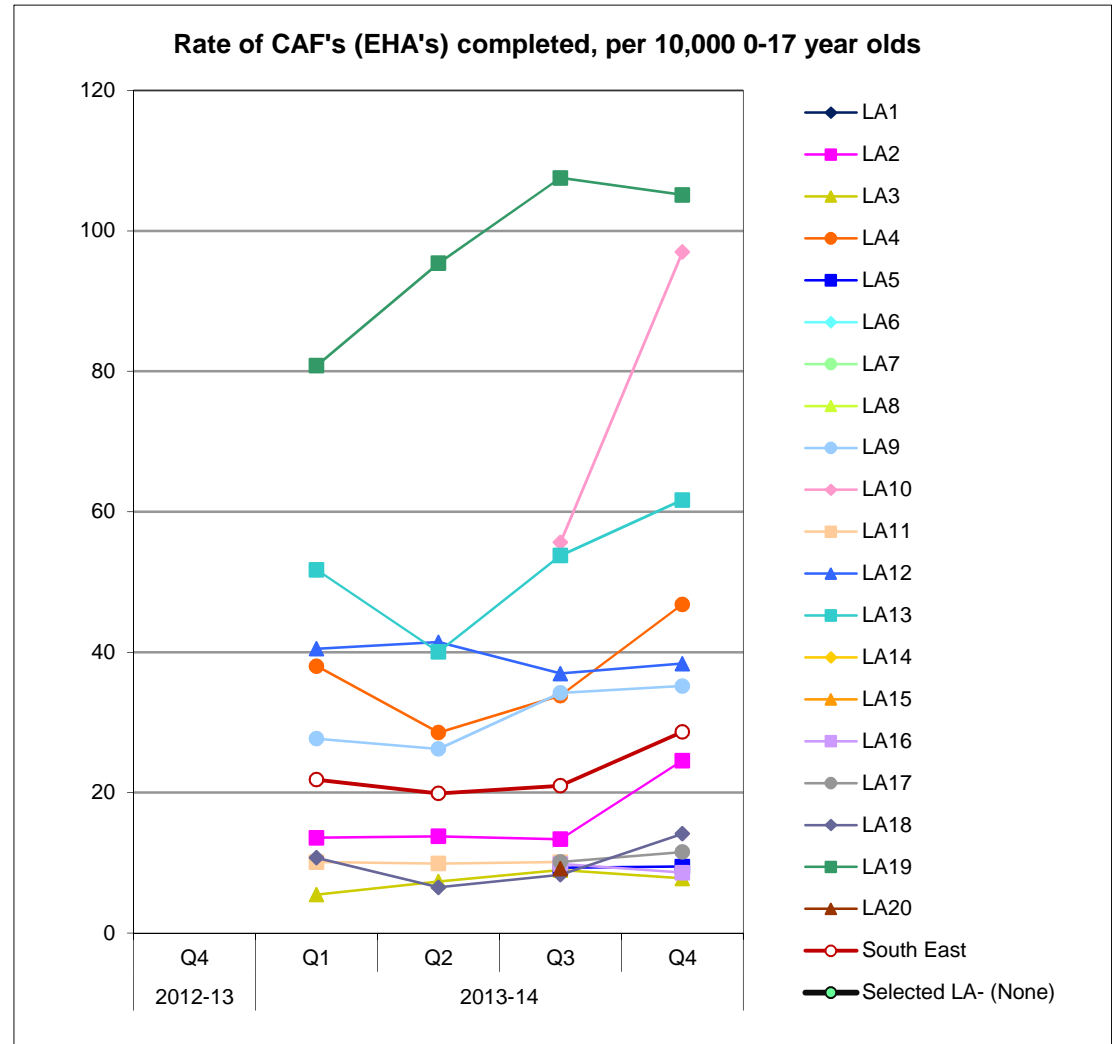

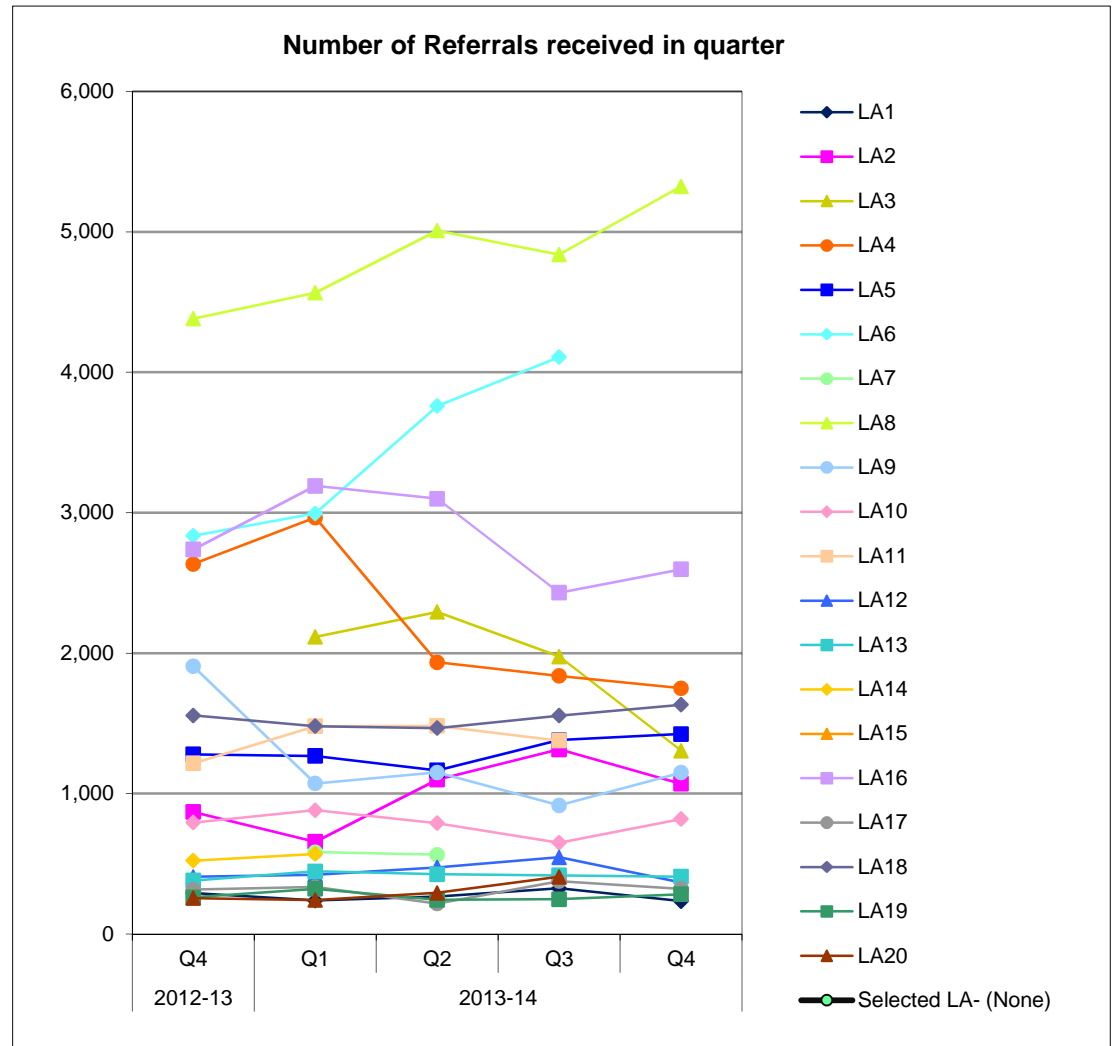

