



Developing a Mentoring and Coaching Culture

Context

<u>The South East Regional Care Cooperative (RCC)</u> is one of two Department for Education (DfE) pilot pathfinders.

"By working together across the South East, we will provide the right care for you that is available locally and when needed. We will be loving, caring and consistent with high aspirations for you. We will listen to you, put your needs first and will not give up on you. By working together, your voice will be stronger and more influential."

A key pillar of its work is to build a skilled, stable, and sustainable workforce across the region's local authorities, private, and voluntary sectors.

The Staff College have undertaken qualitative research on behalf of the RCC, gathering insights from across the sector, speaking to residential support staff, Registered Home Managers, and care-experienced young people.

One of the themes emerging from this research was the potential benefits of a mentoring and coaching culture across the children's residential care sector, helping to provide space for structured support, professional development, and reflective learning opportunities for staff at all levels.

Next Steps - Testing & Learning

The Staff College, on behalf of the RCC, are launching a series of workshops and peer groups to explore, test, and refine different mentoring and coaching approaches.

These sessions will help shape a prototype for a mentoring and coaching programme and framework, which will be further developed and piloted in the next financial year.