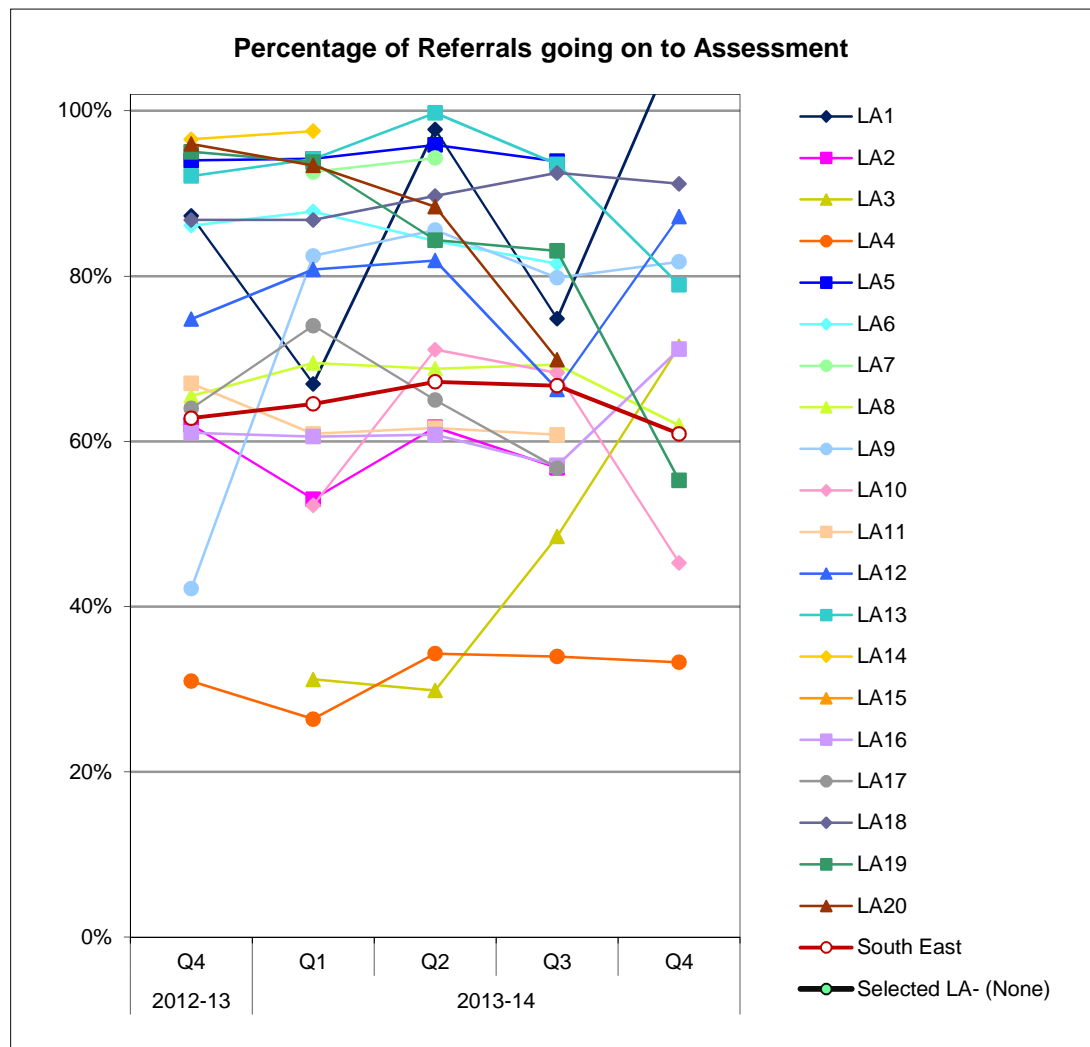

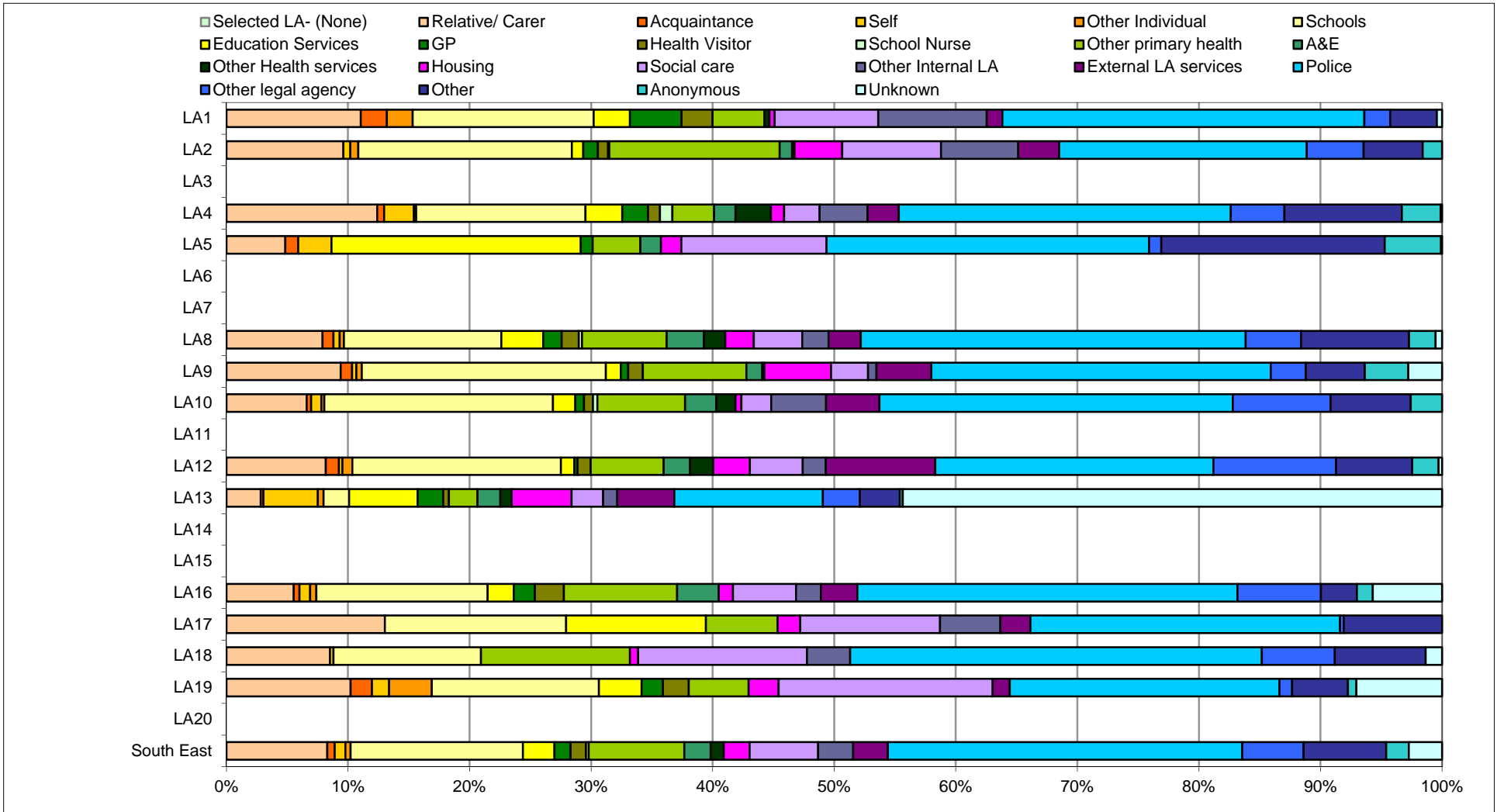

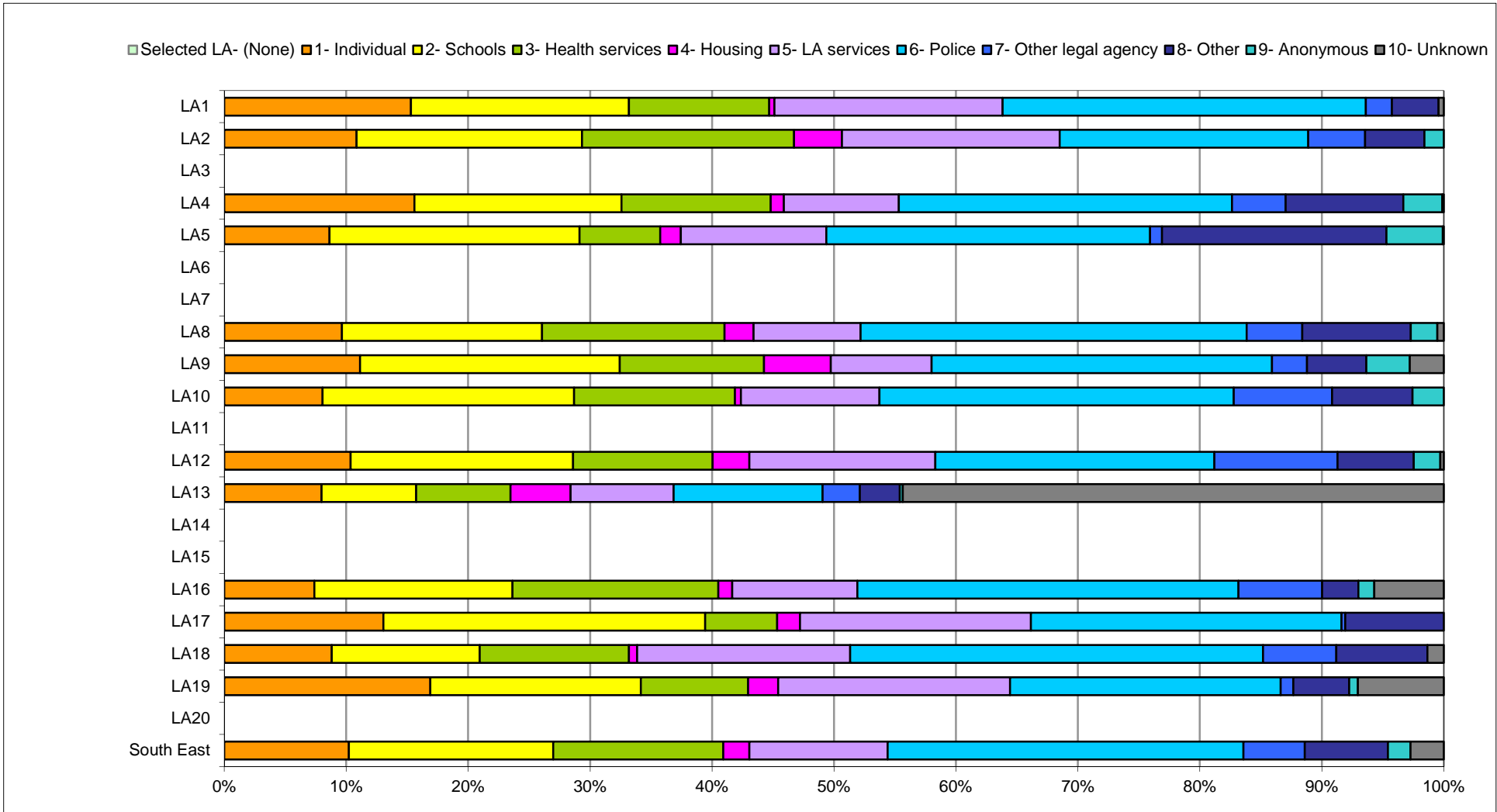
Percentage of Referrals to Social Care from each Referral Source (2013-14 Q4)

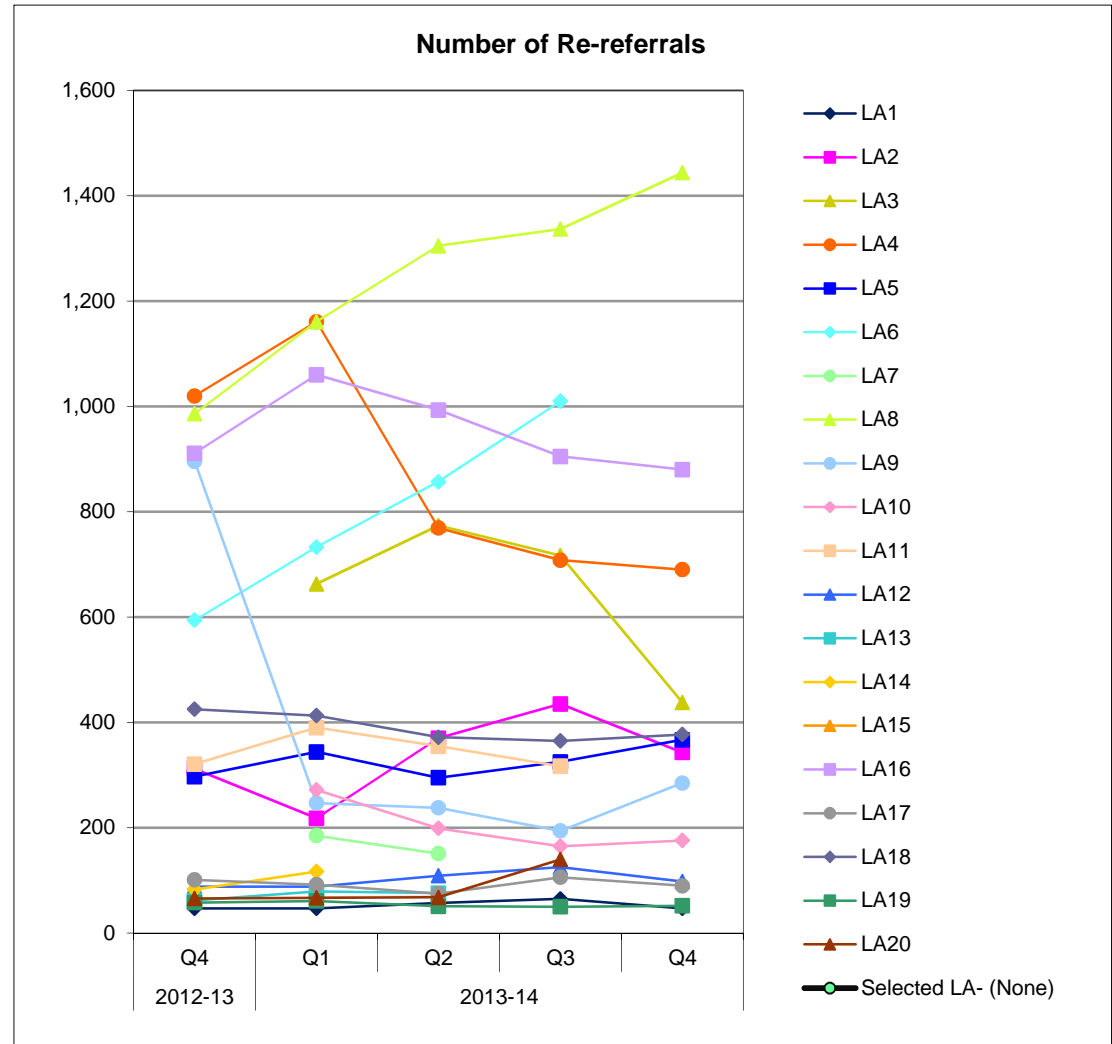
Percentage of Referrals to Social Care from each Referral Source Group (2013-14 Q4)

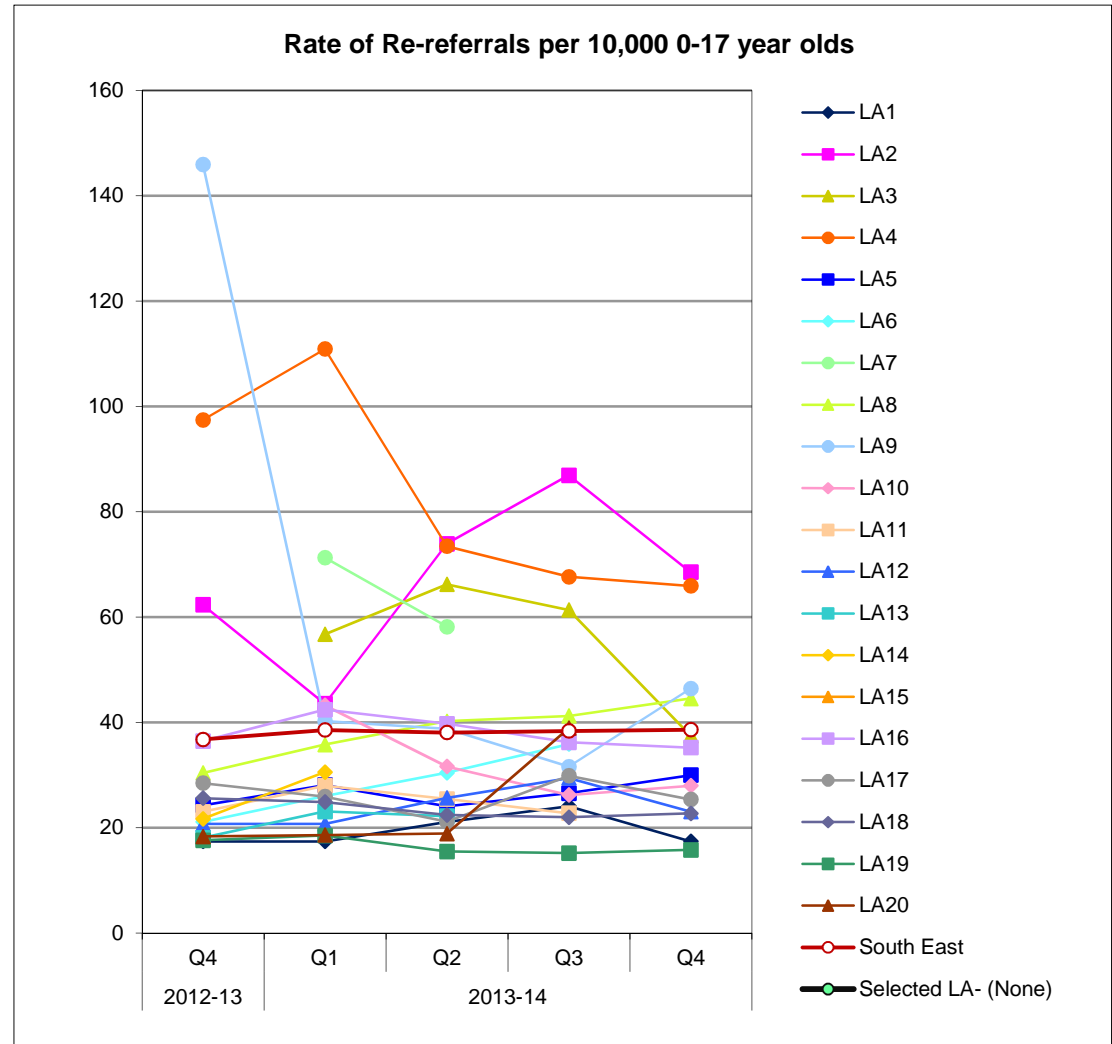

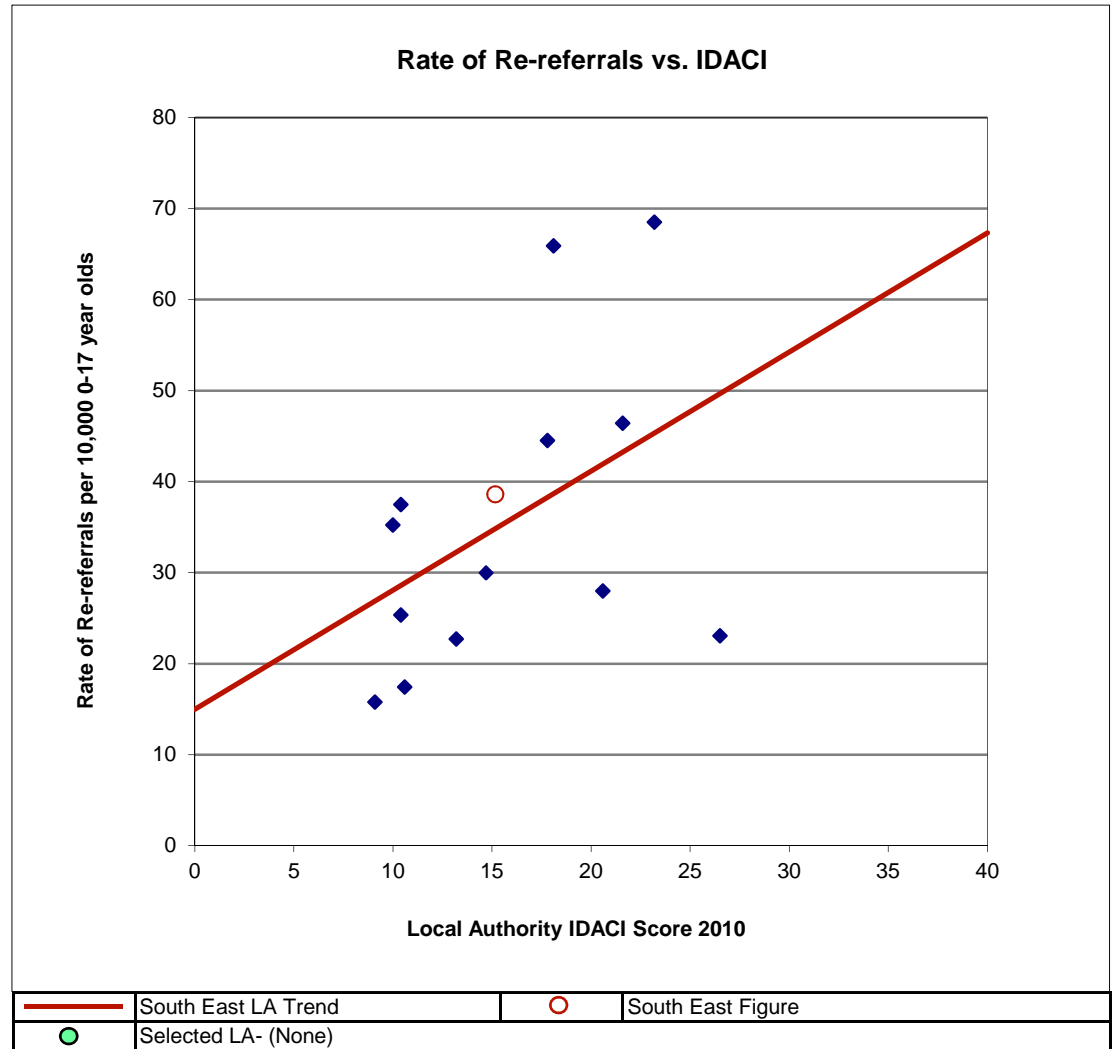

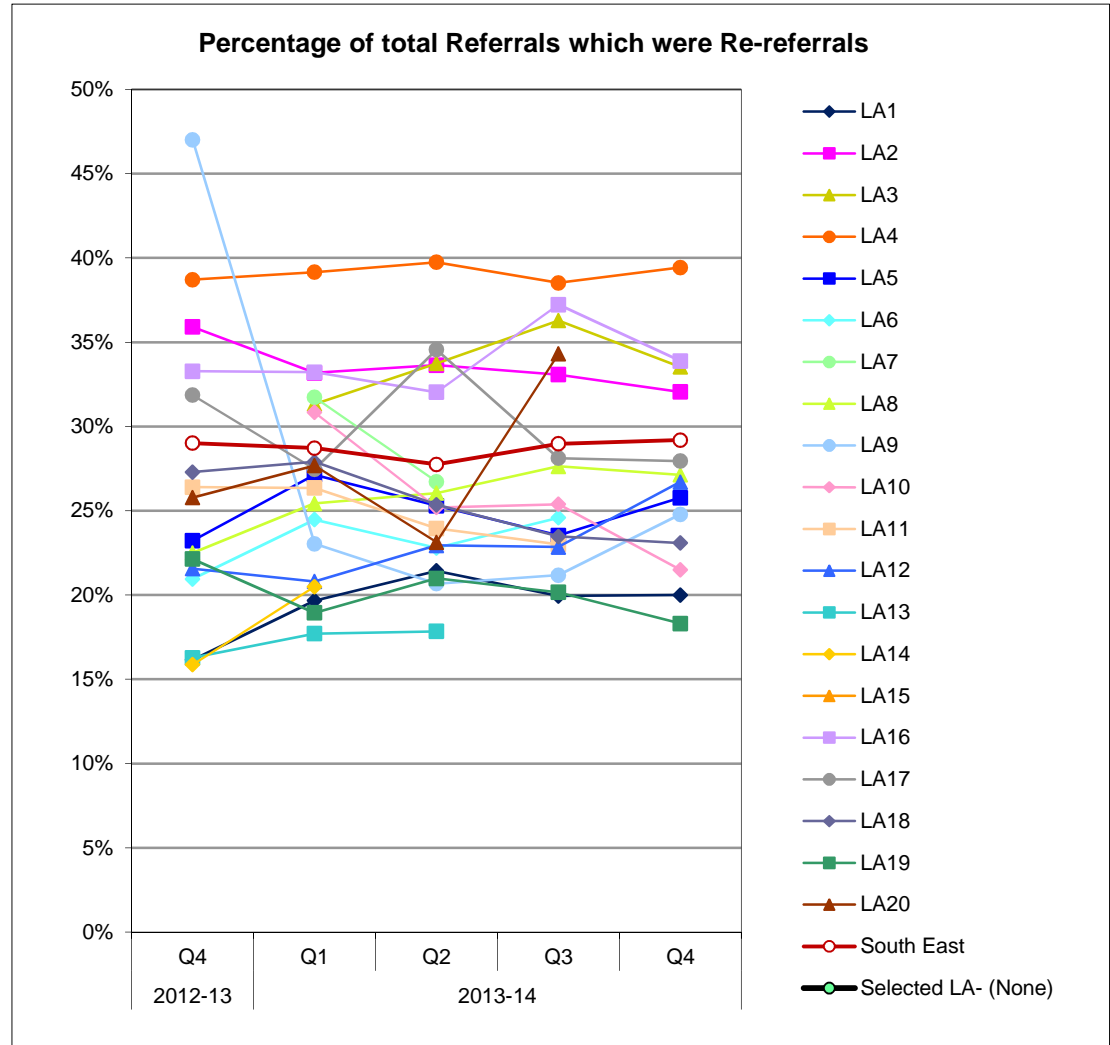

Percentage of Referrals received in quarter, which were received within 12 months of a previous referral

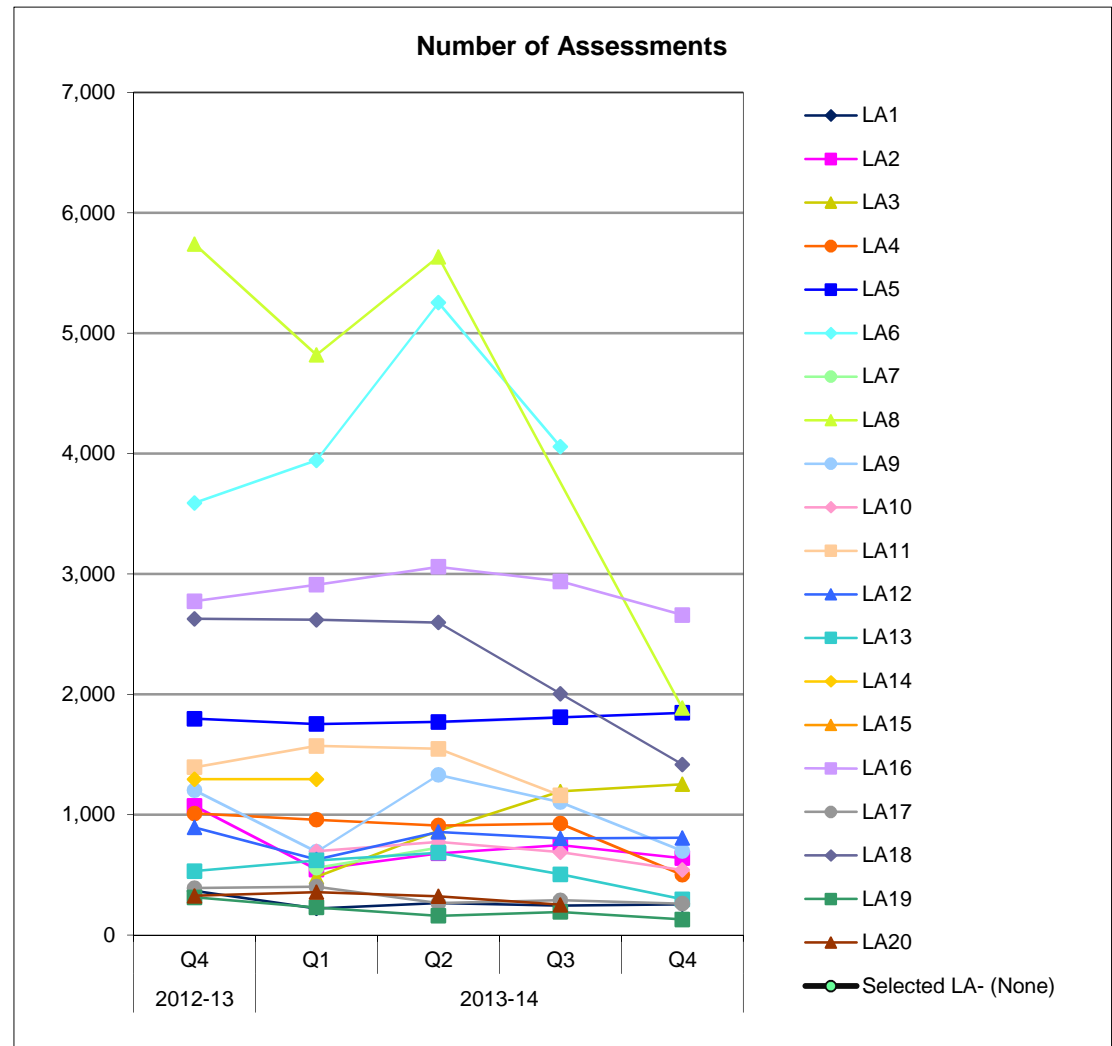

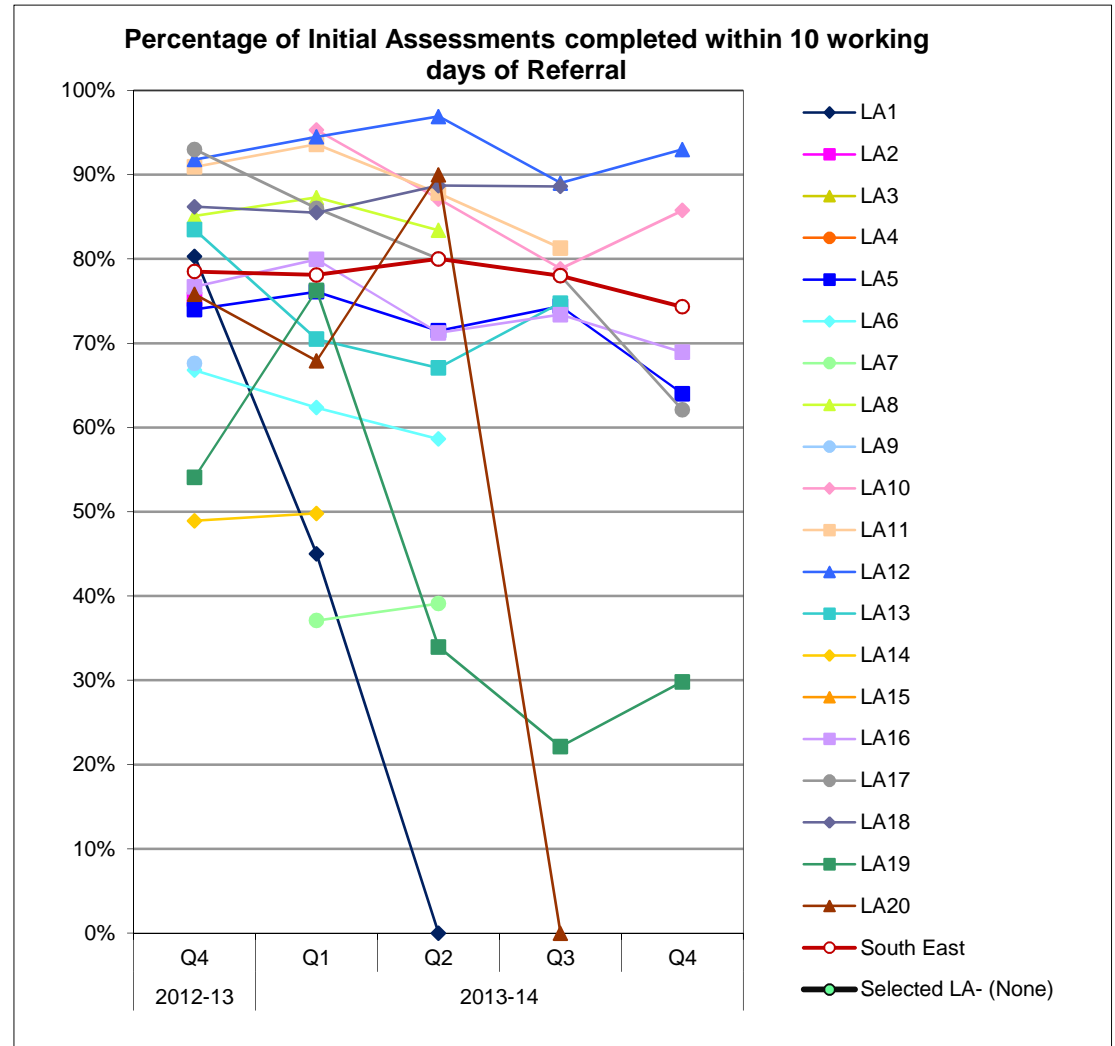

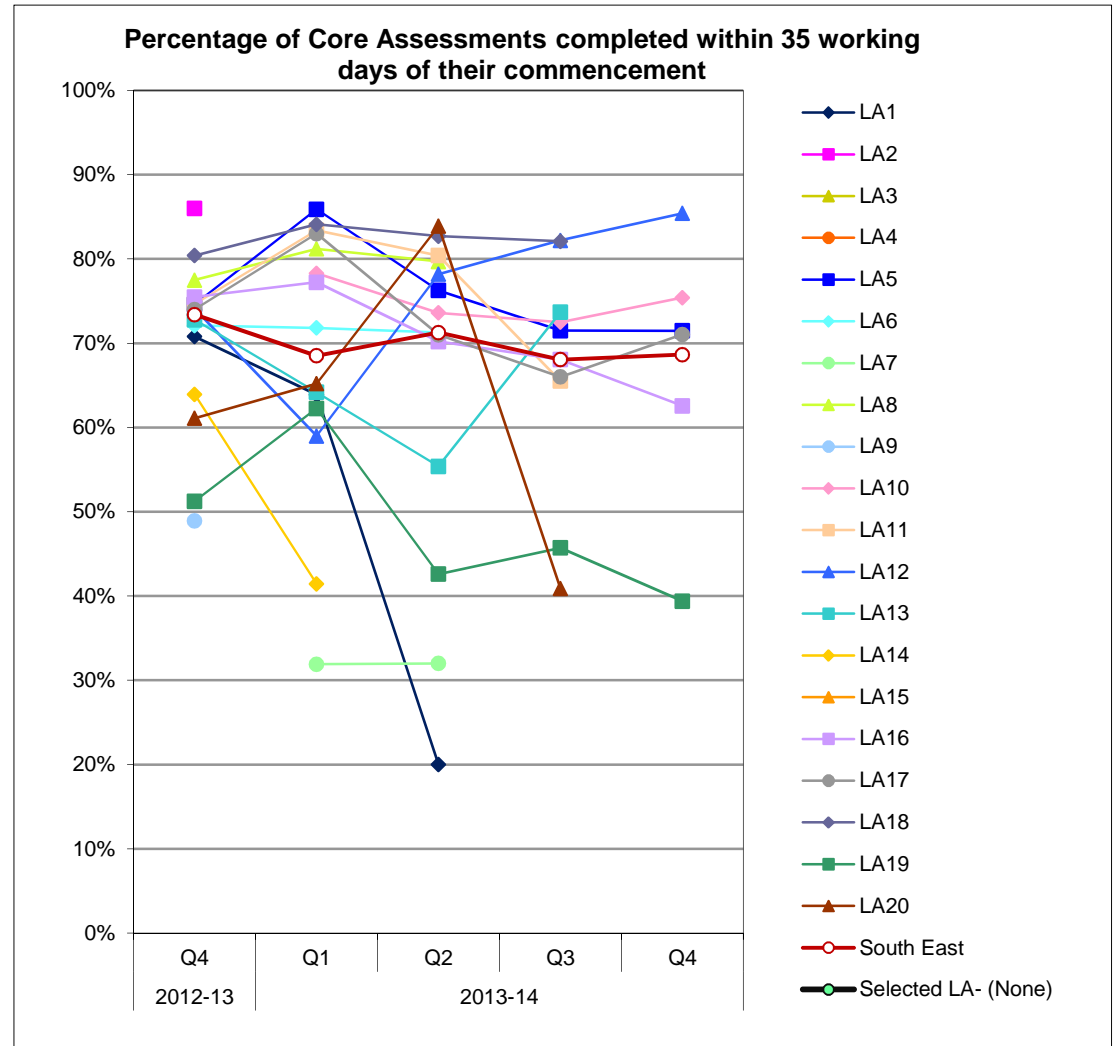


Percentage of Core Assessments completed within 35 working days of their commencement

Rate of Children subject to Court Applications in the past 6 months vs. IDACI

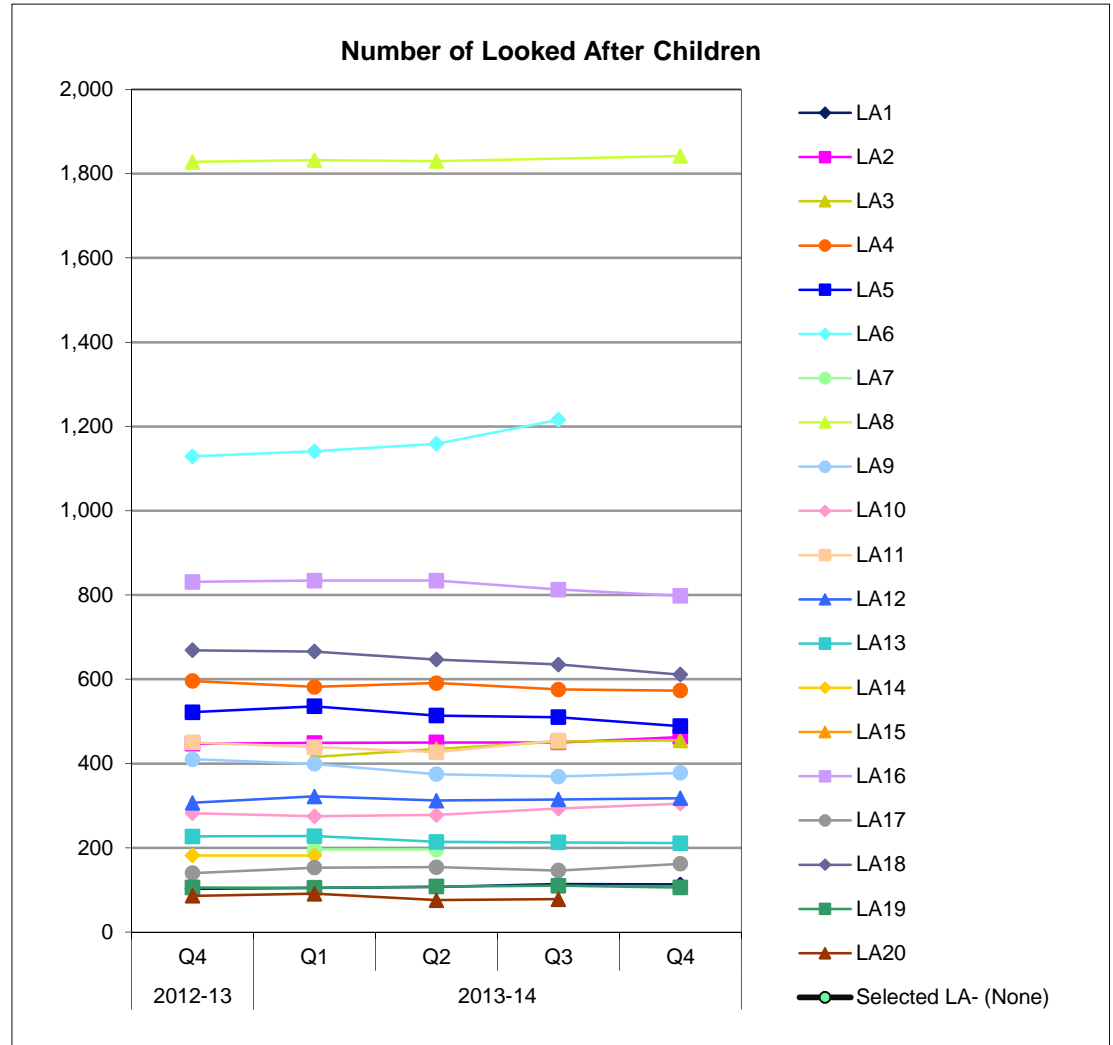
